1. DESCRIPTION

Canaveral Harbor is located in Brevard County on the east coast of Florida at approximately midpoint of the peninsula. The two nearest deep-water ports are Jacksonville, located 155 miles north, and Ft. Pierce, located 40 Miles south. The Canaveral Port Authority (CPA) conducted a feasibility study of potential navigation improvements under the authority granted by Section 203 of WRDA 1986. The study addressed improvements to the west turning basin, deepening, and widening of the main channel and entrance channel. The purpose of the Section 203 study is to obtain authorization for the improvements through the next Water Resource Development Act.

4. STATUS

The Jacksonville District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, provided technical services under a Memorandum of Agreement executed on December 20, 2006, and by a waiver to the Thomas Amendment. A Civil Works Review Board was completed in October 2012 and the Chief of Engineer's Report was issued February 25, 2013. The CPA has proceeded forward with procurement activities related to channel improvements within Canaveral Harbor. A 204(f) agreement has been drafted and provided to USACE HQ which would allow the USACE to take over O&M of the channel improvements. However, this agreement cannot be executed due to the Port awarding a construction contract prior to the agreement being executed.
