GENERAL PERMIT SAJ-74

Administrative Extension

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: To simplify and speed evaluation of Department of the Army permit applications, the Jacksonville District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, promulgates Regional Permits (general permits) to authorize a variety of minor activities. Each general permit is valid for a 5-year period.

BACKGROUND: SAJ-74 is a permit for Residential and Commercial Fill in Wetlands in specified portions of Sections 3, 4, 9, 10, 16, 20, 29, 32, Township 54 South, Range 39 East in Bird Drive Everglades Basin, Miami-Dade County, Florida. It is due to expire on April 30, 2003. Because of time constraints, it will not be possible to complete the reauthorization review process before the permit is due to expire. Therefore, we are administratively extending SAJ-74 for an additional 180-day period. It will now be scheduled to expire on October 30, 2003.
