1. DESCRIPTION

The impacts of the hurricane season of 2004-2005 emphasized the critical need for shoreline protection throughout St. Lucie County, not just south of the Inlet where the existing Federal project is located. St. Lucie County, the project sponsor, supports the feasibility study 100%. The State of Florida also supports shore protection initiatives for the critically eroding shoreline identified within St. Lucie County.


3. SPONSOR

4. STATUS

A reconnaissance report was approved August 2003 and preparation of the feasibility report began in 2005 following execution of the feasibility study cost sharing agreement in June 2004. Federal funds were provided in FY 2005 thru FY 2007, FY 2009 and FY 2010 for continuation of the feasibility study and preparation of the feasibility report. The sponsor has conducted 100% of their 50% of the total study cost as work-in-kind contributions.

In 2014 the scope and schedule of the feasibility was re worked to comply with the Corps of Engineers Smart Planning Guidance. In early FY 2015 \$414k in federal funding was provided for continuance of the feasibility based on a compliance memorandum which was received in October 2014. In FY 2014 the team will continue with efforts that will result in meeting the alternatives milestone. According the current schedule the Civil Works Review Board would be held in April 2017 followed by a Chief of Engineers Report in July 2017.
