

Using Panth0407.kml


These instructions are same for the free Google Viewer

1. Save the Panther0407.kml onto a subfolder "Google Earth" under My Documents


2. Open Google Earth. Click on <File> then <Open...>



3. Click My Documents, then on Google Earth folder, then click on the file name, then click <Open>



4. Right-click on the file name, Then click on <Save to My Places>




5. Click on the [+] to view the sub-layers




6. Click on the folder name to highlight, then on the transparency slider bar.

7. Click on the [✓] checkmark by the folder to turn the entire layer off.



8. Click on the colored box for a sub-layer to highlight, then on the transparency control. If you left the top folder (step 6) at, say, 50% transparent, then the sub-layer maximum is 50%: you cannot turn it opaque. You can leave the top folder at 100% (opaque) then adjust the sub-layer.



9. Click on the [✓] checkmark by the sub-layer to turn the entire layer off.

10. If you click on the blue underlined name, Google will pop up a window and point to the centroid of that layer (e.g., the centroid of all the telemetry points.)

11. If you have other folders in My Places, you can left-click on the file name to highlight it, then hold down the left mouse button and drag the folder to be above or below the Panther0407 folder, if below the other folder will be covered by the Panther0407 map (think of several transparencies on an overhead projector)
