I am writing to you in regard to the proposed dredging and beach re-nourishment off the coast of Palm Beach . I am a native Floridian, underwater photographer and have been diving off of Florida's east coast for the past 28 years. The reefs off Palm Beach are some of the most spectacular in the State. In my opinion, they rival some of the more popular reefs in the Florida Keys.

I also have witnessed first hand the damage that these dredging projects do to the reefs. Many of the smaller reefs I frequent off of Jupiter have still not recovered from the recent "beach re-nourishment" project and I suspect they never will.

I'm strongly urging you to explore other alternatives and consider that these reefs are visited and enjoyed by more people than the beach you are trying to protect.
