






REOPENING OF ROUTE 2

OKEECHOBEE WATERWAY, FLORIDA

1. Navigation interests are advised that all known debris has been removed from the navigable channel in Route 2 and is reopened for navigation.
2. With the Lake Okeechobee water elevation at 13.2 feet, the available draft for Route 2 is 4.52 feet.
3. Due to debris not being removed until now the U.S. Coast Guard has not been able to restore the aids to navigation. Mariners are advised that they may proceed at their own risk and should monitor all Coast Guard Broadcast Notices to Mariners.
