**Intracoastal Waterway - Jacksonville to Miami, FL (O&M)**

**1. DESCRIPTION**

The Intracoastal Waterway (IWW) project authorizes a channel 12 feet deep by 125 feet wide from Jacksonville, Florida south to Fort Pierce, Florida, and a channel 10 feet deep by 125 feet wide from Ft. Pierce, Florida south to Miami, Florida. The length of project is approximately 349 miles running from the St. Johns River in northeast Florida southward along the east coast to Miami, Florida.



**4. STATUS**

A Memorandum of Agreement with FIND to contribute funds for the Operation and Maintenance (O&M) of both the IWW and Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway (AIWW) was executed on September 3, 1997. Since that date, FIND has provided over \$50,000,000 for the O&M of the IWW and AIWW.

In FY 2014 plans and specifications were developed for Indian River Reach 1. Dredging began in January 2015 and is expected to be complete by June 2015. This dredge material is not suitable for beach placement and is being placed in a recently constructed Dredge Material Management Area (DMMA), IR-2. Funding for this dredging was shared between the Corps of Engineers and the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND).

In FY 2015 plans and specifications are being developed for construction of DMMA O-7 which is located in Martin County, Florida. Funding for the plans and specifications effort is from Federal funding. Construction of DMMA O-7 will be from Contributed Funds from FIND. In addition, in FY2015 investigations will be underway for Broward Reach 1, including initiation of environmental investigations and a water quality certification.
