1. The Detachment semi-monthly activity report on Camp Mackall, N. C., Pine Castle Florida AFB Gunnery & Bombing Range, and Ft. Jackson maneuver area for a period of 1 thru 15 April 1953 is herewith submitted.

During the period covered by this report the Detachment has completed the Search and Clearance of South Range at Camp Mackall and cleared areas #17 #18 and part of area N #10 and #13 in North Range a total of 559 acres. Completed the inspection of the 12000 acres Pine Castle Bombing Range & Search of 182 acres of impact areas in that range. Also completed was the Inspection & Clearance of the Ft. Jackson Maneuver Area a total of acres cleared by inspection this period.


