PUBLIC NOTICE

GENERAL PERMIT SAJ-74

Administrative Extension OCT 21 2003

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: To simplify and speed evaluation of Department of the Army permit applications, the Jacksonville District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, promulgates Regional Permits (general permits) to authorize a variety of minor activities. Each general permit is valid for a 5-year period.

BACKGROUND: SAJ-74 is a permit for Residential and Commercial Fill in Wetlands in specified portions of Sections 3, 4, 9, 10, 16, 20, 29, 32, Township 54 South, Range 39 East in Bird Drive Everglades Basin, Miami-Dade County, Florida. It is due to expire on October 30, 2003. A public notice for the proposed reauthorization was issued on October 7, 2003. Because it will take time beyond October 30, 2003 to analyze and resolve any issues brought up in the public notice, we are administratively extending SAJ-74 for an additional 180 day period or until SAJ-74 is reauthorized, whichever comes first. It will now be scheduled to expire on April 30, 2004. If the proposed permit is reauthorized prior to that date, the existing SAJ-74 will be revoked as unnecessary and the criteria in the newly authorized SAJ-74 will supersede that in the existing SAJ-74.
