1. DESCRIPTION

The ocean shoreline of St. Johns County is approximately 42 miles long. The St. Johns County feasibility study includes critically eroded shoreline in South Ponte Vedra Beach, Vilano Beach, and Summerhaven. Extreme erosion north of the St. Augustine Inlet due to the 2004 and 2005 Hurricane seasons has compounded the need for the study.

4. STATUS

In 2015, the team received \$390,000 to continue the feasibility study efforts. In 2015, the team completed the Alternatives Milestone that was held in March 2015 and identified alternatives that potentially will provide hurricane storm damage reduction in highly erosive areas along the shoreline. FY16 activities include selecting a Tentative Selected Plan, Public Review of draft report and Agency Decision milestone. The study is currently scheduled to be completed in January 2017.
