**1. DESCRIPTION**

The ocean shoreline of St. Johns County is approximately 42 miles long. The St. Johns County feasibility study includes critically eroded shoreline in South Ponte Vedra Beach, Vilano Beach, and Summerhaven. Extreme erosion north of the St. Augustine Inlet due to the 2004 and 2005 Hurricane seasons has compounded the need for the study.

**4. STATUS**

Re-scoping efforts were completed in FY2014 to ensure the study met the Corps new Smart Planning guidance. Vertical team concurrence that the St. Johns County feasibility study is in compliance with the new policy was received on October 21, 2014. The project received Federal Funding in the amount of \$525,000 to move forward with the study in November 2014. The team has resumed work on the study and plans to complete the Alternatives Milestone in March 2015. Alternatives identified will provide hurricane storm damage reduction in highly erosive areas along the shoreline. The study is currently scheduled to be completed in 2017 contingent upon continuous funding.
