





## NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS

### MELALEUCA REMOVAL ALONG OKEECHOBEE WATERWAY ROUTE #2

#### OKEECHOBEE WATERWAY, FLORIDA

1. This notice provides information in-addition to previous notice dated, January 11, 2005
2. Mariners are hereby notified that crews working for South Florida Water Management District and the US Army Corps of Engineers are removing exotic trees along the rim canal from Moore Haven Lock and Dam to Pahokee in the Okeechobee Waterway. Removal operations will continue until approximately 15 August 2005 (this is a revised completion date).
3. Mariners should use caution when operating vessels in or around the rim canal from Moore Haven, Florida to Pahokee, Florida. The waterway will have increased boat traffic due to work crews and work boats. Due to the nature of the work there is a possibility of floating debris in the waterway. Every effort will be made to keep the rim canal free of floating debris, however caution should be exercised. Workboats will be transporting supplies from Alvin Ward Boat Ramp across the waterway on a daily basis; therefore extra caution should be used in this area.
