1. DESCRIPTION

The project was authorized in WRDA 96 from a recommendation included in the Coast Of Florida Region III Feasibility Report. An additional study recommended project construction in two phases with Phase I being rehabilitation of the Sand Transfer Plant and Phase II being installation of a booster pump and pipeline extension approximately 2500 feet south of the jetty. The study was approved in August 2008.


