1. DESCRIPTION

There are two active Dredge Material Disposal Facilities (DMDFs) associated with Tampa Harbor. These are 2D and 3D. 2D is used for Berthing areas (Non-Federal material). 3-D is used for Federal channels. Per the 2012 Dredge Material Management Plan, the dikes at DMMF 3D need to be raised from current elevation 23 to 40 feet.



4. STATUS

A project Partnership Agreement was signed in FY 2013 to issue a Contract to raise the dikes at DMDF 3D. Funds provided in FY 2012 and FY 2013 were used to award a contract in August 2013 at Dredge Material Placement Facility (DMPF) 3D to create almost 15 MCY of capacity. The contract is scheduled for completion in January 2015.
