St. Johns County, FL Shore Protection Project

1. DESCRIPTION

The ocean shoreline of St. Johns County is approximately 42 miles long. The St. Johns County feasibility study includes critically eroded shoreline in South Ponte Vedra Beach, Vilano Beach, and Summerhaven. Extreme erosion north of the St. Augustine Inlet due to the 2004 and 2005 Hurricane seasons has compounded the need for completion of the study. The recommended plan includes placement of sand along 3 miles of shoreline in Vilano Beach and South Ponte Vedra Beach. The recommended plan also calls for 3 renourishments (at 12-year intervals) over the project life.

PED and Construction of the recommended plan is subject to authorization and future appropriations. These future activities needed to be completed as soon as possible to reduce future storm risks in areas impacted during Hurricane Matthew.
