### **1. DESCRIPTION**

The project begins approximately 2.5 miles feet south of the south jetty of St. Augustine Inlet. The purpose of this project is to mitigate for down drift shoreline impacts caused by the Federal navigation channel at St. Augustine Inlet, and provide storm damage protection to the upland development. As a result, the cost sharing for this project is 80.5 percent Federal and 19.5 percent non-Federal. The authorized project for the St. Johns County Florida Shore Protection project also includes initial restoration of a protective beach to a width of 60 feet.



A renourishment contract was awarded in January 2012 to dredge 2.1 million cubic yards of material from 3 borrow areas including the Federal channel at St. Augustine Inlet, the Ebb Shoal and Vilano Point. The contract was completed in August 2012. The next renourishment is scheduled for FY 2016.
