**1. DESCRIPTION**

There are two active Dredge Material Disposal Facilities (DMDFs) associated with Jacksonville Harbor. These are Bartram and Buck Islands. Bartram Island is used for Federal and Non-Federal capacity for primarily unsuitable material. Buck Island is used for construction grade material which has beneficial uses and can be offloaded via roadway.



**4. STATUS**

Contract 1 to rehabilitate the Buck Island DMDF was completed in June 2012. Funds provided in FY11 and FY12 were used to award a 2<sup>nd</sup> contract in May 2012 at Bartram Island DMDF to create almost 7 MCY of capacity. The contract is scheduled for completion in February 2015 and is well ahead of schedule.
