### **1. DESCRIPTION**

There are two active Dredge Material Disposal Facilities (DMDFs) associated with Jacksonville Harbor. These are Bartram Island and Buck Island. Bartram Island is used for placement of Federal and Non-Federal dredged material that is unsuitable for beneficial reuse. Buck Island is used for construction grade material which has beneficial uses and can be offloaded via roadway.



Contract 1 to rehabilitate the Buck Island DMDF was completed in June 2012. Funds provided in FY 2011 and FY 2012 were used to award a 2<sup>nd</sup> contract in May 2012 at Bartram Island DMDF to create almost 7 MCY of capacity. The contract is scheduled for completion in October 2015.
