KISSIMMEE RIVER CLOSURE OF HISTORIC RIVER OXBOW

REFERENCE: Title 33 CFR Navigation and Navigable Waters

1. Notice to Navigation Interests

Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Jacksonville District is planning the closure of a historic river oxbow located approximately 1.7 miles south of US Highway 98 and approximately 0.6 miles north of the Structure 65D lock and spillway structure. The channelized Kissimmee River (Canal 38) will remain open. The proposed change will take effect on 15 June 2015 through 13 July 2015 while embankment repairs and erosion prevention efforts are made in the vicinity of the recently constructed CSX railroad bridge. Mariners are requested to stay clear of any navigation aids located near the entrances of the historic river oxbow.
