**1. DESCRIPTION**

The work consists of maintenance dredging the 38 FT slip basin at the U.S. Marine Corps Support Facility Blount Island, Jacksonville, Florida.


**4. STATUS**

Approximately 125,000 cubic yards is maintenance dredged every year. Non-beach quality material is placed in the Dayson upland disposal facility. The dredging efforts for this contract are combined under the MATOC award for U.S. Navy Kings Bay Inner Channel. Effort in FY 2013 includes condition surveys, ongoing ODMS study, and award. Dredging was completed at Blount Island on October 23, 2014. Due to customer request, the FY14 dredging cycle has been postponed into FY15. The next maintenance event is scheduled for award in January 2015.
