**Río Guanajibo, PR**  
 Construction (C)  
 Congressional District: Puerto Rico

### **1. DESCRIPTION**

The Río Guanajibo basin is located in southwest Puerto Rico and includes portions of six municipalities with a total population of over 225,000. The catchment area is 140 square miles. Flooding is a serious threat to life and property in the towns of San German, Hormigueros, and Mayaguez. The recommended project includes a channel plan with a 10 year level of protection at San German in the upper basin and a system of levees that will provide 100 year protection for the urban areas at Hormigueros and Mayaguez in the lower basin.




### **4. STATUS**

Project was authorized for construction in Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) of 1999; however, no construction funds have been allocated. A Limited Re-evaluation Report (LRR), which updates project costs and benefits based on the most recent economic guidance, was near completion in FY05 before all available funds were expended. Federal funds will be required in order to complete LRR. No additional Federal funds have been received since FY05. Completion and approval of LRR is necessary prior to execution of the Project Partnership Agreement and contract award. Plans and Specifications for the first construction contract, San German Segment, have been completed.
