Former Lee Field Naval Air Station



Site History

- Established in 1940 as a pilot training base
- Comprised approximately 1,560 acres
- Used by Navy to deactivate ships following WWII
- Transferred to City of Green Cove Springs in 1963
- Sold to J. Louis Reynolds and developed as the Reynolds Industrial Park



Potential Landfill Area 2




- About 7.5 acres at western edge of industrial park
- Used as equipment storage area
- Wooded, undeveloped area



CERCLA Process

Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act



Remedial Investigation

- Characterizes the nature and extent of the military's past use of the site
- Evaluates potential risks to people and the environment
- Determines the need for further action



Remedial Investigation

- Reviewed historical aerial photographs
- Dug 41 test pits
- Installed 8 groundwater monitoring wells
- Collected 51 soil samples and 19 groundwater samples



Remedial Investigation Results

- No debris indicative of a military landfill
- Limited amounts of building materials and other miscellaneous debris



Remedial Investigation Results

- Soil and groundwater samples sent to laboratory for analysis
- Results indicated no risk to people or the environment
- Results also indicated no impact by the military's use of the site



Proposed Plan



- No evidence of military landfill
- No further action necessary
- Public comment period open through February 29, 2016
