1. DESCRIPTION

The work consists of maintenance dredging the 38 FT slip basin at the U.S. Marine Corps Support Facility Blount Island, Jacksonville, Florida.

2. FUNDING

4. STATUS

Approximately 125,000 cubic yards is maintenance dredged every year. Non-beach quality material is placed in the Dayson Island upland disposal area. The dredging efforts for this contract are combined under the MATOC award for U.S. Navy Kings Bay Inner Channel. Effort in FY 2014 includes condition surveys, ongoing ODMDS study, and award. Due to customer request, the FY14 dredging cycle has been postponed into FY15. The next maintenance event is scheduled for award in April 2015.
