### 1. DESCRIPTION

The project extends along 25 miles of island beaches from Dunedin Pass to Pass-A-Grille Pass. The project provides for the restoration of 1 mile of shoreline on Clearwater Beach Island, restoration of 7.9 miles of shoreline on Sand Key, restoration of 2 miles of shoreline on Treasure Island, nourishment of 0.5 miles of shoreline on Long Key, and periodic nourishment as needed along the entire length of the four segments.

### 4. STATUS

In FY11 the third periodic construction renourishment of Sand Key was awarded. Construction was completed end of November 2012. A new study is required to extend the period of Federal participation at Long Key and Treasure Island which is due to expire in 2019. Tropical Storm Debby impacted the Counties beaches and as a result, the Treasure Island and Long Key segments will undergo renourishment this summer, with completion scheduled for August 2014.
