1. DESCRIPTION

Nassau County is the northernmost county on the east coast of Florida. Amelia Island forms the eastern border, stretching 13 miles south from the St. Mary's River to the Nassau River. The Water Resources Development Act of 1988 authorized the Nassau County, Florida shore protection project. The authorized project area is located on the Atlantic Shorefront of Amelia Island in Nassau County. The project provides for initial fill for 3.6 miles of shoreline and periodic nourishment along 4.3 miles as needed. Initial cost, as estimated in the General Reevaluation Report (GRR), is \$16.2 million, of which \$12.7 million is the Federal share of the initial cost. The project cost share reflects Section 111 cost mitigation for downdrift impacts of the Federal navigation project. Net annual benefits are \$7.5 million with a B/C ratio of 3.9. Initial construction was completed in November 2008.
