# FACT SHEET **Pinellas County, FL** Construction (C)

#### 1. DESCRIPTION

The project extends along 25 miles of island beaches from Dunedin Pass to Pass-A-Grille Pass. The project provides for the restoration of 1 mile of shoreline on Clearwater Beach Island, restoration of 7.9 miles of shoreline on Sand Key, restoration of 2 miles of shoreline on Treasure Island, nourishment of 0.5 miles of shoreline on Long Key, and periodic nourishment as needed along the entire length of the four segments.

### 4. STATUS

Tropical Storm Debby impacted the County beaches and as a result, the Treasure Island and Long Key segments underwent renourishment during summer of 2014. Annual post construction monitoring continues for both Long Key and Treasure Island segments. Prepartion for the 4<sup>th</sup> renourishment of the Sand Key segment is underway, with additional analyses of current conditions performed post Hurricane Hermine, yielding a loss of 360k cubic yards from the project's design berm. A positive Project Information Report was approved by Corps Headquarters and accelerated construction from FY18 to FY17. Award is scheduled for summer of 2017 with a total value of \$30m.
