## **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers postpones Everglades Master Recreation Plan public meetings**

Jacksonville, Fla. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announced today that, considering the approach of Hurricane Ernesto, it has postponed two public meetings that had been scheduled for this evening in Homestead and Tuesday evening in Stuart.

The meetings had been scheduled to gain public input to a Master Recreation Plan, part of the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan (CERP).

“Public safety is our highest priority,” said project manager Paul Stevenson. “Since travel is necessarily limited during potential extreme weather conditions, we will reschedule these meetings at a later date, to allow full community participation.”
