Amanda Ellison opened the meeting at 6:15 p.m. and explained that this evening's meeting would be an abbreviated meeting, for the purpose of electing a community co-chair and approving minutes of the May and June RAB meetings. This business had been postponed to the July meeting because a quorum was not present at the June meeting and no official business or votes could be conducted.

Amanda announced that one correction had been received on the May minutes, to move member Mark Holley from the absent list to the list of those in attendance. Amanda asked if there were any further comments on the May minutes; no further comments were received. Motion to accept the May minutes with the noted correction was made and seconded and carried unanimously. Amanda then asked for comments on the June meeting minutes. Ron Cumello asked that the minutes be noted that they were recorded for informational purposes only since the June meeting was not considered an official meeting during which business was conducted. A motion was made to accept the minutes as noted and seconded and carried unanimously.

Bruce Hossfield updated the RAB on an open action item from the June meeting. A question had been asked by a community member at that meeting regarding whether or not the city's stop work order applied to utility companies. Bruce reported that utility companies are required to obtain a permit from the city to perform their work.

Amanda began the process of the election of the community co-chair by announcing that there were two candidates – Ron Cumello and Leonides Villalon. No further nominations were received from the floor. Nancy Sticht collected the completed written ballots from the community members and asked member Aida Gonzalez to open and announce each vote. Ron Cumello received the majority vote (10/12); the remaining two votes were for individuals that were not official candidates. An election for a vice co-chair will be held at the next meeting.

The next meeting will be held August 26 at 6:30, location to be announced.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:30 and was followed by the previously scheduled community meeting for Remedial Investigation Areas of Interest B, C and D.
