1. It is desired that action be taken to prepare for a consolidation of the chemical, the ordnance, and the three mission ranges of the T.A.F. Demonstration.

2. The area selected for the above is that land east and south of the jeep track on the Orlando range. It is proposed to erect a large grandstand at the north end of the jeep track, install the chemical demonstration range directly in front of the stands, and present the T.A.F. show in the area to the southeast. The ordnance range will remain in approximately the same location.

3. In order to accomplish the above, it is directed that the areas outlined on the attached photograph be cleared of all standing trees in the order indicated. This project will receive an A-1 priority in the employment of labor troops and in the use of equipment assigned to the Orlando Army Air Base.

4. It is desired that this Headquarters be informed by letter not later than 9 November 1945 of the action taken for the accomplishment of this directive and the estimated date of completion of the clearing of the range.
