Since the inception of pioneer environmental legislation, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) has been making recommendations and decisions concerning the fate of our nation's natural resources.

Today, the Corps is involved in wetland restoration and watershed protection as well as regulatory activities. Behind these activities are highly skilled engineers, biologists and other professionals.

When you volunteer with the Corps, you will gain valuable knowledge and skills about the environment where you live, work and play.

The Corps' Regulatory program has three goals:

- To protect the aquatic environment, including wetlands.
- To enhance the efficiency of the Corps' administration of the regulatory program
- To ensure that the Corps makes fair and reasonable decisions.

Field Work

- Assist with wetland identification and delineations
- Perform environmental inspections

Intergovernmental Relations

- Work with environmental professionals at the local, state and federal levels
- Attend meetings related to regulatory issues

Administrative and Public Outreach

- Attend outreach events
- Assist in the review of environmental permits

What to Expect

You will receive a general orientation as well as training specific to your needs. All volunteers serve without pay. However, reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses may be available.

Volunteers are limited only by their willingness to serve. You may work full time or just a few hours each week.
