SUBJECT: San Juan Harbor, Puerto Rico Federal Navigation Project LRR – Request for Review Plan Approval

1. References:

2. The enclosed Review Plan for the San Juan Harbor, Puerto Rico, Limited Reevaluation Report has been prepared in accordance with Engineer Circular (EC) 1165-2-214. The Review Plan has been coordinated with the Deep Draft Navigation Planning Center of Expertise (DDN-PCX), which SAD will coordinate with in executing this plan. For further information, please contact the DDN-PCX at (251) 694-3804. The Review Plan does not include independent external peer review.

3. Economics is not required for this Limited Reevaluation Report, and the attached Review Plan is revised accordingly. The LRR should be appropriately scaled to the decision being made, and therefore it is expected that the LRR could be written in about 20 pages for the main report, along with an attached cost engineering appendix, real estate plan, and Environmental Assessment. The LRR should include a qualitative assessment of alternative mitigation sites considered in discussions with the non-Federal Sponsor and resource agencies, and why the proposed site was chosen.

4. I hereby approve this Review Plan, which is subject to change as circumstances require, consistent with study development under the Project Management Business Process. Subsequent revisions to this Review Plan or its execution will require new written approval from this office. The District shall post the approved Review Plan and a copy of this approval memorandum to the District public internet website and provide a link to the DDN-PCX for their use. Before posting to the website, the names of Corps employees should be removed.
