



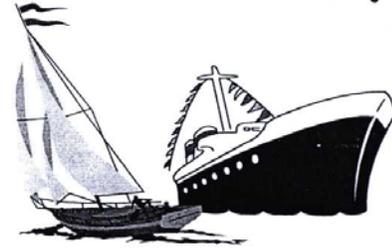

Scheduled Closure of St. Lucie Canal South Fork at the Indian Street Bridge  
Construction Zone Between Stuart and Palm City, Martin County, Florida

1. Mariners are hereby notified to use caution and plan their transit of this area accordingly.
2. The closure is related to new bridge construction.
3. The project is located at Lat 27-09-32.11 North and Long 80-15-06.5 West.
4. There will be a daily waterway closure from 1000 - 1600 local time starting 11 February 2013 through 4 March 2013. The waterway will be closed in both directions during these hours. Archer Western Contractors has arranged for the Martin County Sheriff's Office to maintain a Safety Zone during closure hours. Mariners should operate vessels with caution in the area due to potential for floating debris, increased traffic due to the operation, and large equipment working in and along the waterway. The Martin County Sheriff's Office will be monitoring VHF channels 13 and 16. All vessels are to comply with the Inland Navigational Rules Act of 1980 (33 U.S.C. 2001-2038).
