## *is coming to Your Neighborhood*

**Operation Blue Roof** is a FEMA-assigned mission of the **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers**, that provides temporary repairs to roofs in **Lee, Charlotte, DeSoto, Hardee, Highlands** and **Polk** counties for damage done by **Hurricane Charley**.

For **Hurricane Frances**, the **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers**, intends to provide temporary repairs to roofs in **Indian River, Martin, St Lucie, Palm Beach** and **Brevard** counties.

Corps contractors will install the temporary roof covering at **NO COST TO YOU**.

To get the help, homeowners must sign a "Right of Entry" form that allows Corps staff to assess roof damage, and for Corps contractors to do the work. Corps and volunteers will be in your neighborhood or you may visit an outreach center to sign a form. Installation will occur at the earliest possible date.
