# 1. **DESCRIPTION**

The work consists of maintenance dredging the 50 foot Entrance Channel to include Bar Cut 3, and non-50 foot portions including the Turning Basin, Destroyer Slip, and Small Boat Basin at the U.S. Naval Station (NS) Mayport, Florida.

# 4. STATUS

Approximately 1,400,000 cubic yards is maintenance dredged every two years. Efforts in FY17 will include maintenance dredging of the 50 foot portions of the U. S. Naval Station Mayport project including the Turning Basin, the Mayport Entrance Channel, Bar Cut 3, and non-50 foot portions including the Turning Basin, Destroyer Slip, and Small Boat Basin. All material resulting from this work will be transported to and placed in the Jacksonville ODMDS.


