1. DESCRIPTION

The Tarpon Springs 103 Project is located on the West Coast of Florida, Pinellas County, within the city limits of Tarpon Springs. The City of Tarpon Springs and Pinellas County maintain a portion of Spring Bayou, Whitcomb Bayou, and adjacent roads. Erosion of the bayou banks is threatening the city and county maintained roadways. Portions of the roadways are subject to frequent flooding, having been constructed on low elevation land. The roads provide the only emergency evacuation route for some residents. Concrete revetment and sheet piles will be implemented on Whitcomb and Kreamer Bayous, in order to stabilize the adjacent roadways. Project authorized under Section 103, River and Harbor Act of 1962 as amended.


