1. In connection with the summer camp of Air ROTC students Orlando Air Force Base, Headquarters Fourteenth Air Force has advised this headquarters:

a. That there is in existence at Pinecastle Army Airfield a 1000-inch range located in a deduded area.

b. That all necessary precautions will be taken by erection of appropriate fencing to safeguard personnel from injury when the range is being used.

c. That funds are available locally for renovation purposes.

2. It is recommended that the Chief of Engineers be authorized to grant a temporary right of entry for a period of two months (June-July 1948) allowing the Air ROTC utilization of the Pinecastle Army Airfield Turret and Rifle Range.
