**1. DESCRIPTION**

This study was authorized under Section 205 of the Flood Control Act of 1948 as amended. The Pinellas Anclote watershed is located in the southwest portion of Pasco County with small portions extending into both Hillsborough and Pinellas County. The project area is prone to significant flooding events which include Flood damages to property, public infrastructure, businesses, and public safety. High groundwater levels exasperate flooding by limiting the drainage available within the watershed.
