Corps of Engineers announces closure of all Right of Entry collection sites as of Noon, November 23, 2005

JACKSONVILLE, FLA. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Jacksonville District, announces all Right of Entry (ROE) collection sites will close effective noon, Wed. Nov. 23, 2005. “Operation Blue Roof is not stopping,” stated Col. Bob Carpenter, Jacksonville District Commander. “We will continue installing temporary roofing until all Rights of Entry forms have been processed. As of today, over 16,000 damaged roofs have been protected, almost 50% of our mission.”

If you are still in need of temporary roof repairs, please visit one of the listed ROE collection centers as soon as possible.

The Operation Blue Roof program provides a temporary remedy for roof damage sustained during Hurricane Wilma. A homeowner must first sign the right of entry form before workers can assess the amount and type of roof damage and whether installation of blue plastic will constitute an appropriate temporary repair. Only primary residences that have sloped, shingled roofs are eligible to receive a blue roof. Roofs with greater than 50% structural damage, metal, tile and flat roofs are not eligible.

Right of entry collection centers are open daily from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. unless indicated otherwise.
