



TENTATIVELY SELECTED PLAN – Non-Structural Measures

Nonstructural measures are permanent or contingent measures applied to a structure and/or its contents that prevent or provide resistance to damage from flooding. They focus on reducing the consequences of flooding rather than reducing the probability of flooding.

Floodproofing




Types of Flood Shields

Waterproofing:
Apply membrane on exterior wall (left) and fiber-reinforced polymer wrap to interior wall (right)



Acquisitions & Relocations

This nonstructural measure consists of acquiring the at-risk structure and land that the structure sat upon.
