






NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS

HAZARD TO NAVIGATION ON ST LUCIE CANAL

COMMUNICATION CABLES BELOW AUTHORIZED CLEARANCE

1. Until further notice, mariners are hereby advised of hazard to navigation due to communication cables below authorized clearance at two locations along the St Lucie Canal.
2. Communication Cables are located from East to West:
 - a. OVHD PWR & T CABS AUTH CL 56 FT found at 27° 05.323'N and 80° 18.067'W, or approximately 170 yds NE of County Hwy 76A Bridge.
 - b. OVHD PWR CAB AUTH CL 76 FT found at 27° 01.307'N and 80° 26.004'W, or approximately 1.25 nm ENE of State Hwy 710 Bridge.
3. Due to damage from recent storms these cables are approximately five to twenty-one feet below authorized clearance at above locations.
