




## **CANAVERAL HARBOR, MAINTENANCE DREDGING**

The Dredge ATLANTIC will commence dredging operations near Cape Canaveral, Florida on or about August 20, 2012. The project will consist of dredging the West Turning Basin and various berths at Cape Canaveral, Florida. Scows will be towed from the jobsite to the Ocean Disposal Area. The project is expected to continue until approximately 1 August 2013. The Dredge Operator will standby on channels #13 and #16 VHF-FM. Traffic should call 30 minutes prior to expected time of passage. Mariners are requested to stay clear of the dredge, barges, derricks and operating wires about the dredge. Operators of vessels of all types should be aware that the barges are held in place by cables, attached to anchors some distance away from the equipment. Buoys are attached to the anchors to mark their location. Mariners are cautioned to strictly comply with the Inland Rules of the Road when approaching, passing and leaving the area of operations and remain a safe distance away from the dredge, buoys, cables, barges, derricks, wires and related equipment. Owners and lessees of fishnets, crab pots and other structures that may be in the vicinity and that may hinder the free navigation of attending vessels and equipment must remove these from the area where tugs, tender-boats and other attendant equipment will be navigating. The project will be conducted twenty-four (24) hours per day seven (7) days per week. Fish-nets, crab-pots and structures in the general area must be removed prior to the commencement of the work.
