1. DESCRIPTION

There are two active Dredge Material Disposal Facilities (DMDFs) associated with Jacksonville Harbor. These are Bartram Island and Buck Island. Bartram Island is used for placement of Federal and Non-Federal dredged material that is unsuitable for beneficial reuse. Buck Island is used for construction grade material which has beneficial uses and can be offloaded via roadway.



Contract 1 to rehabilitate the Buck Island DMDF was completed in June 2012. Funds provided in FY11 and FY12 were used to award a 2nd contract in May 2012 at Bartram Island DMDF to create 9 MCY of capacity. The contract was completed in September 2015.
