1. DESCRIPTION

The work consists of maintenance dredging the 38 feet slip basin at the U.S. Marine Corps Support Facility Blount Island, Jacksonville, Florida.

4. STATUS

Approximately 125,000 cubic yards is maintenance dredged every year. Non-beach quality material is placed in the Dayson Island upland disposal area. The dredging efforts for this contract are combined under the MATOC award for U.S. Navy Kings Bay Inner Channel. Effort in FY17 includes condition surveys, plans and specifications, and award of the construction contract. The next maintenance event is scheduled for award in August 2018.
