

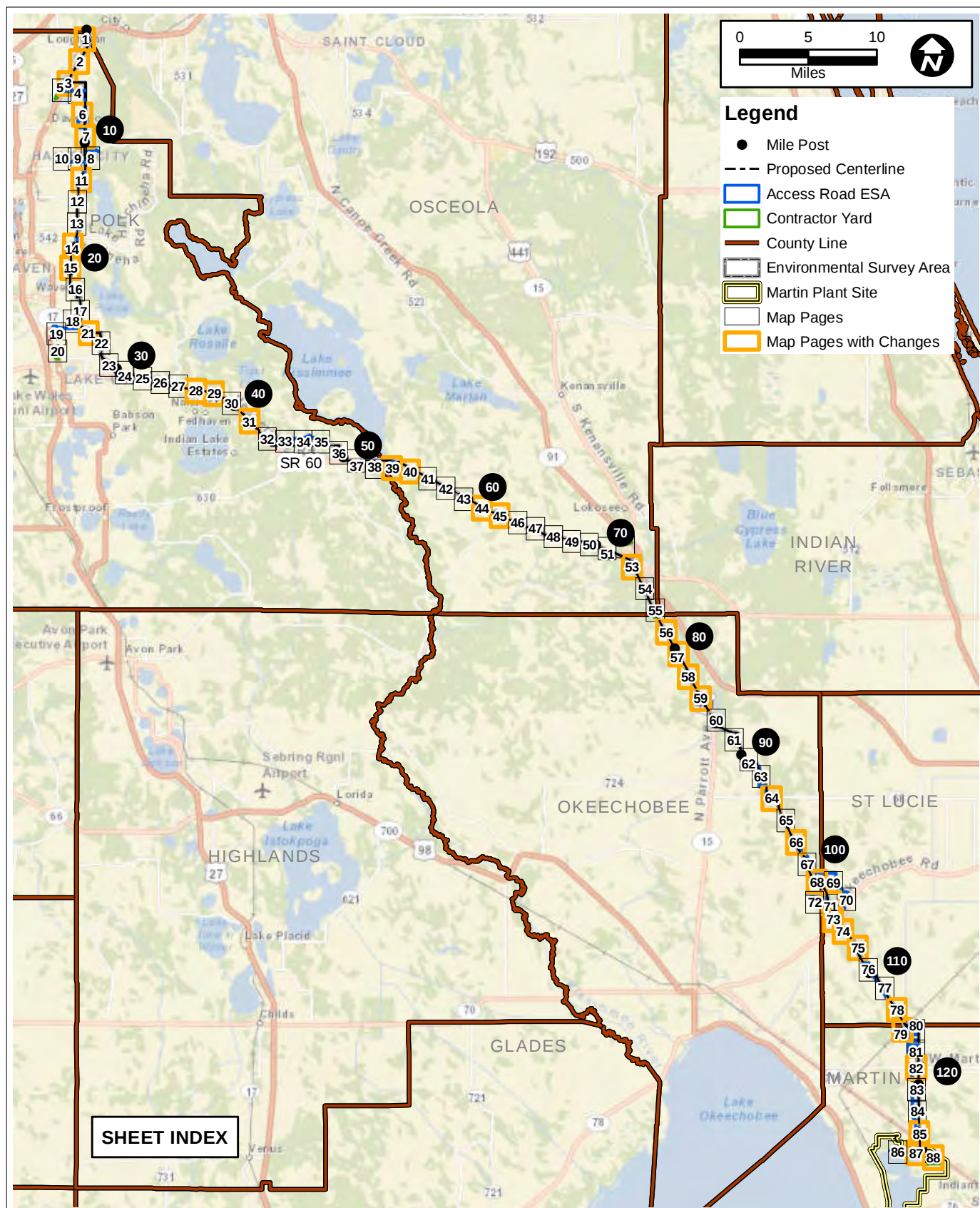

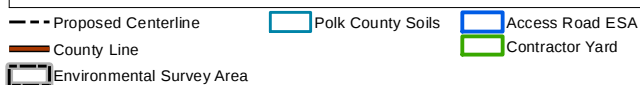


FIGURE 6. (SHEET 6 of 88)

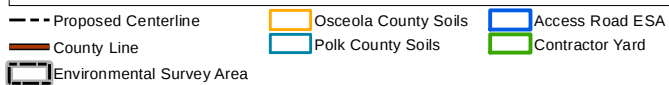
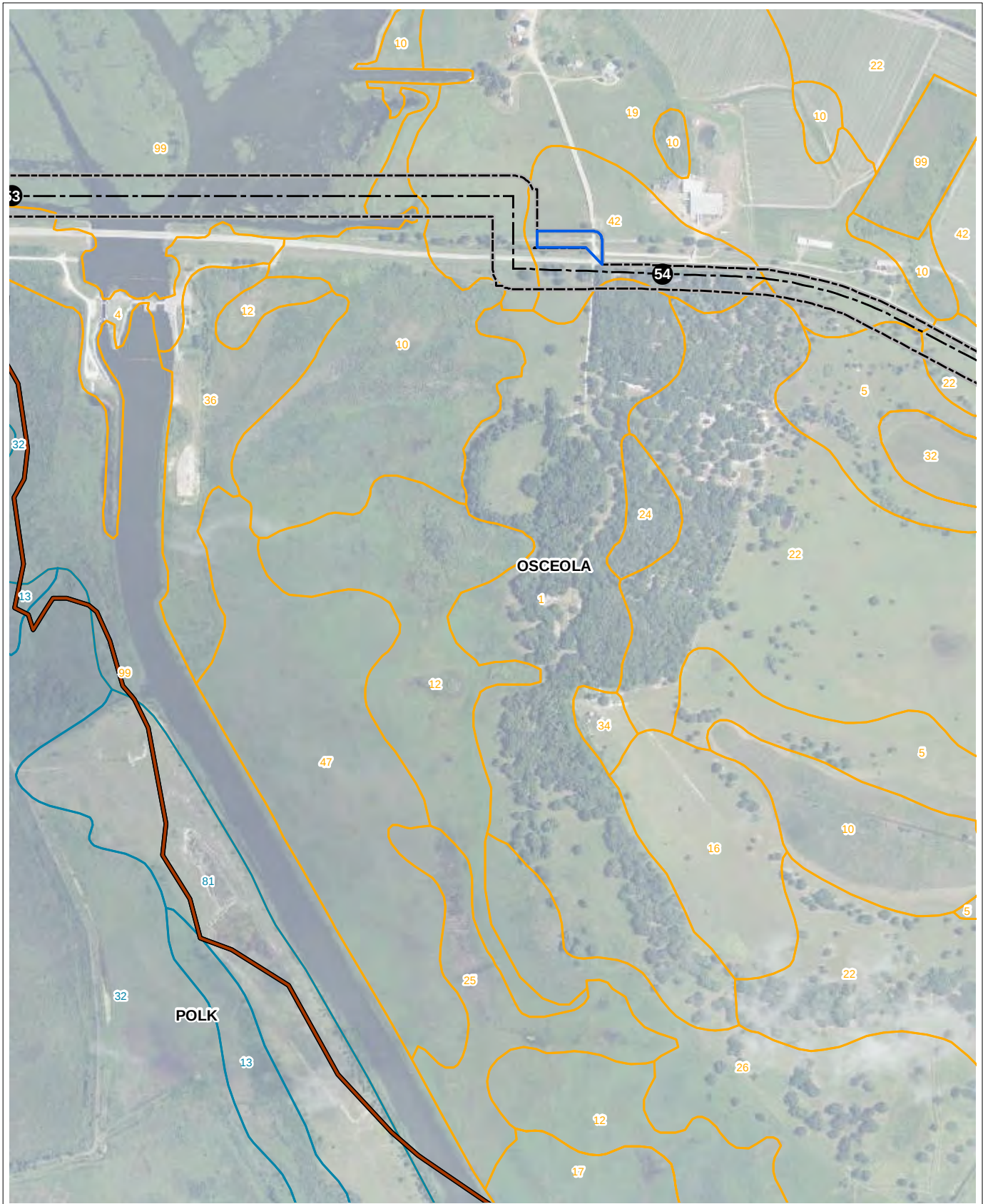


FIGURE 6. (SHEET 31 of 88)

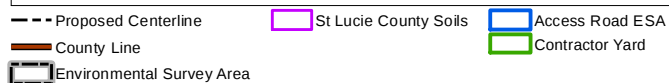
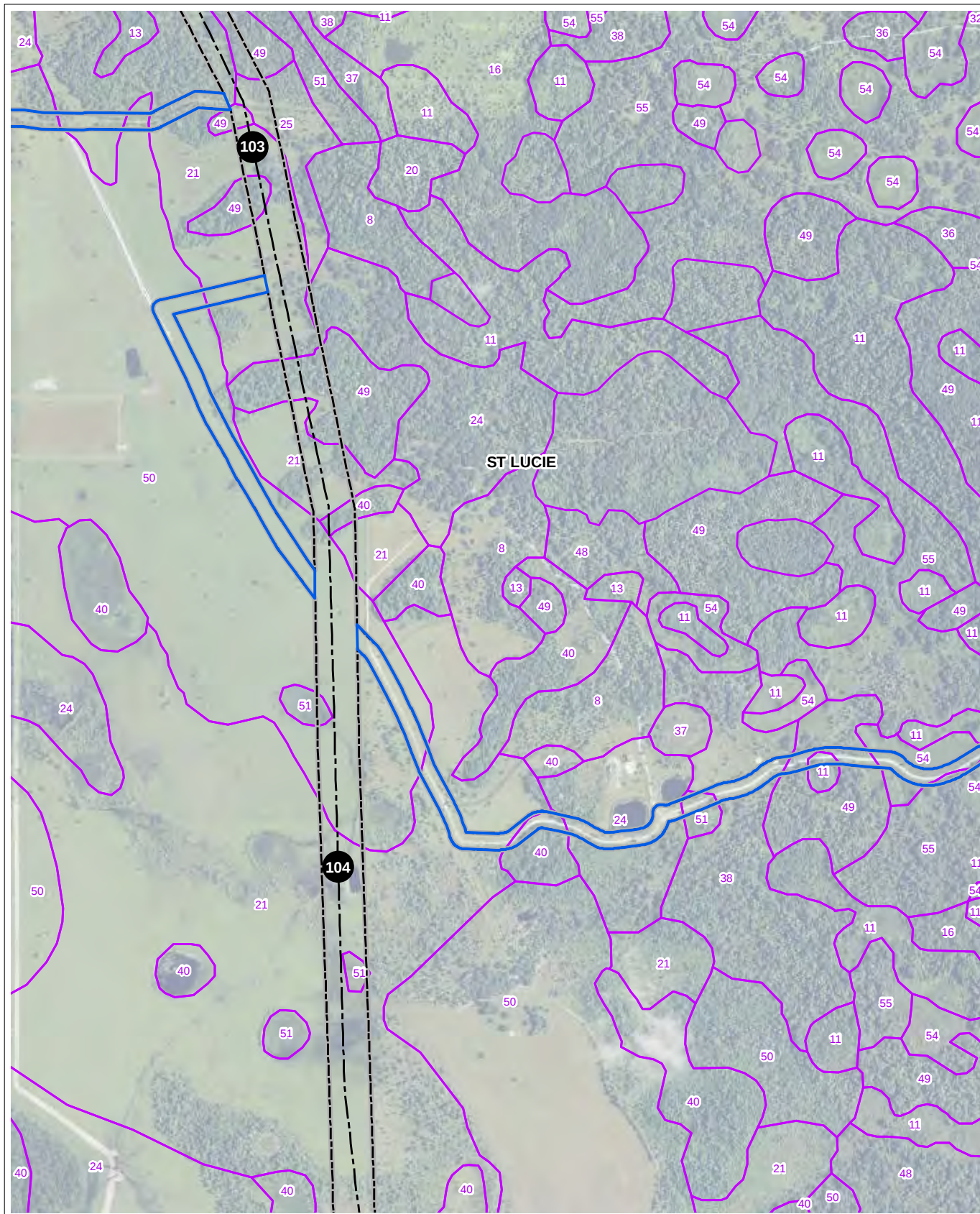


FIGURE 6. (SHEET 68 of 88)

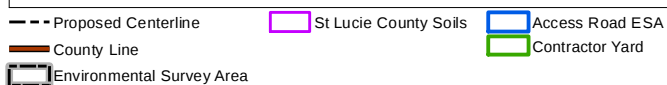


FIGURE 6. (SHEET 74 of 88)

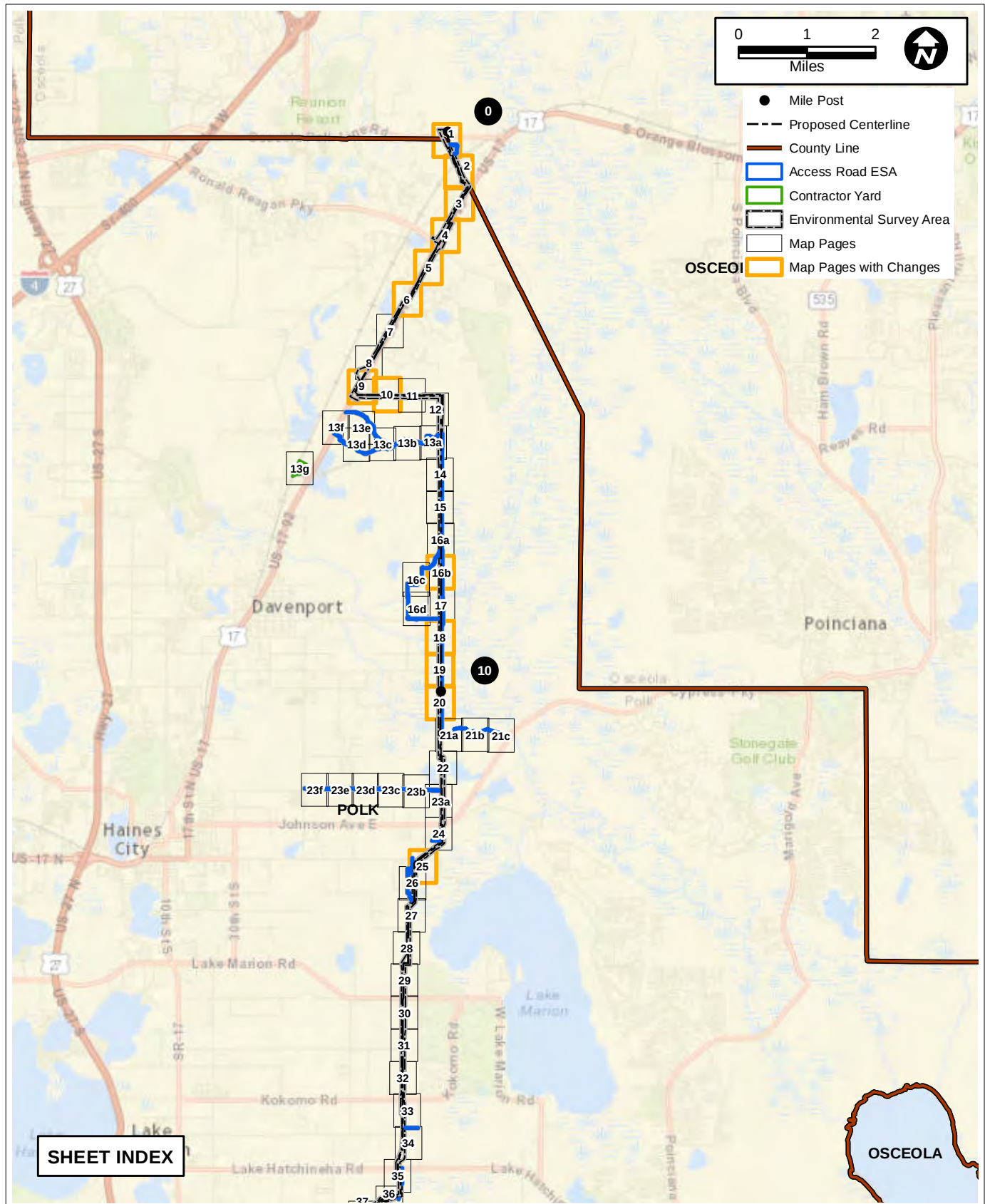


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 1 of 7)

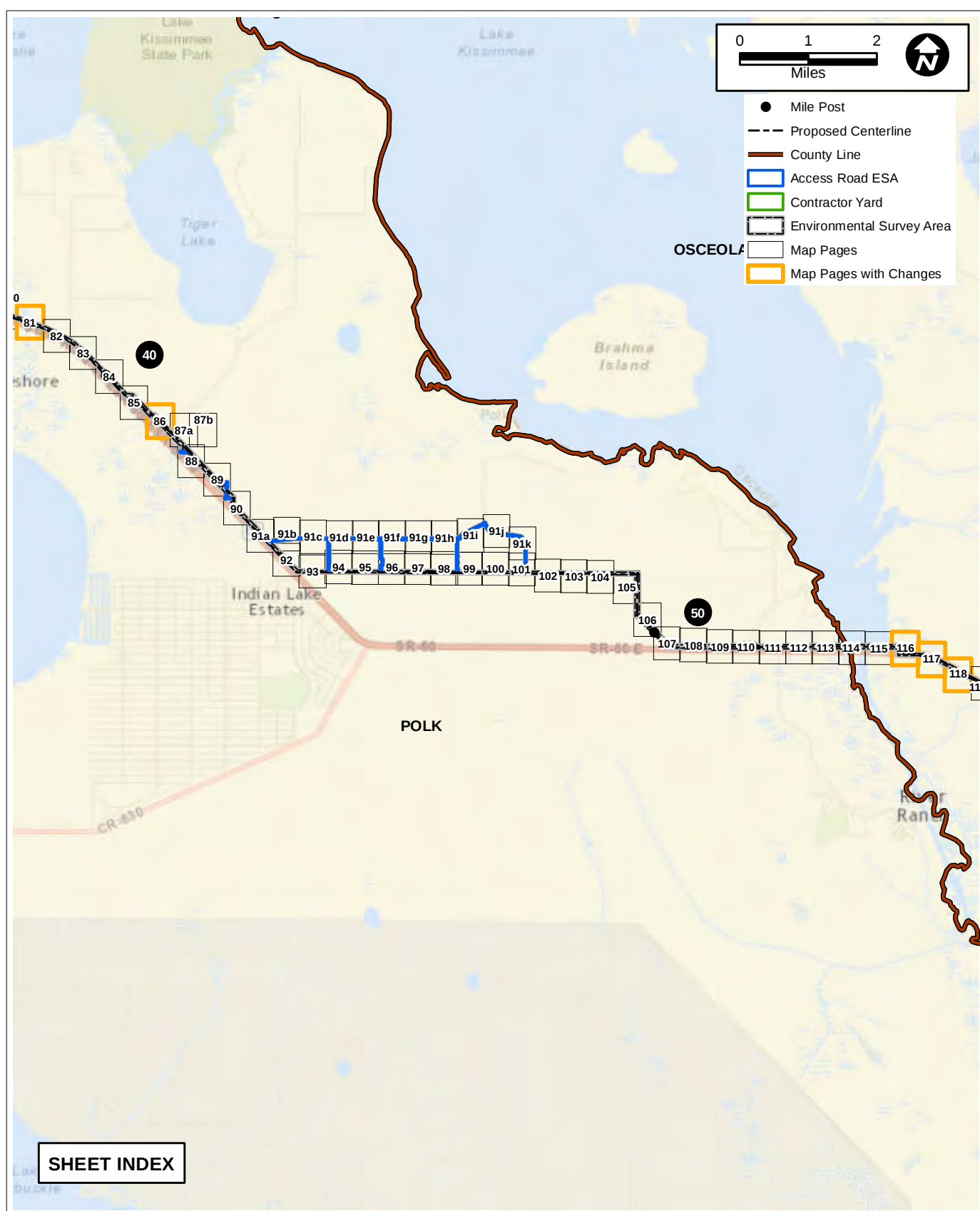


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 3 of 7)

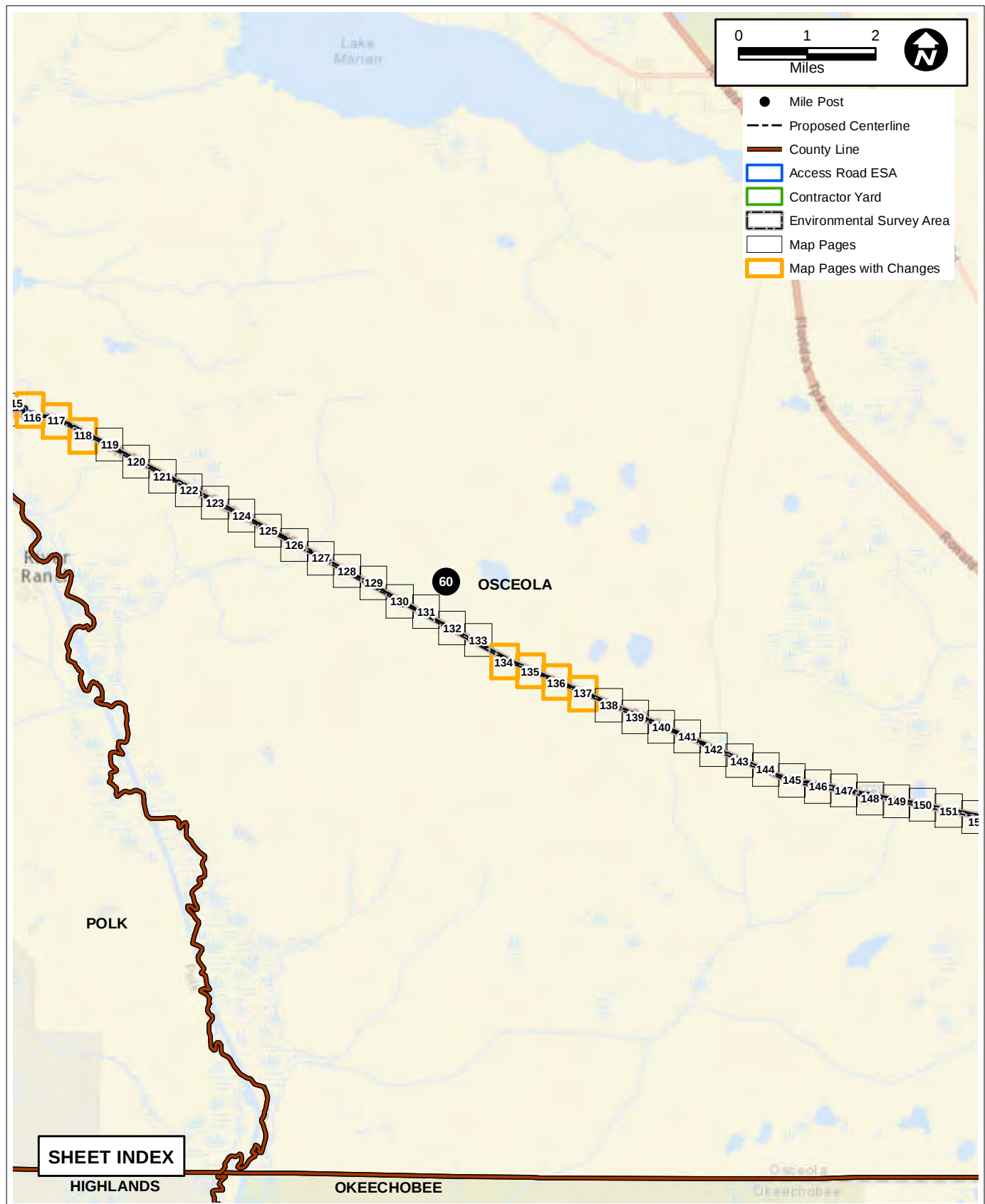


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 4 of 7)

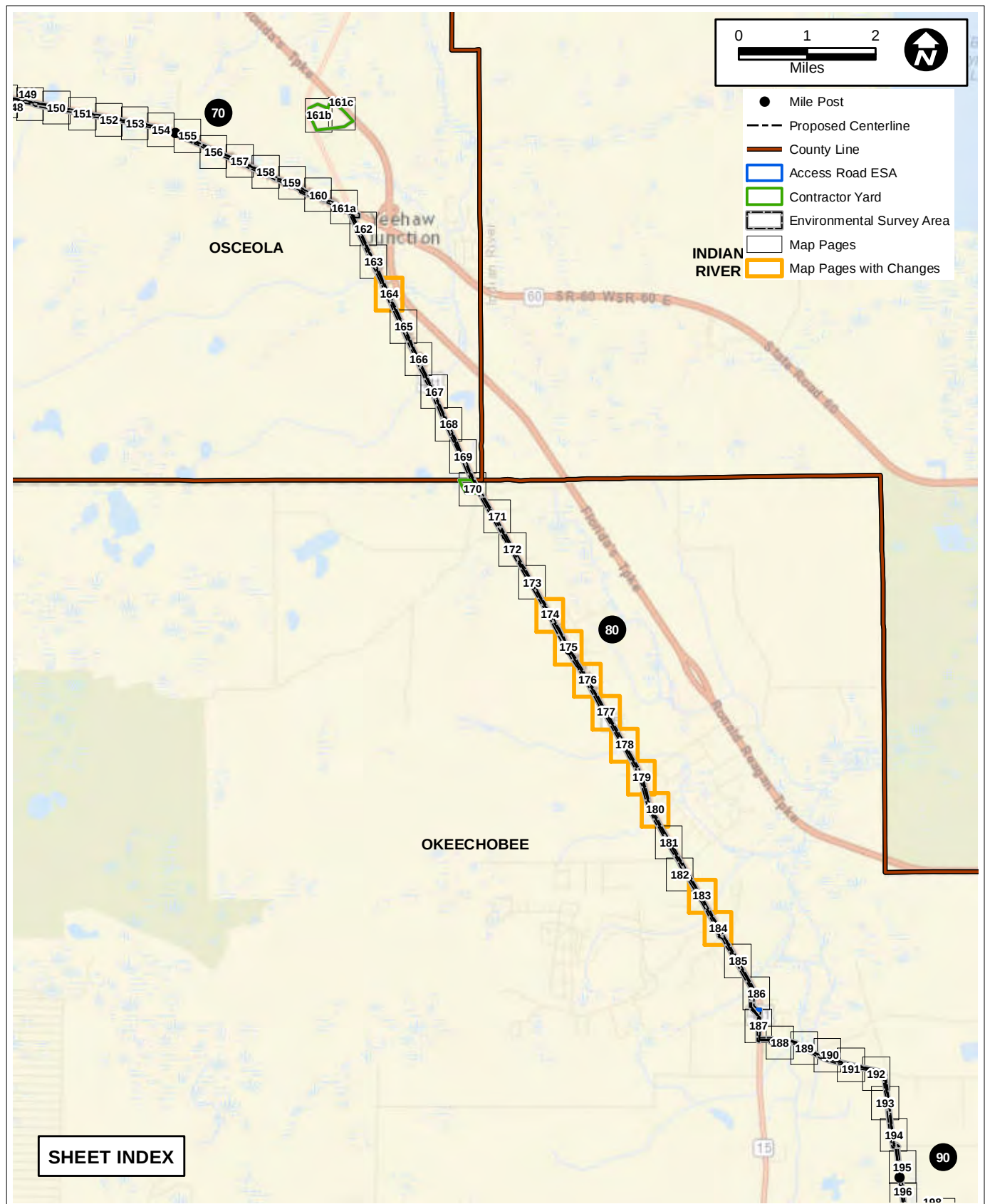
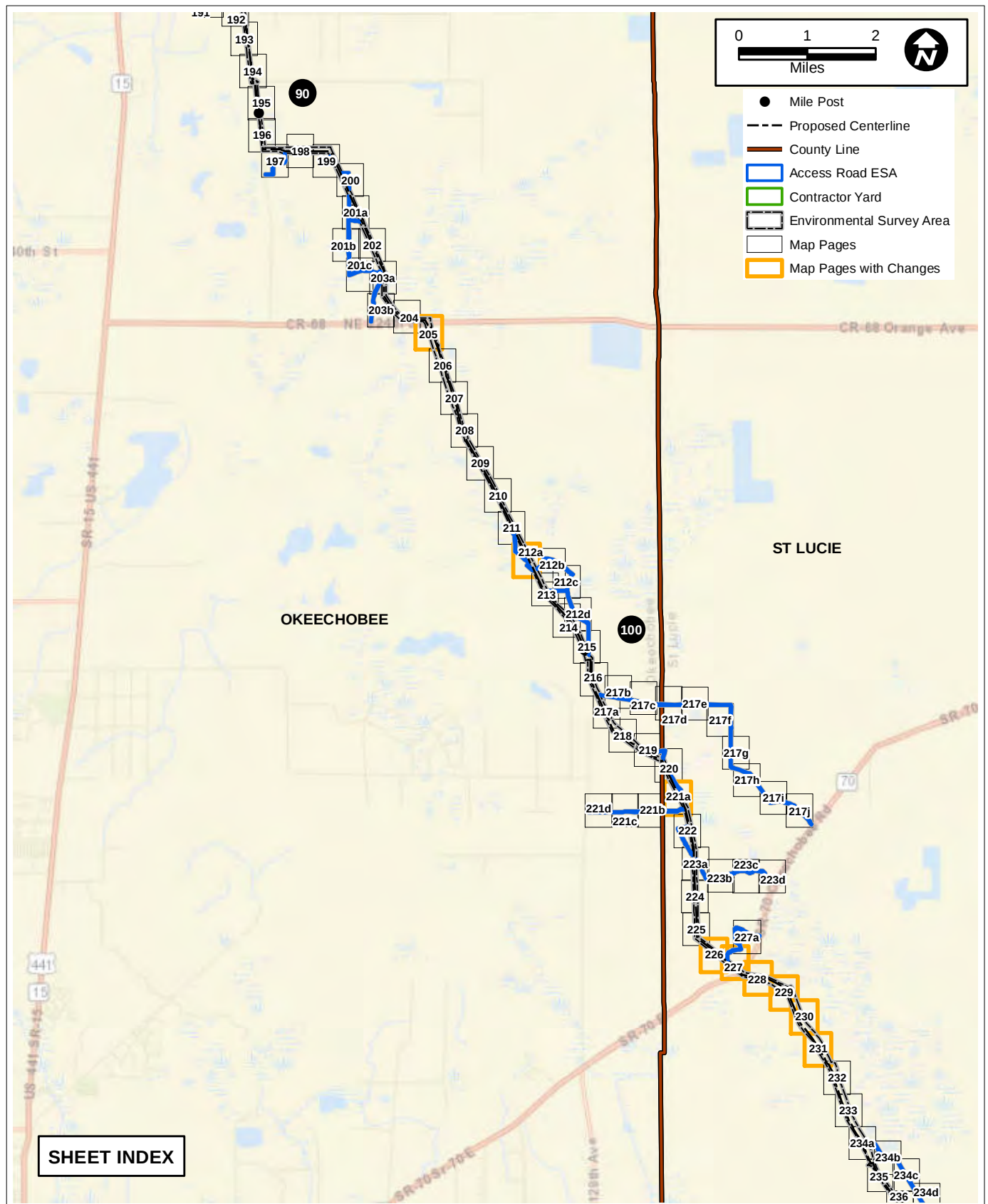


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 5 of 7)

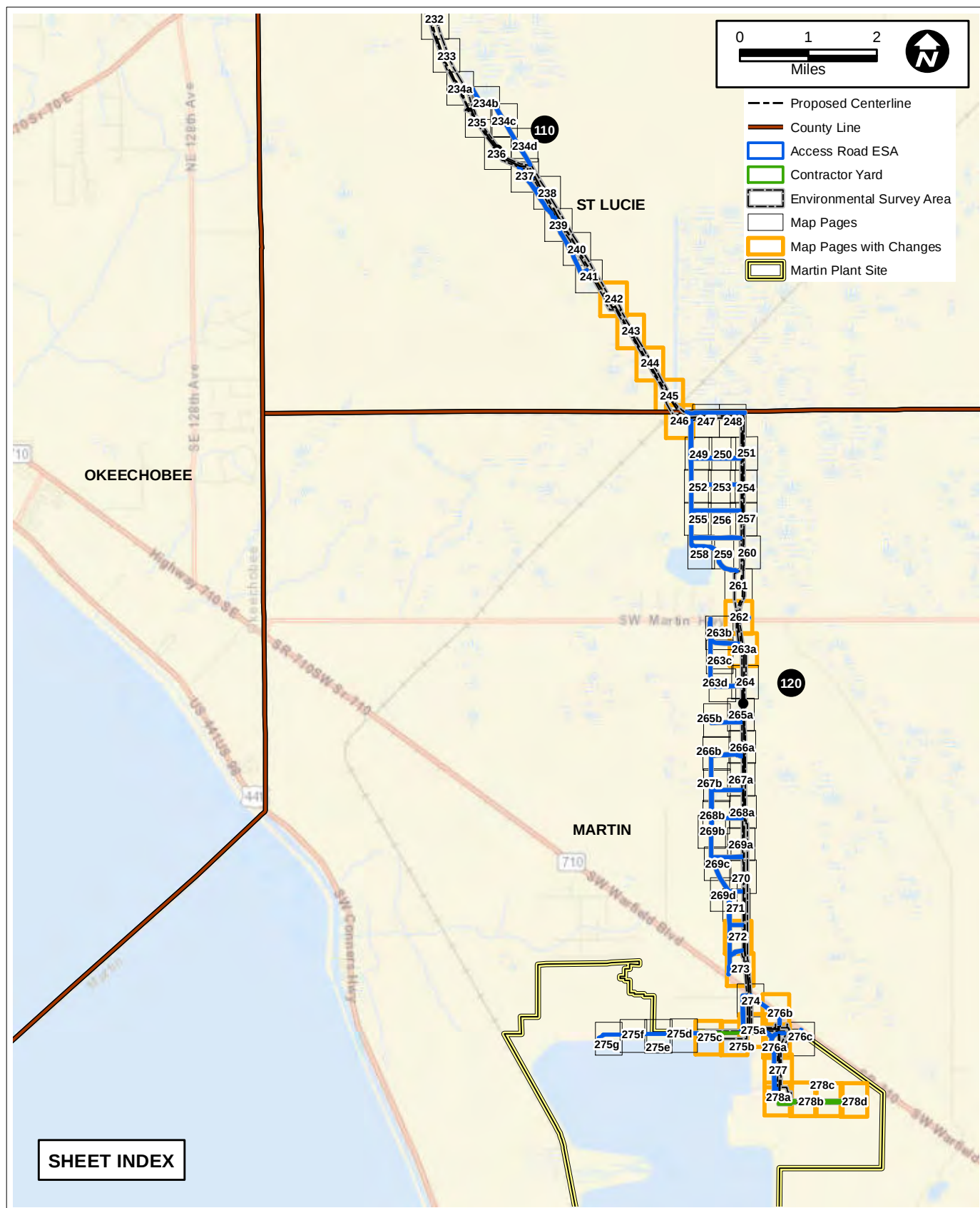


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 7 of 7)

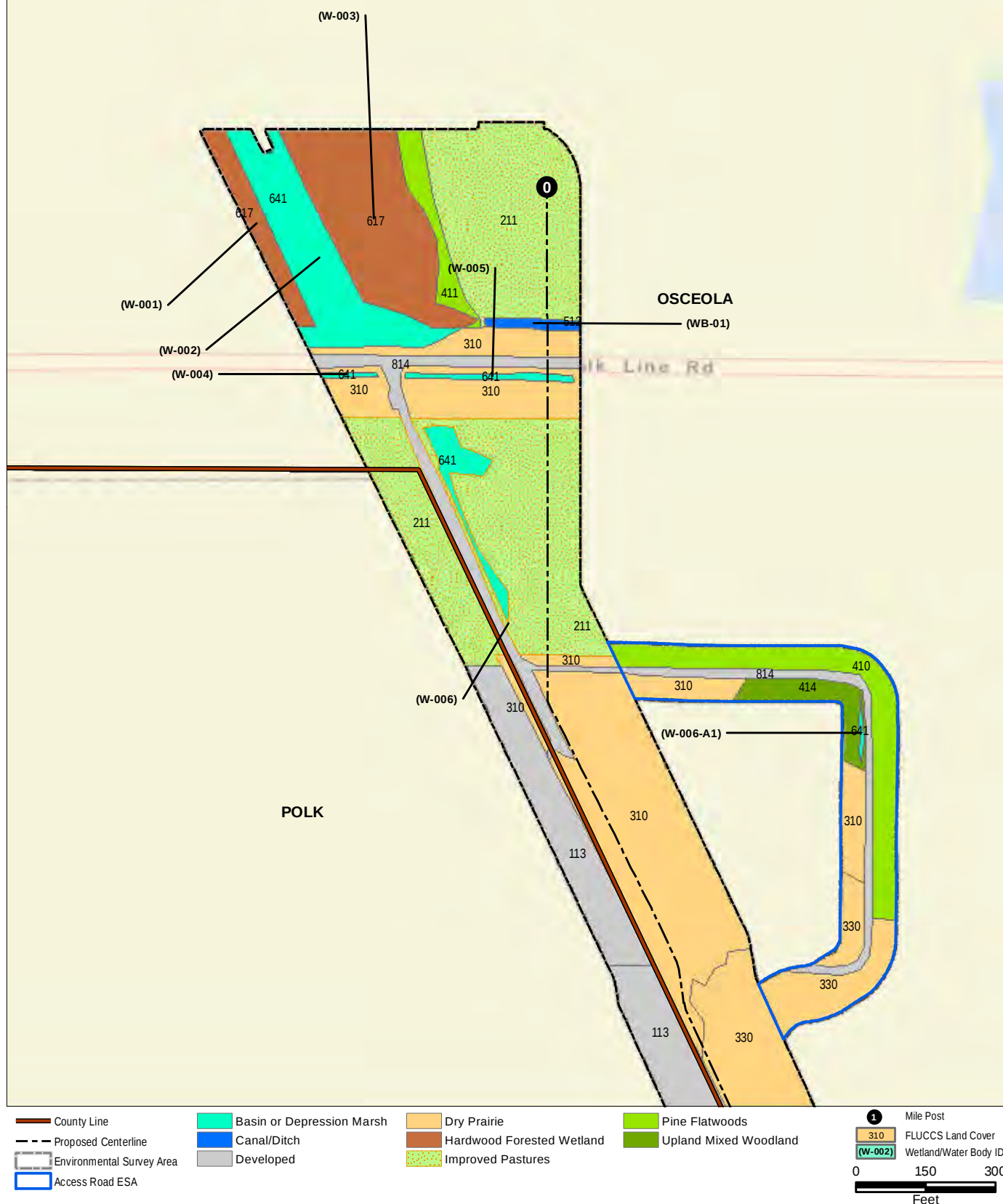


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 1)

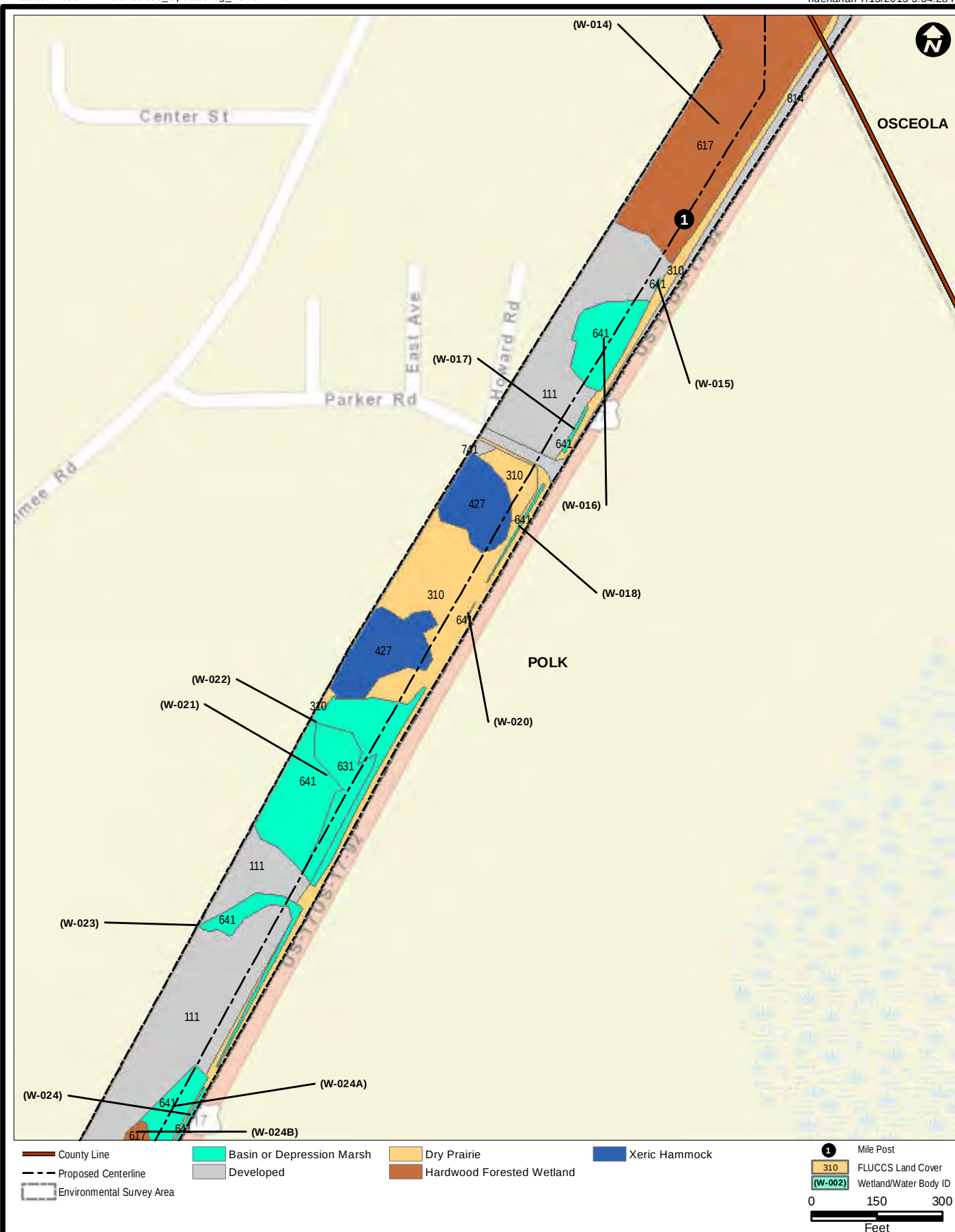


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 3)

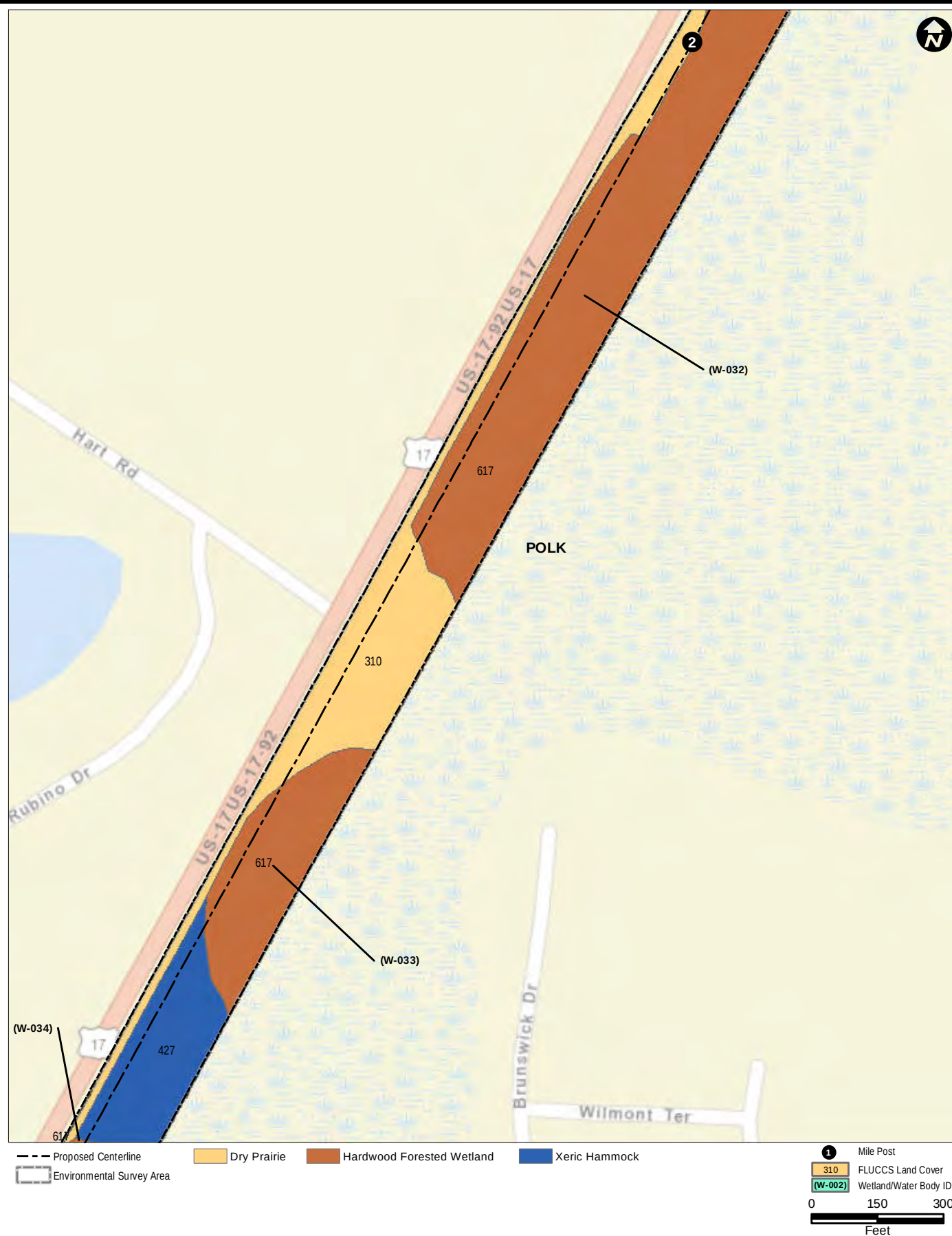


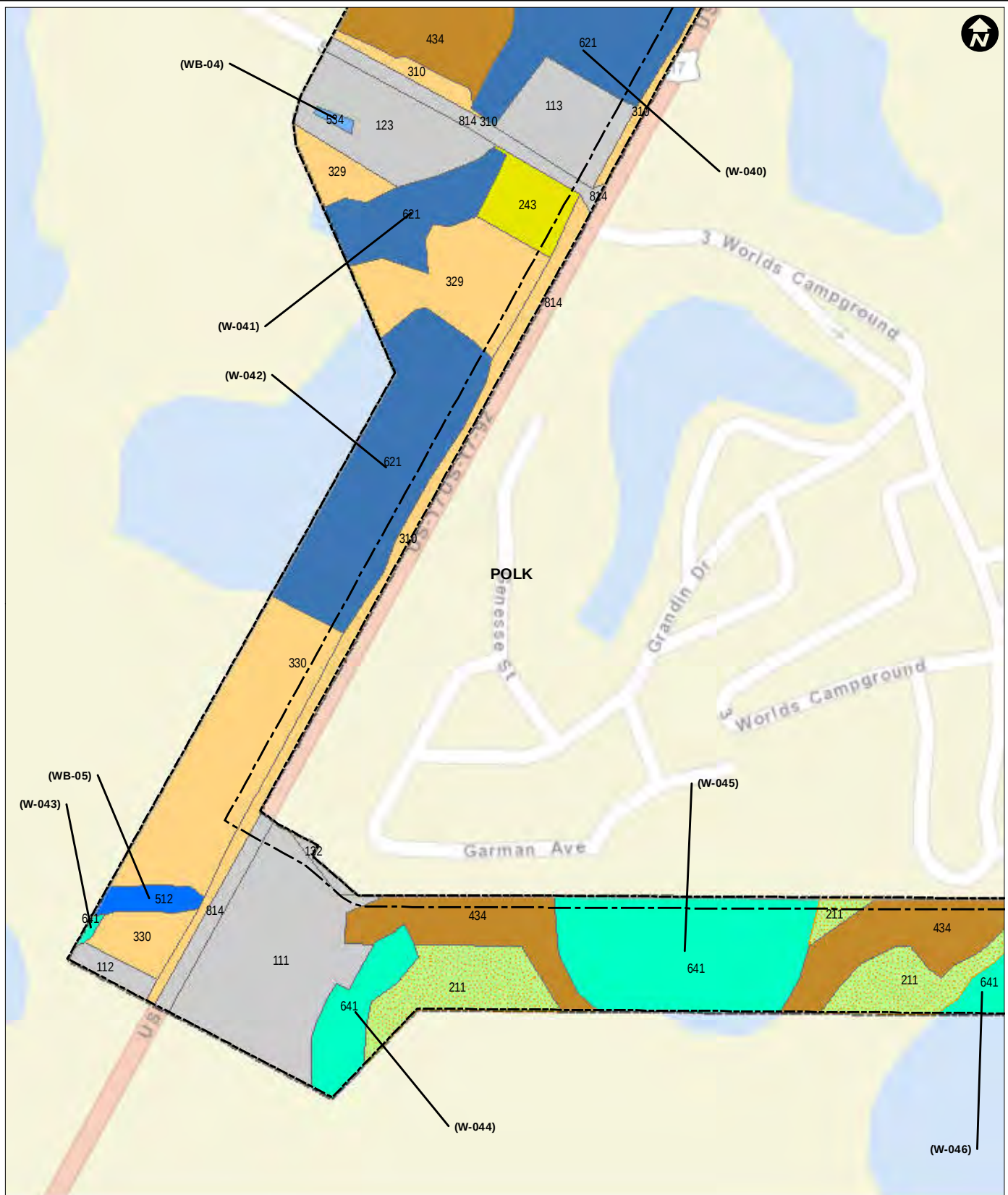
FIGURE 7. (SHEET 5)

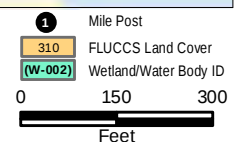


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 9)

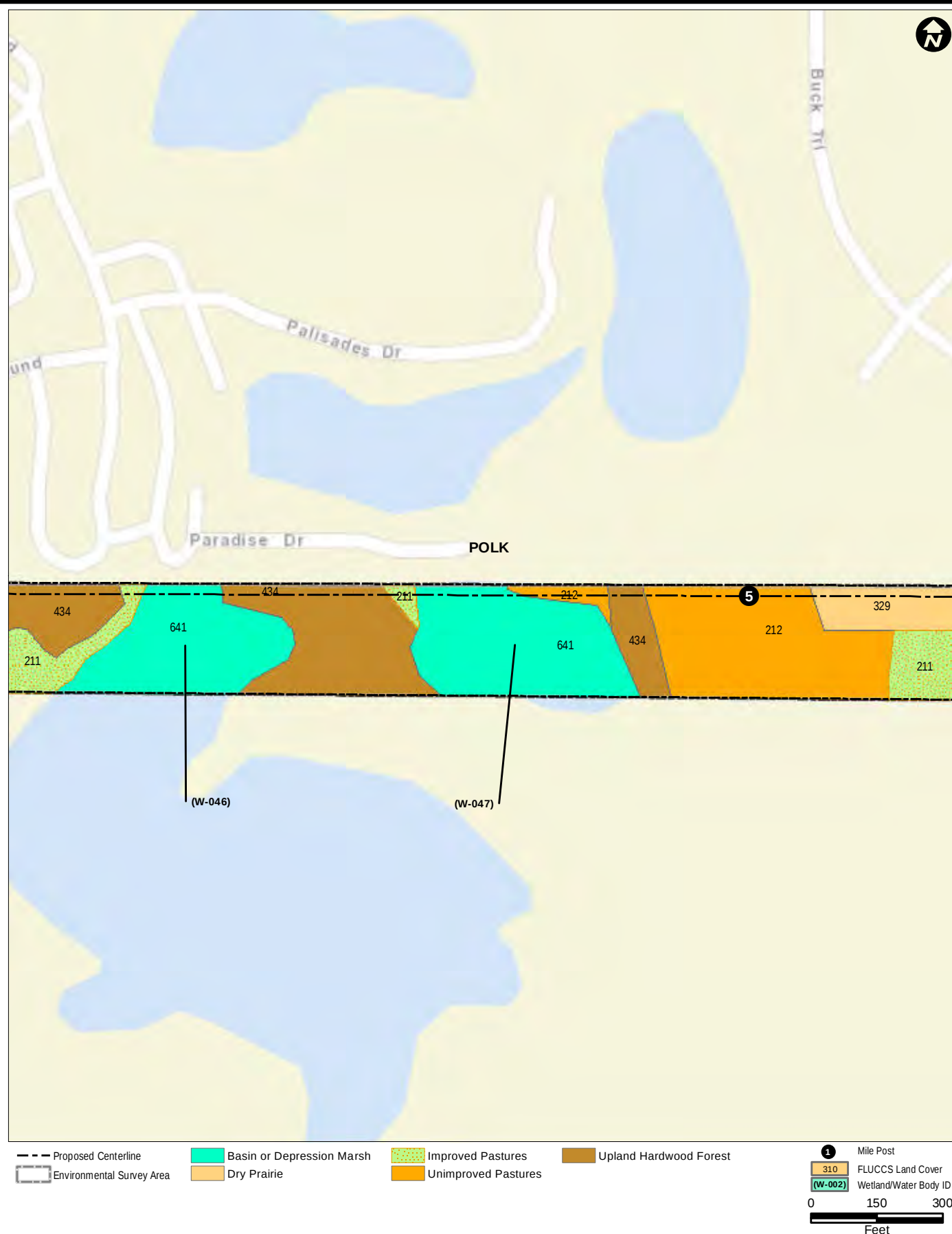


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 10)

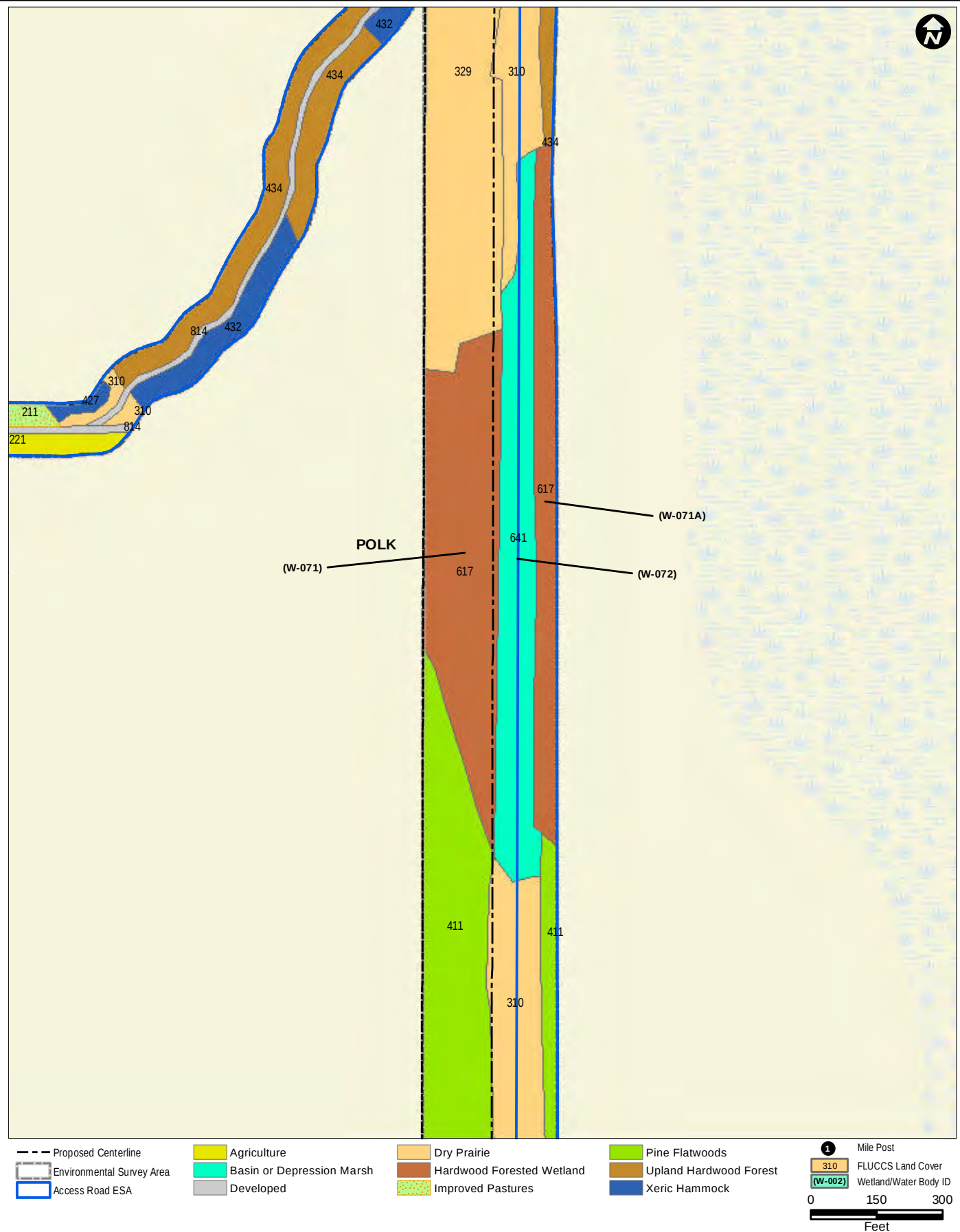
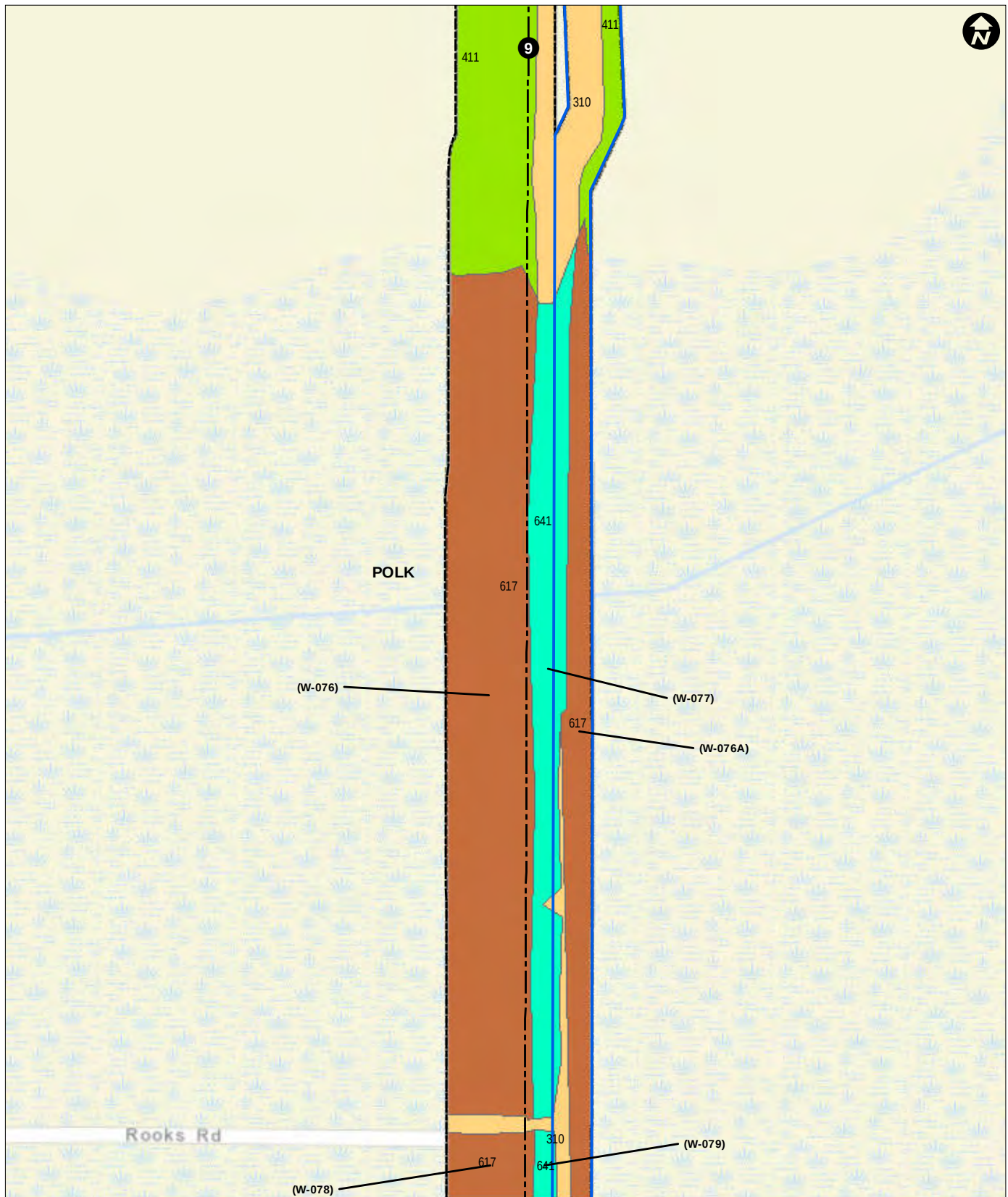


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 16b)

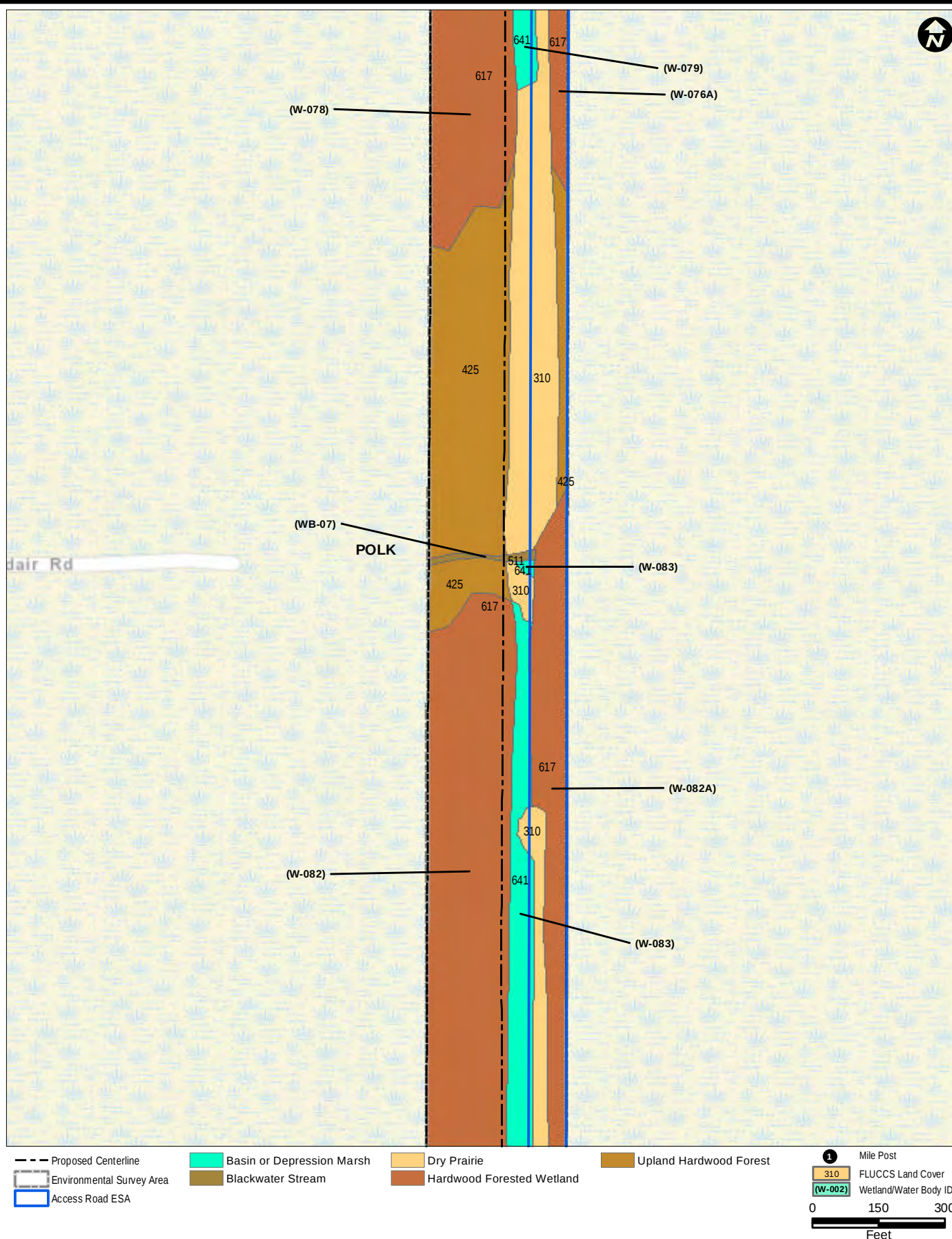


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 19)

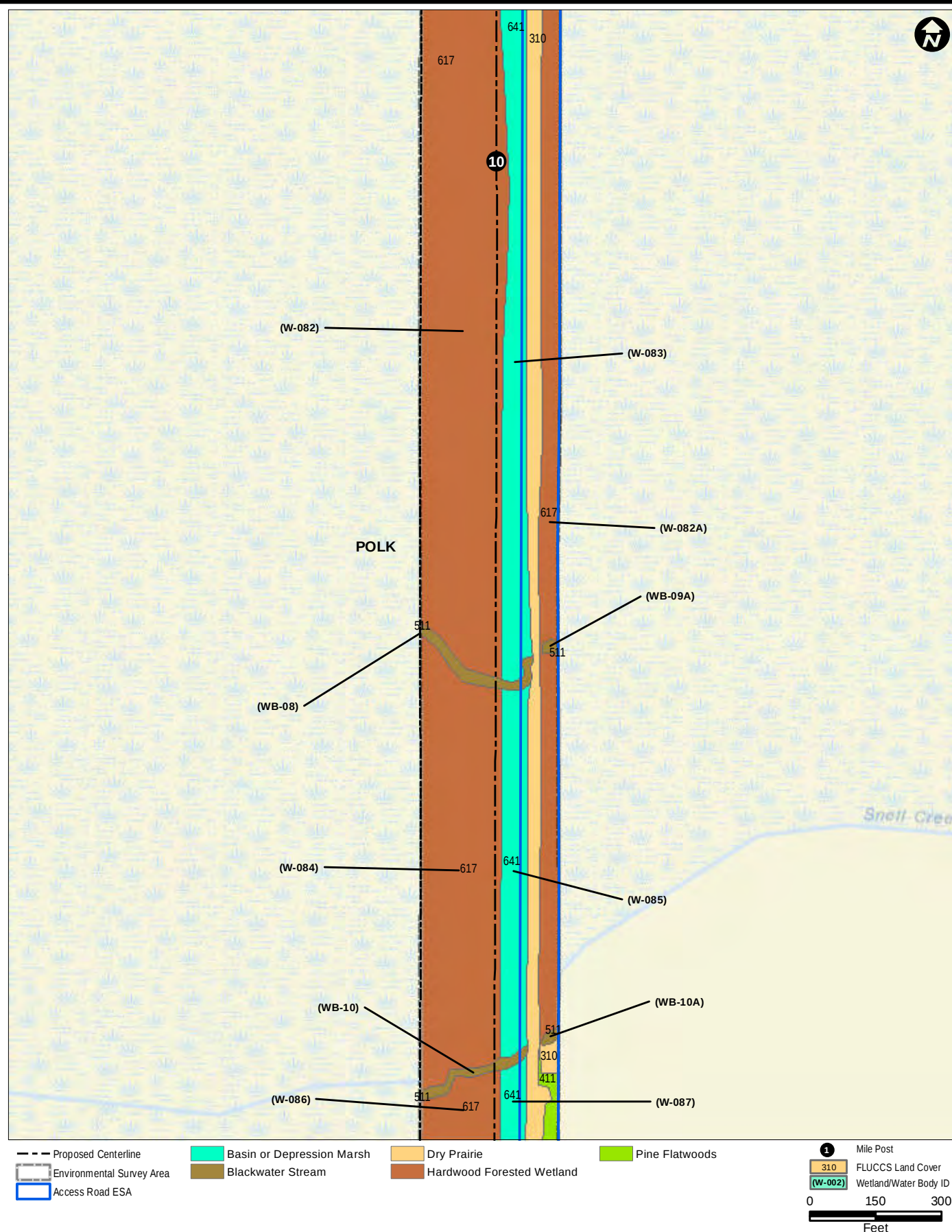


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 20)

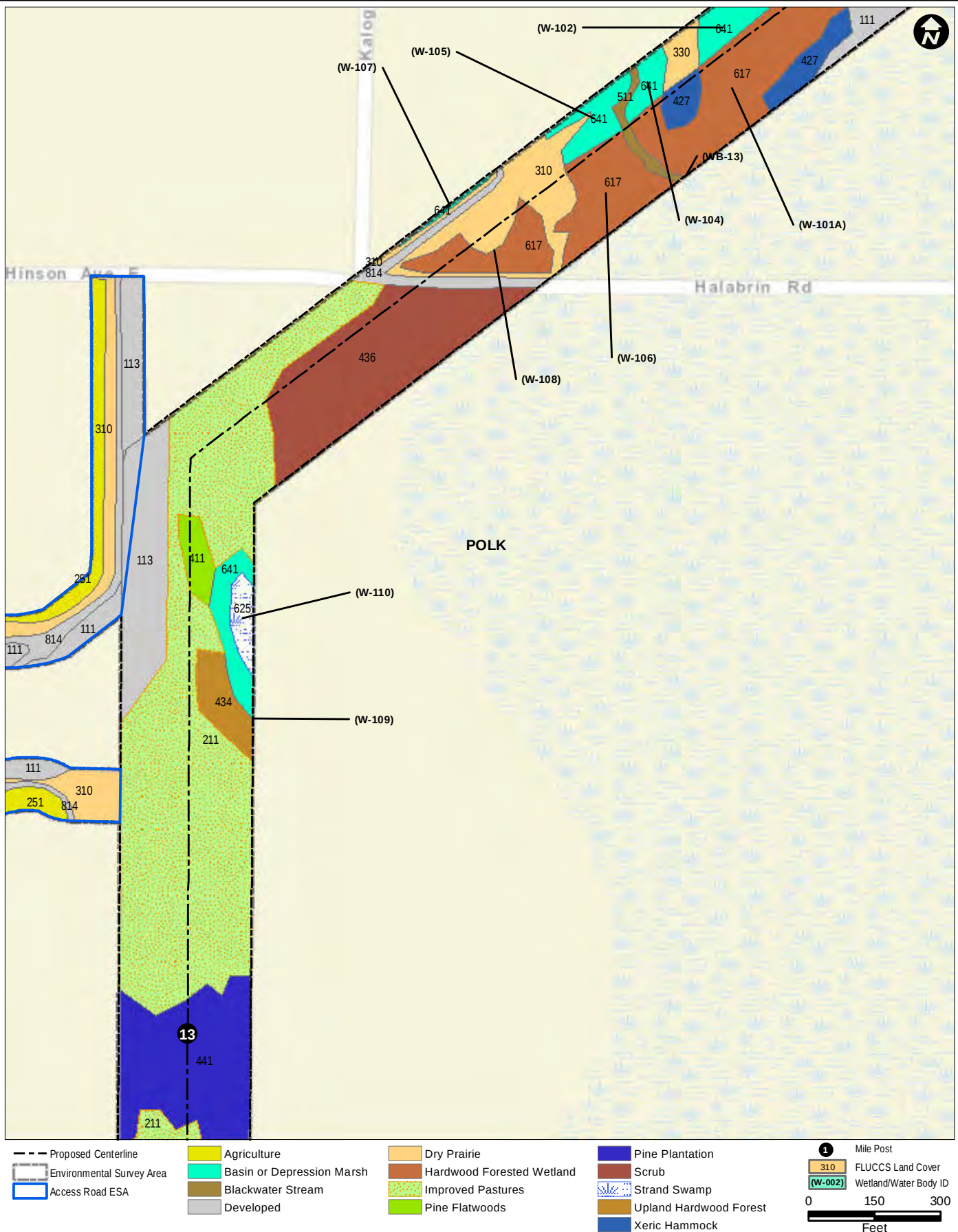


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 25)

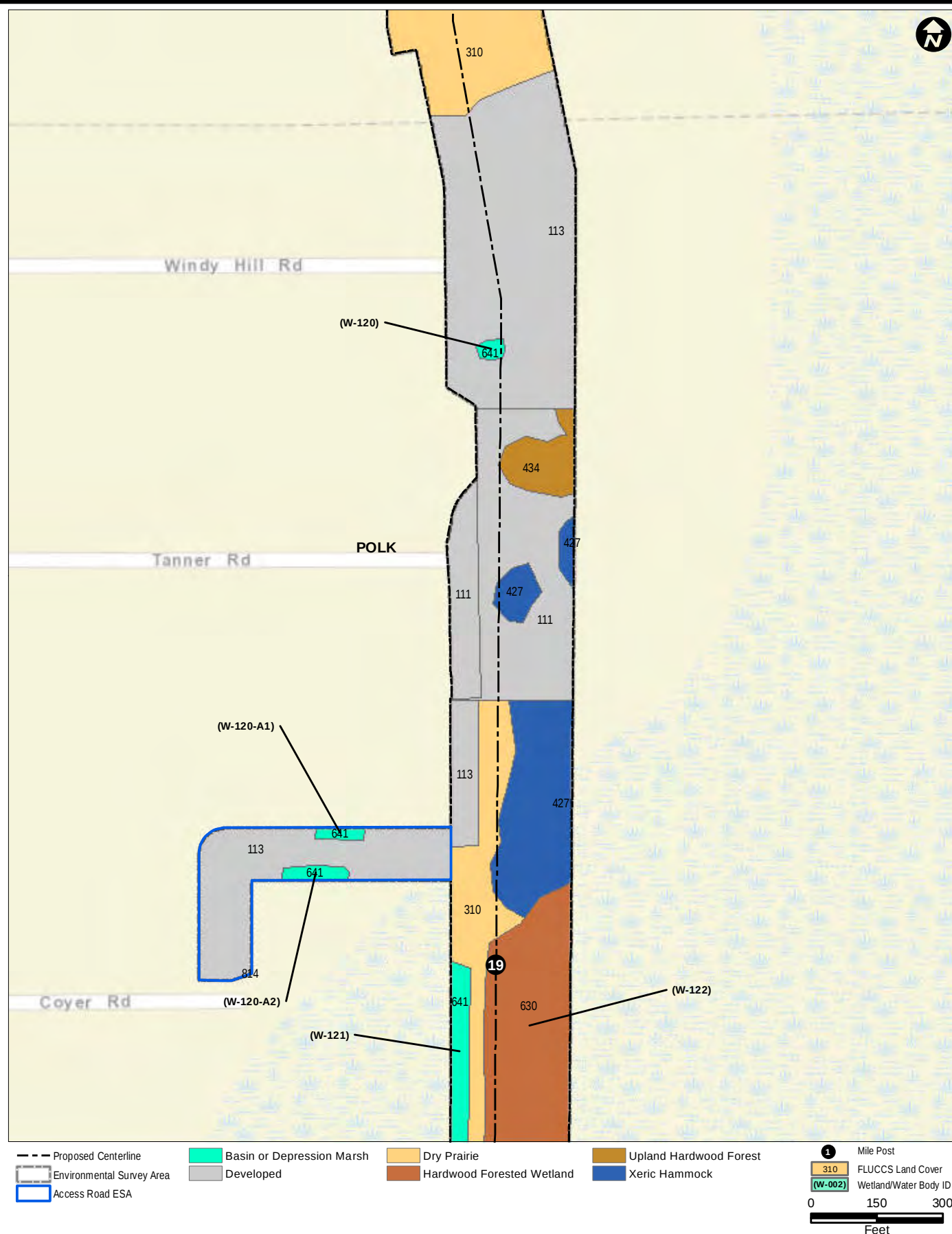


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 38)

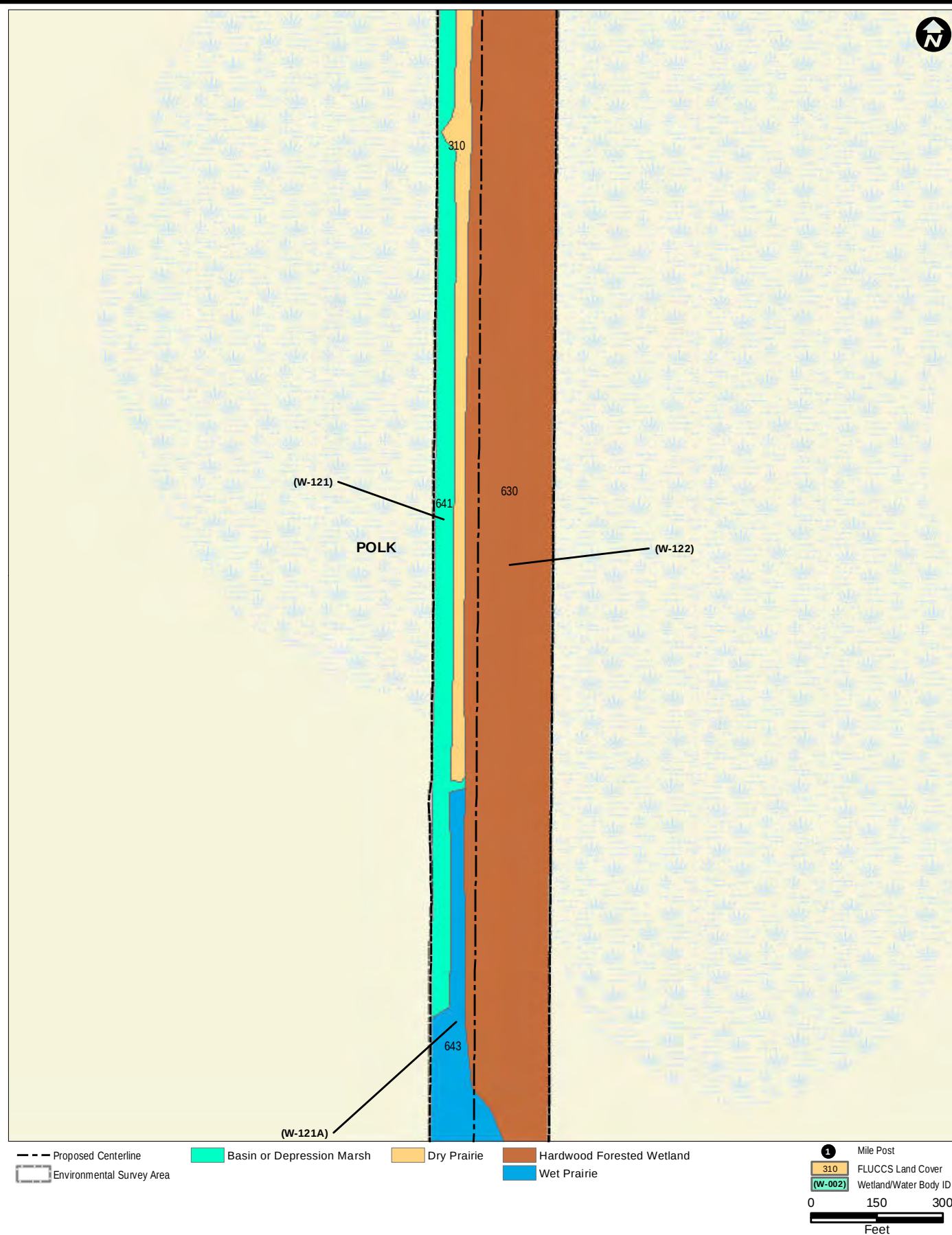


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 39)

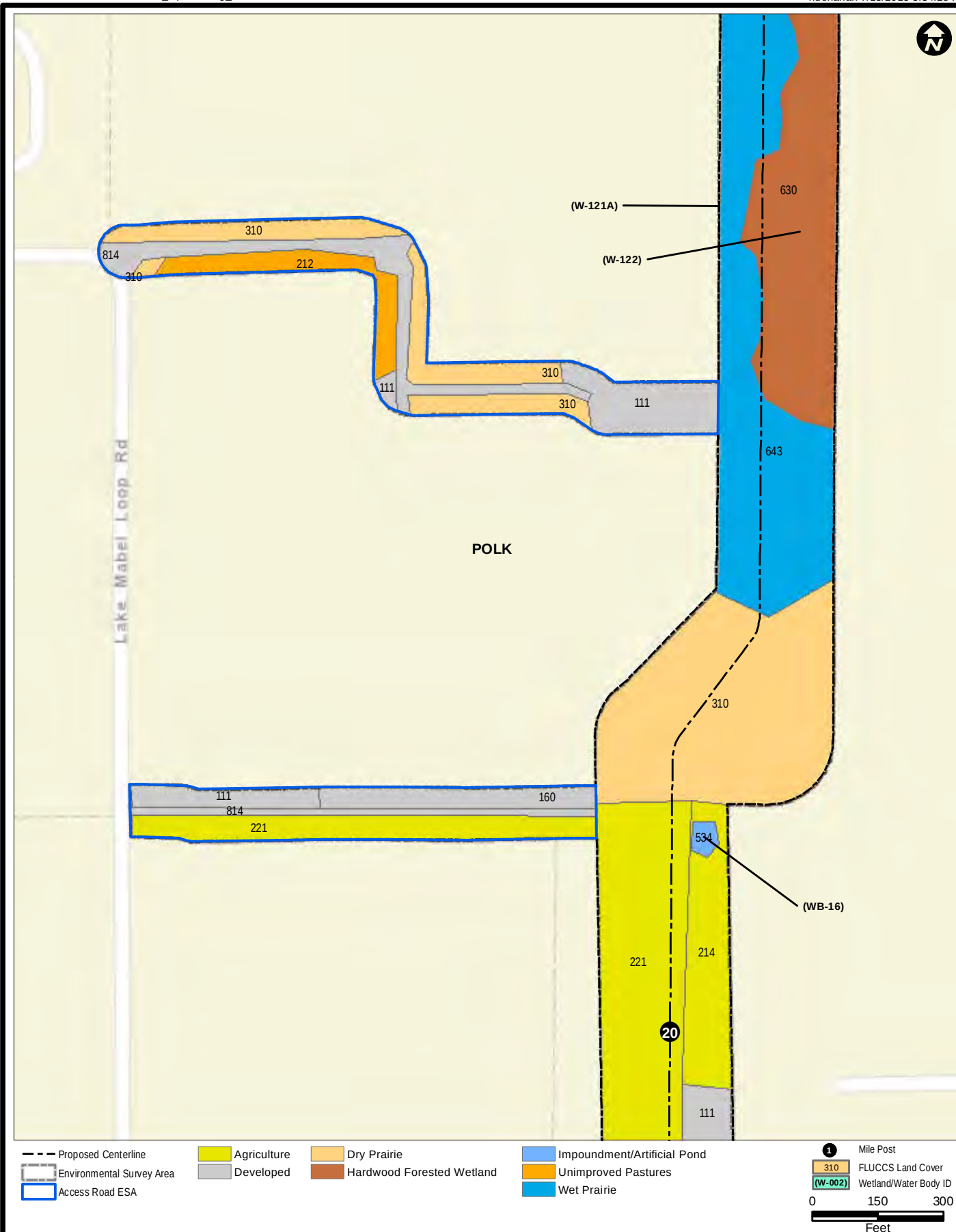
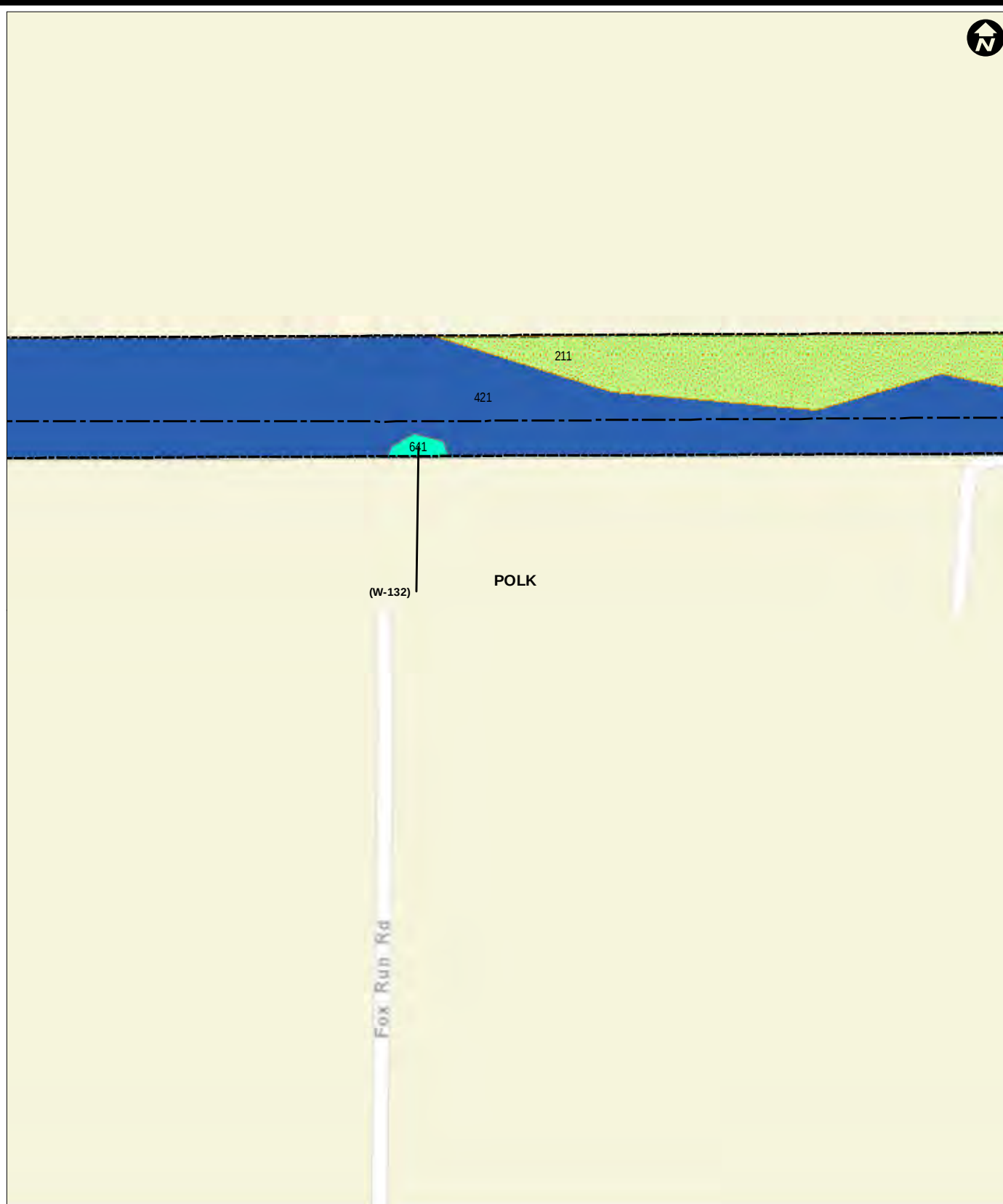


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 40)

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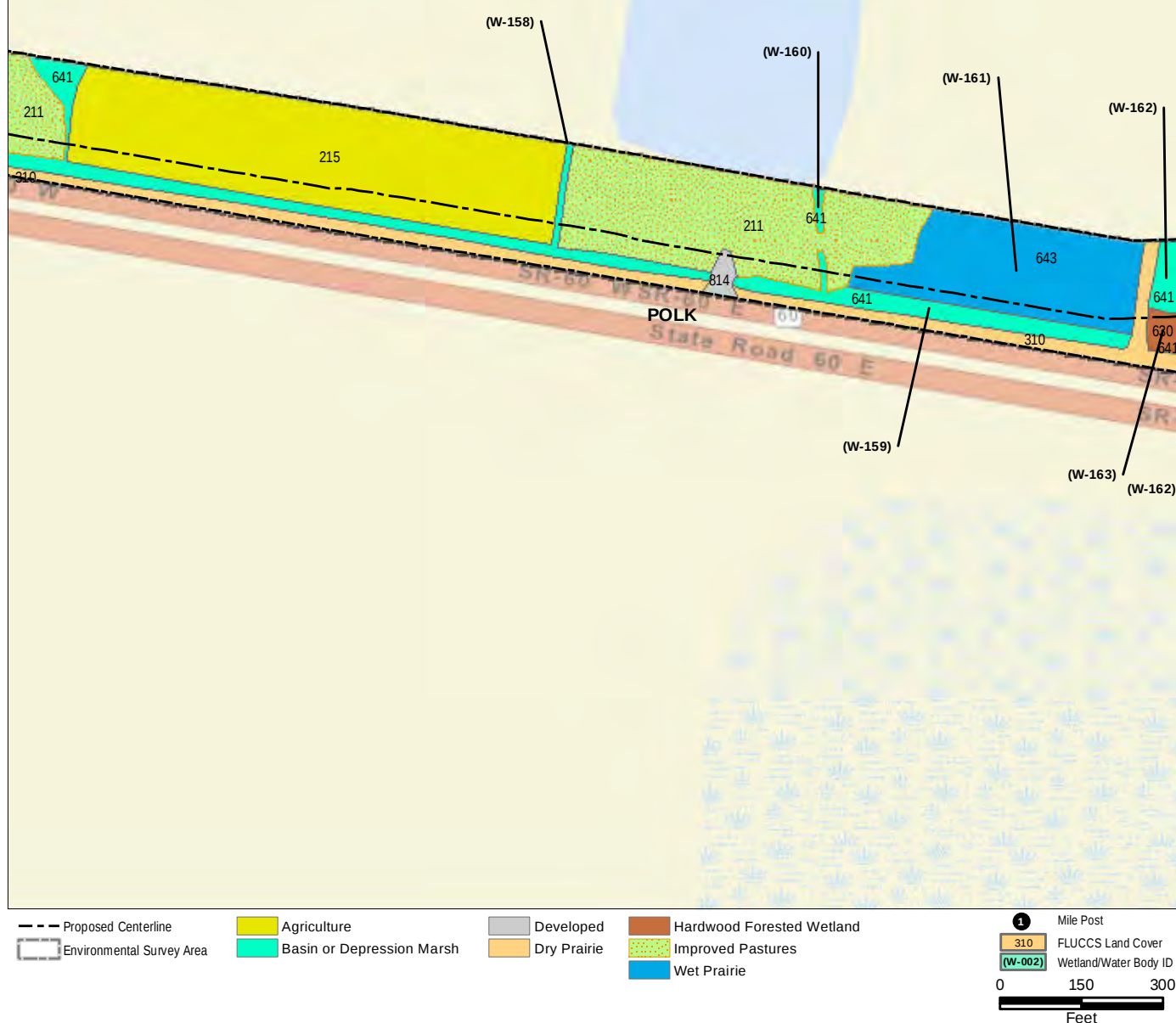


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 76)

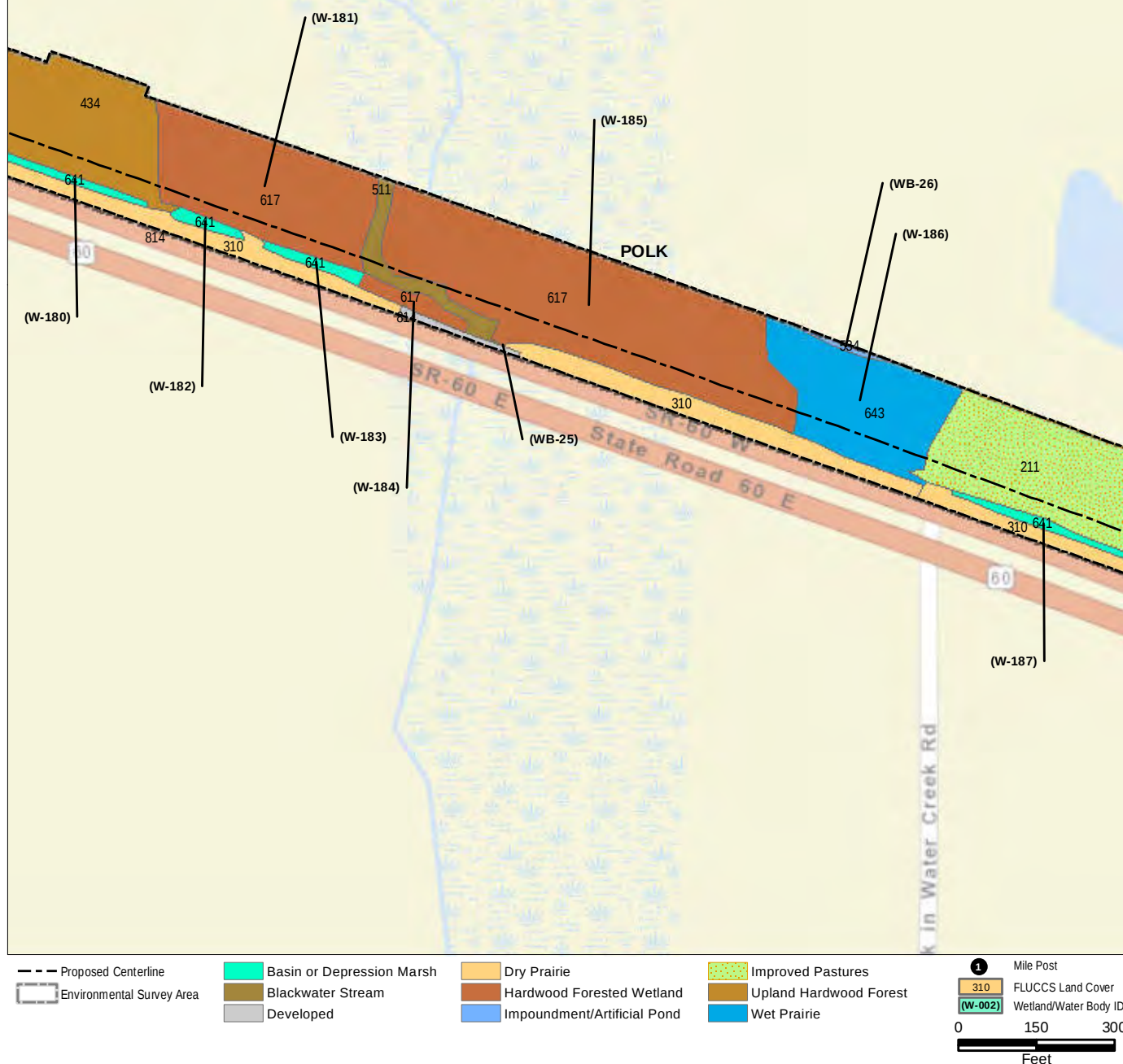


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 81)

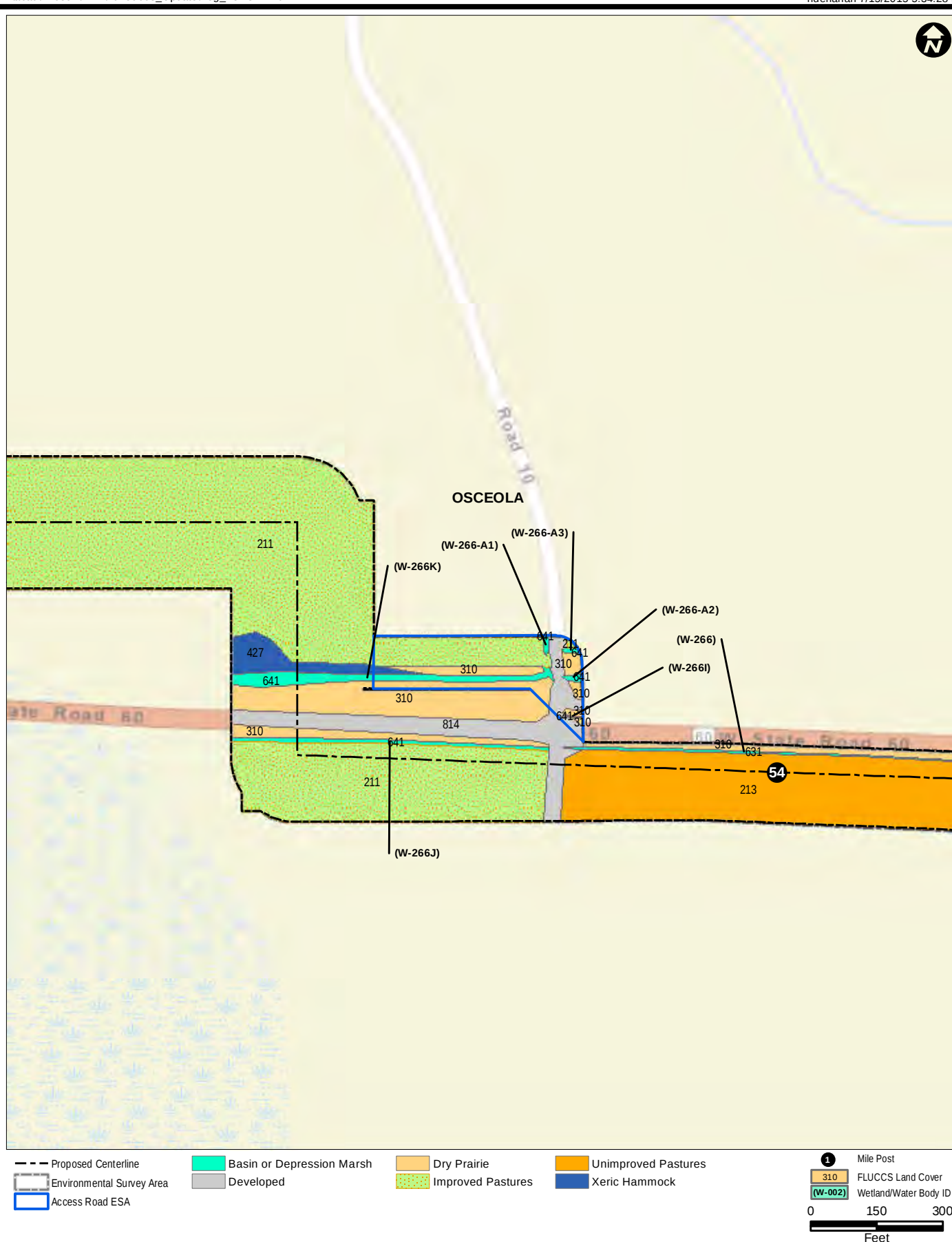


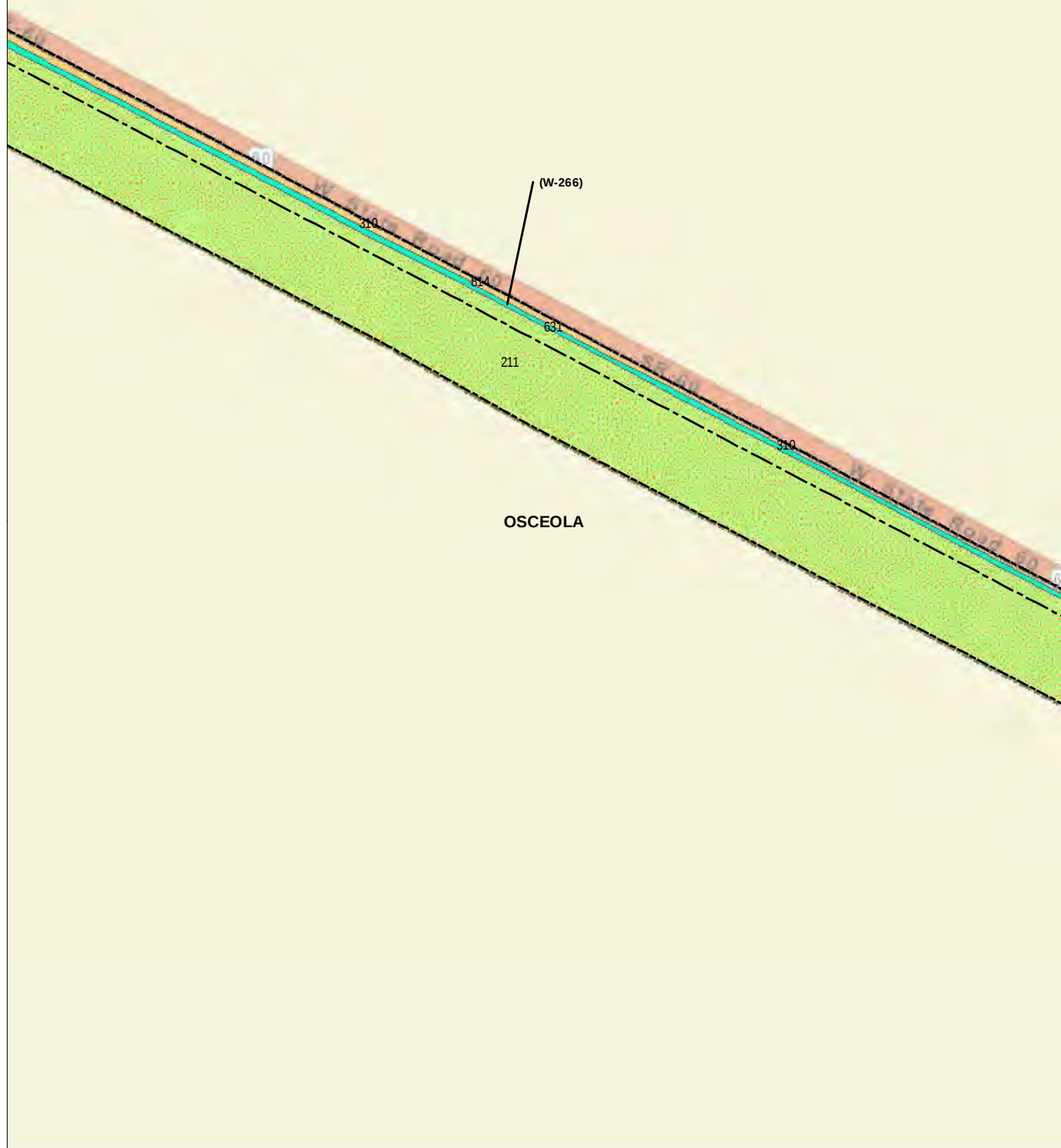
FIGURE 7. (SHEET 116)

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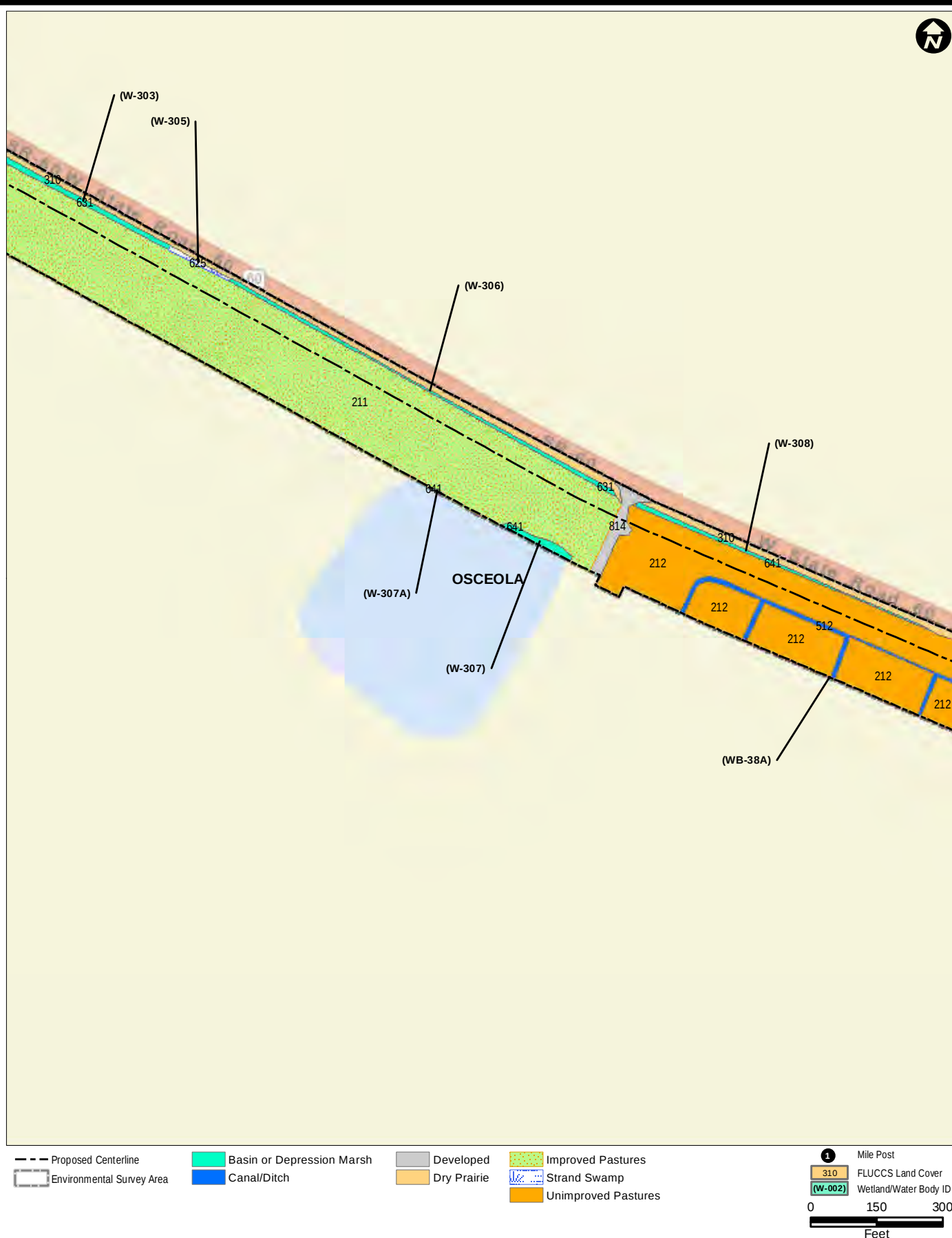


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 134)

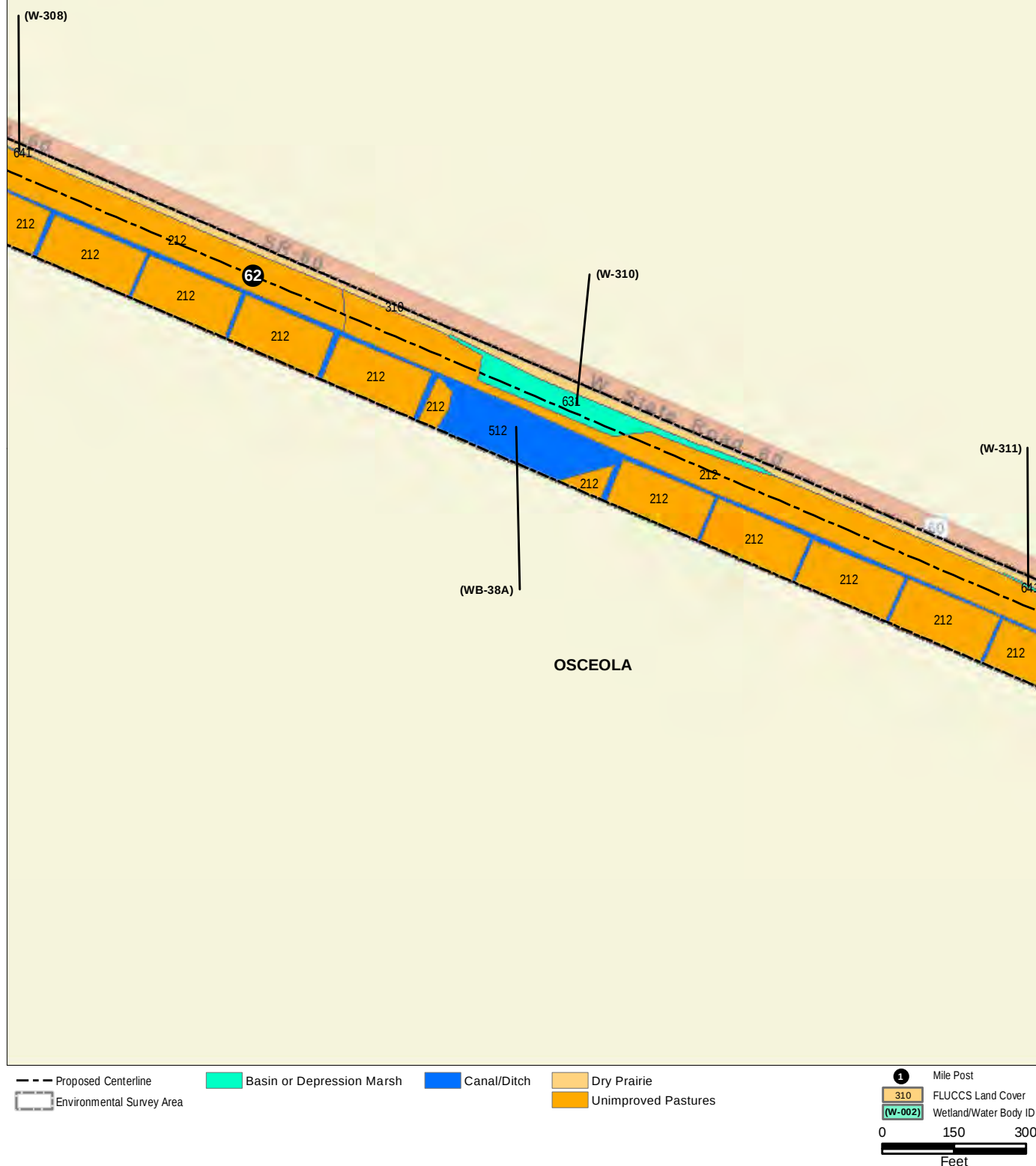


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 135)

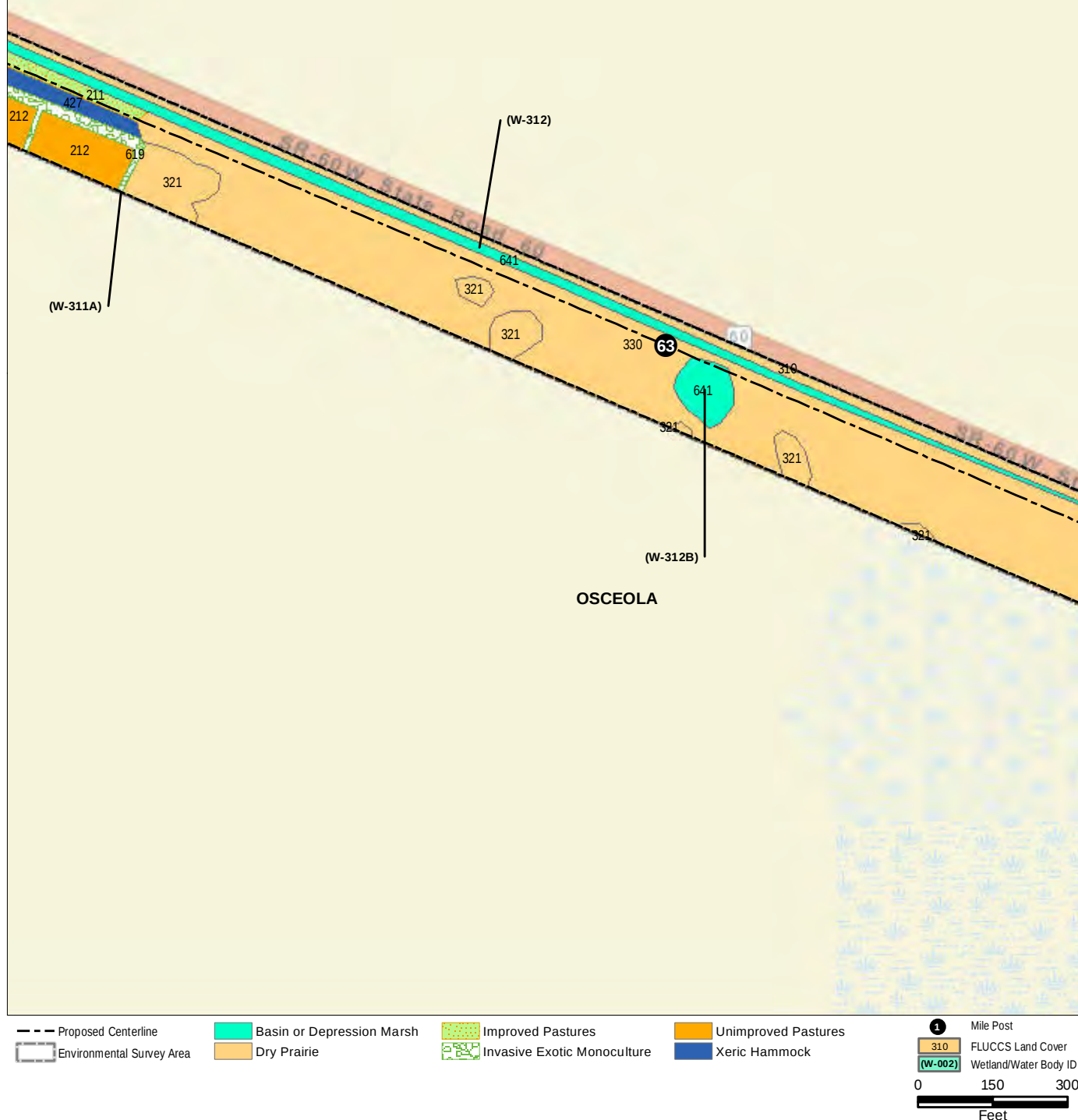


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 137)

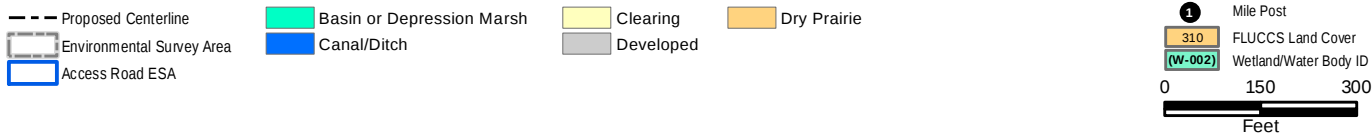
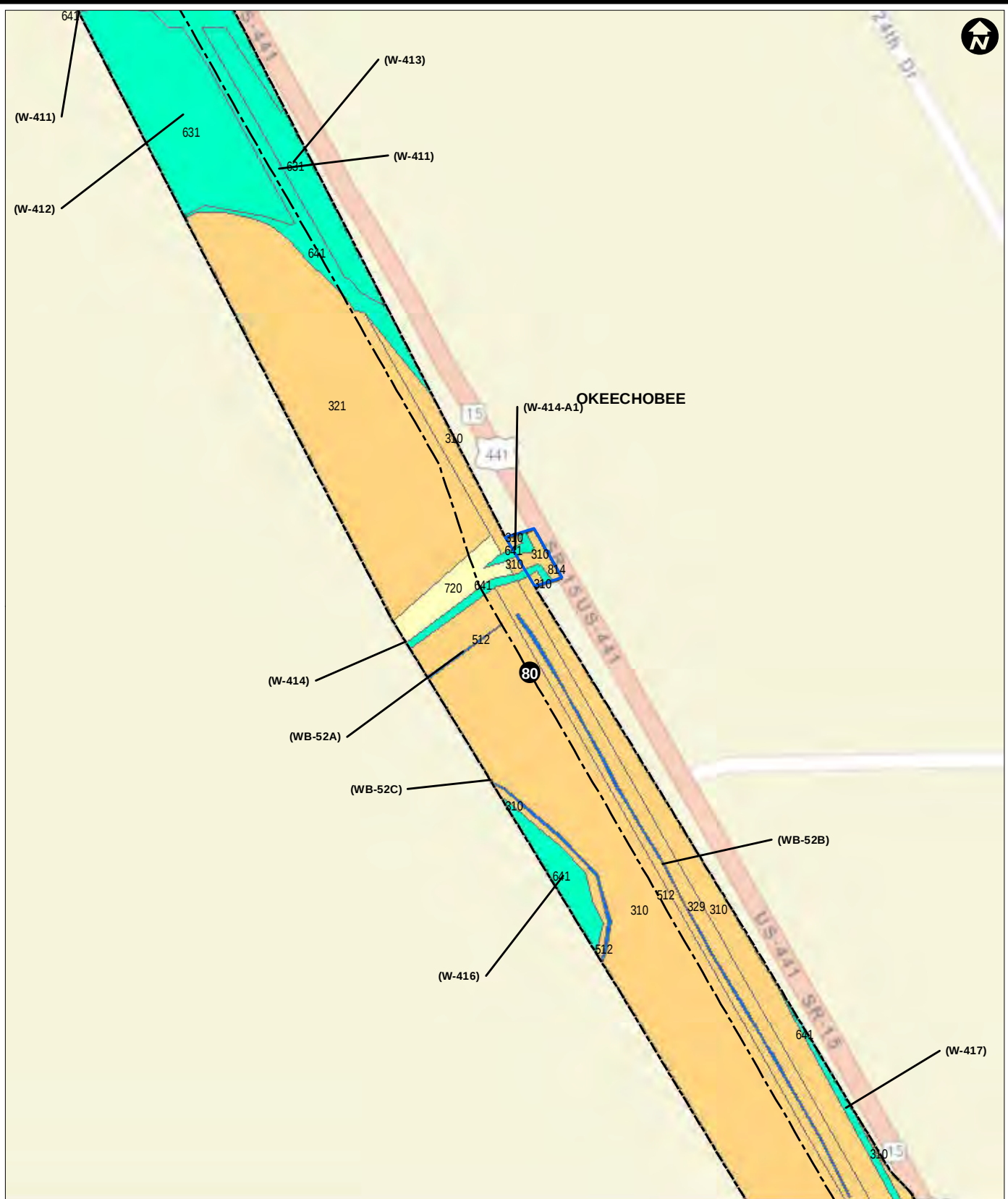


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 175)

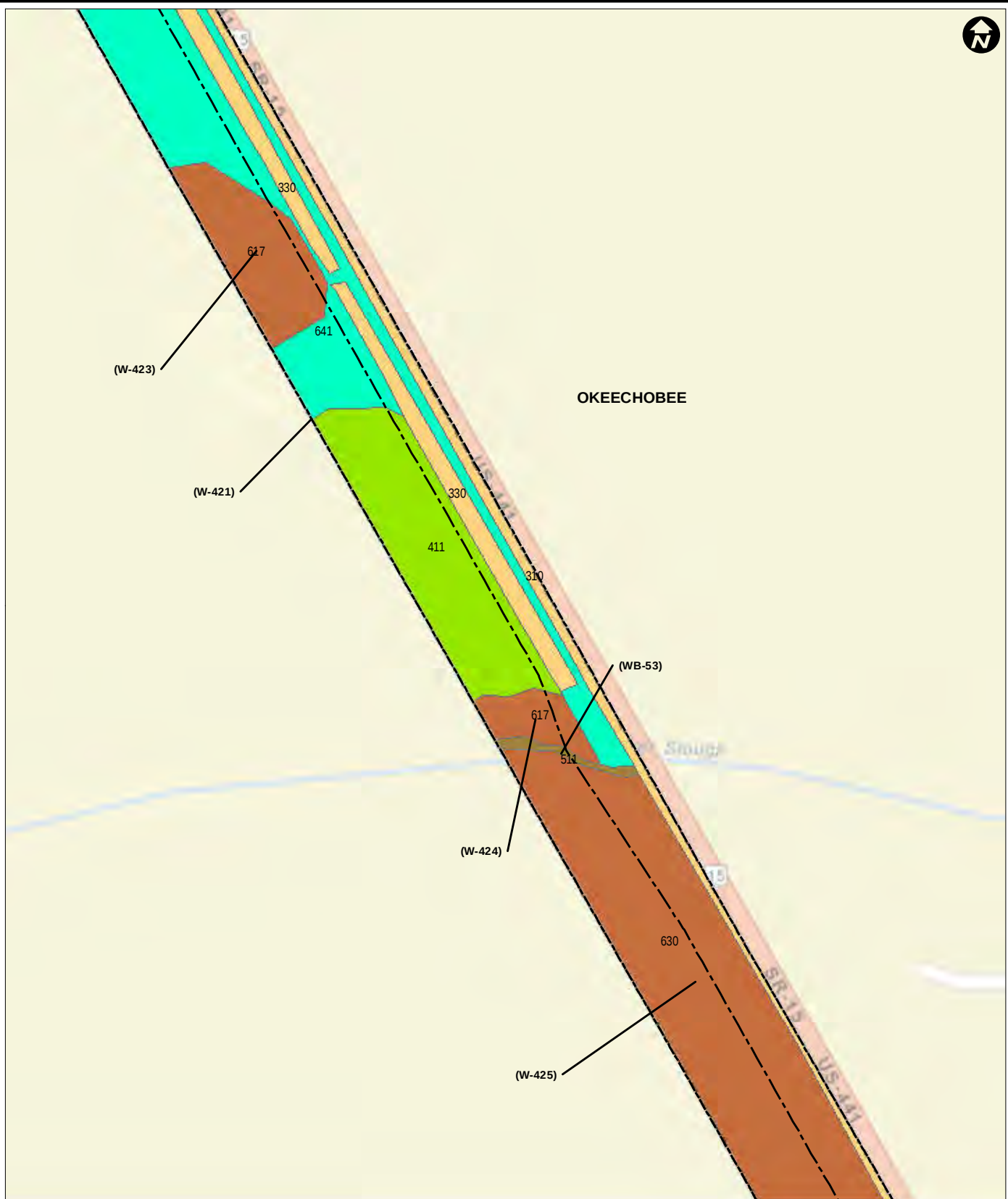

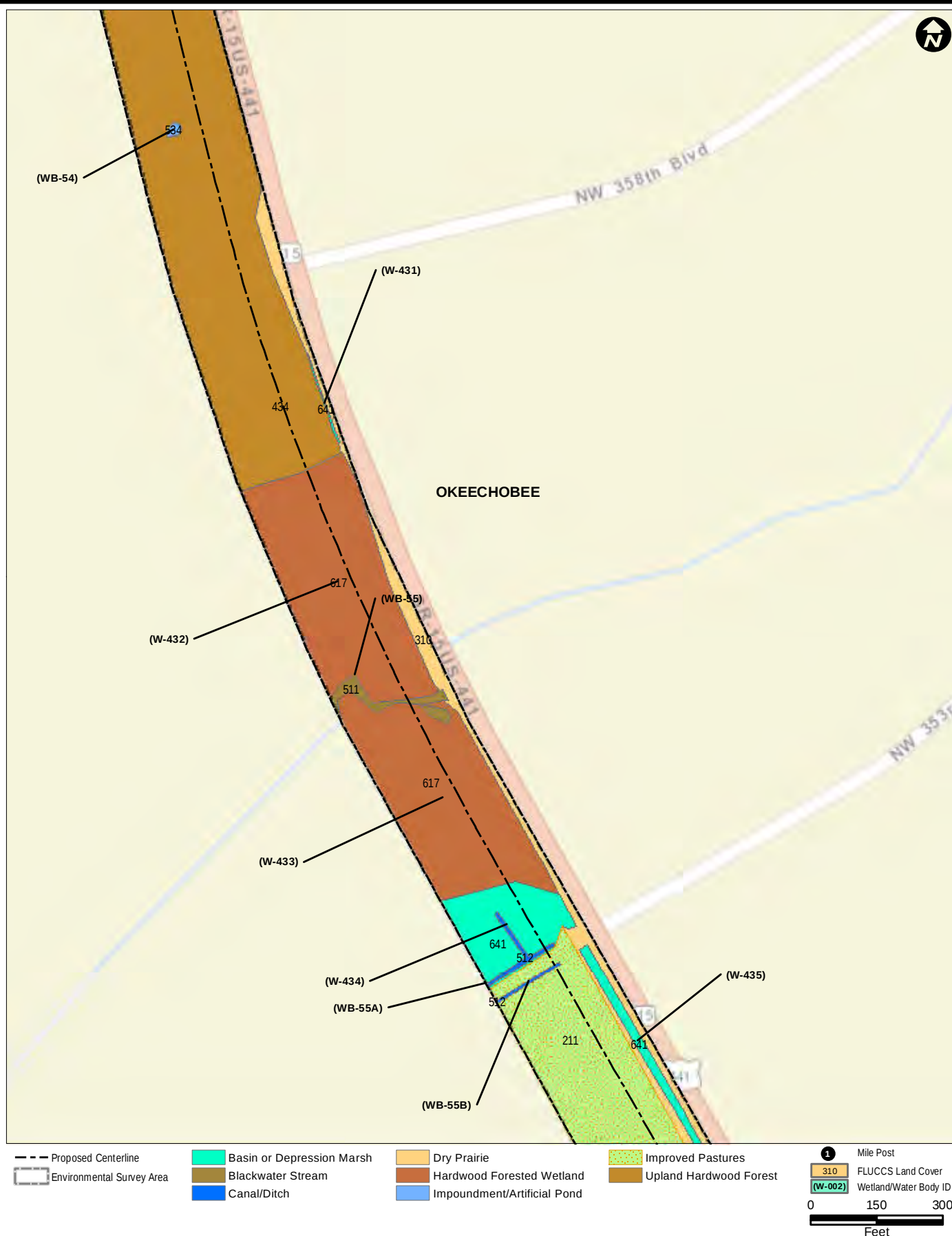


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 180)

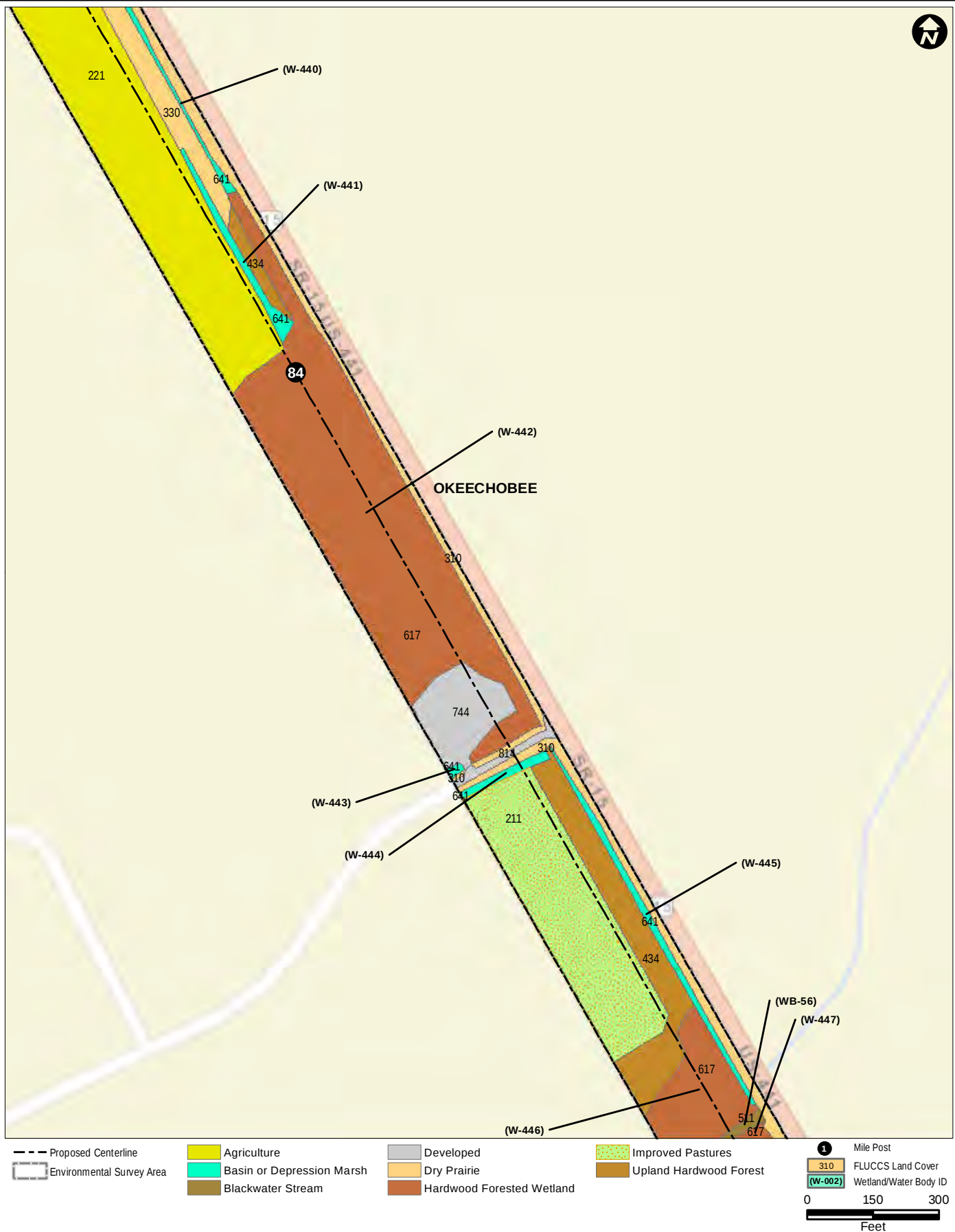


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 183)

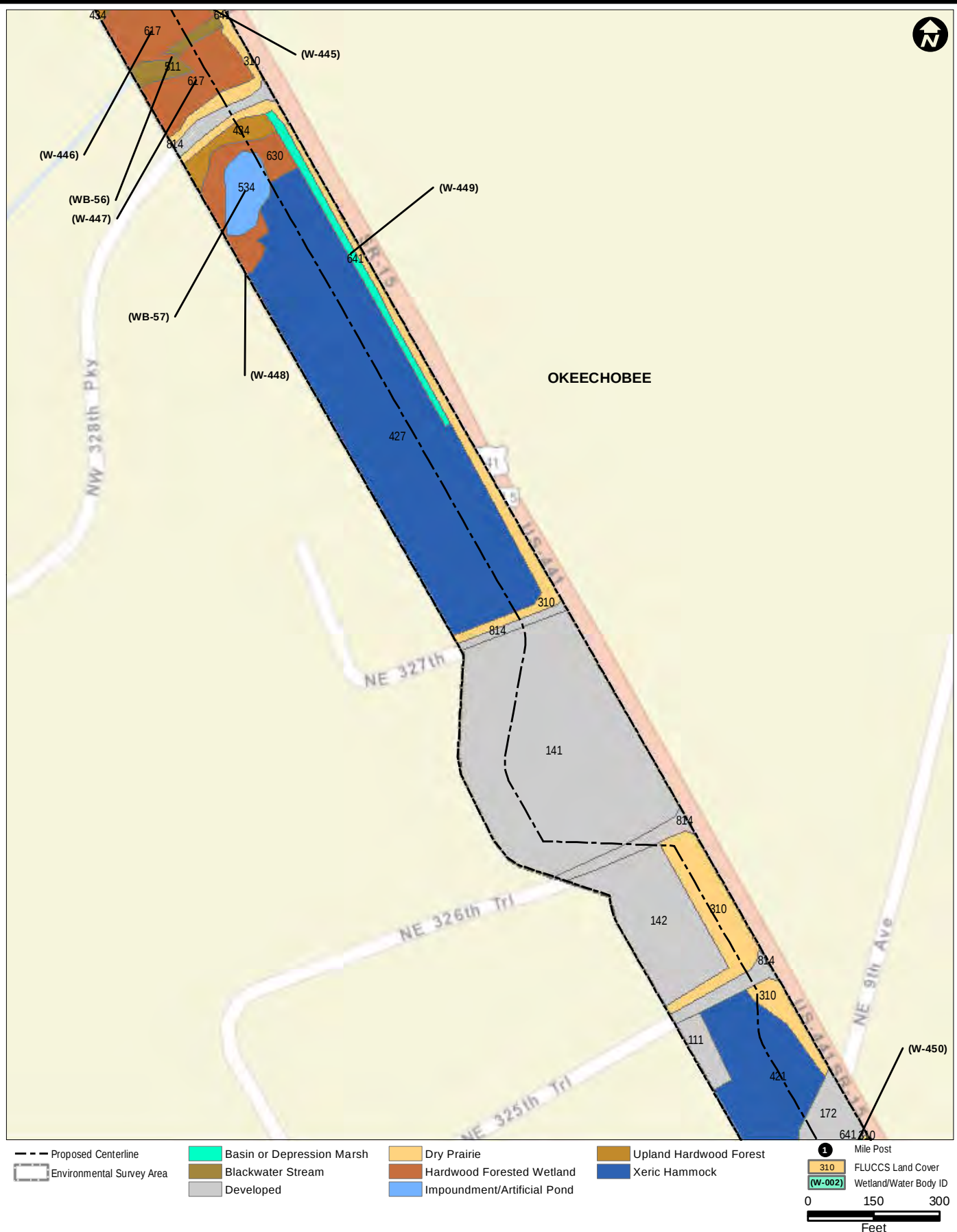


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 184)

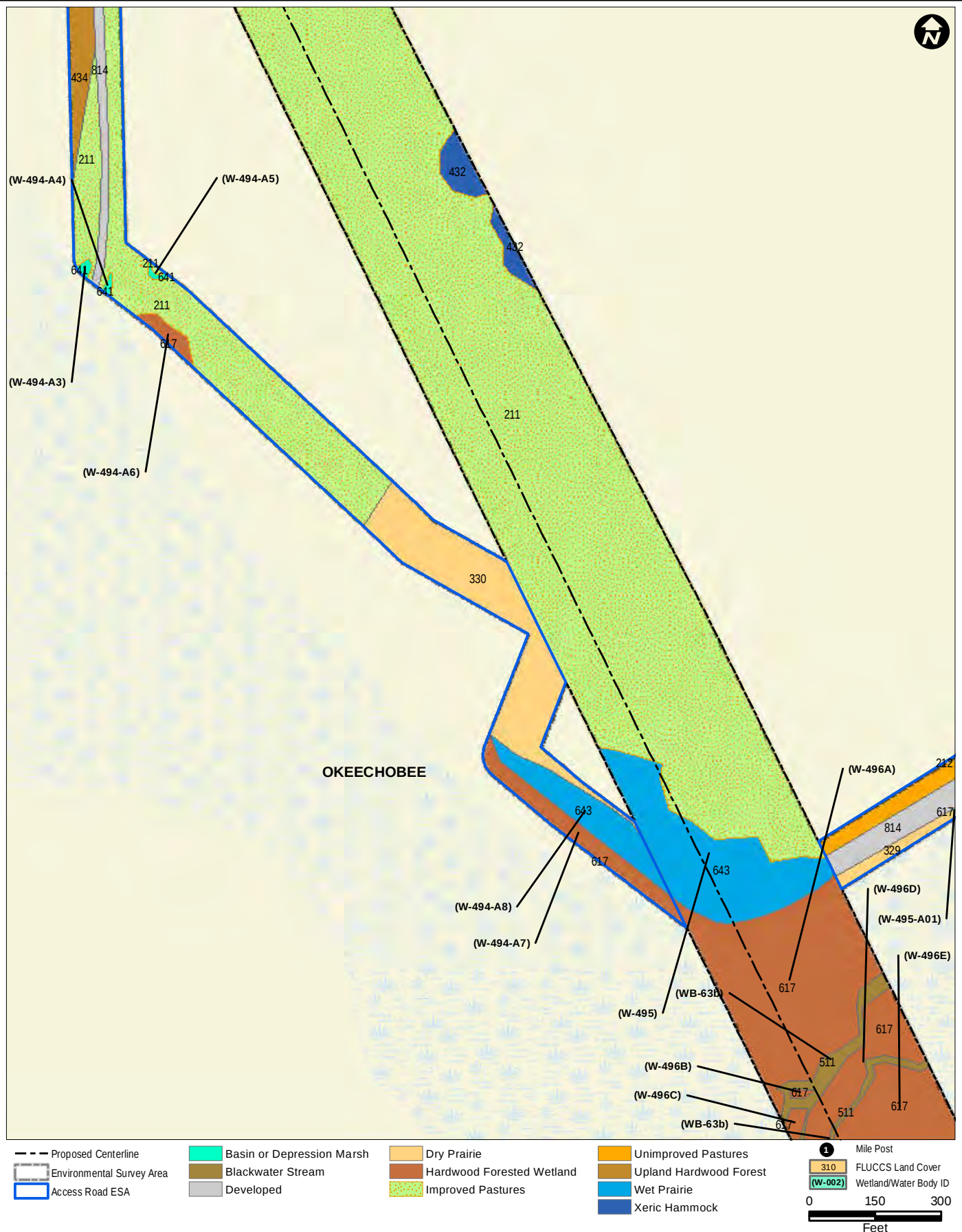


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 212a)

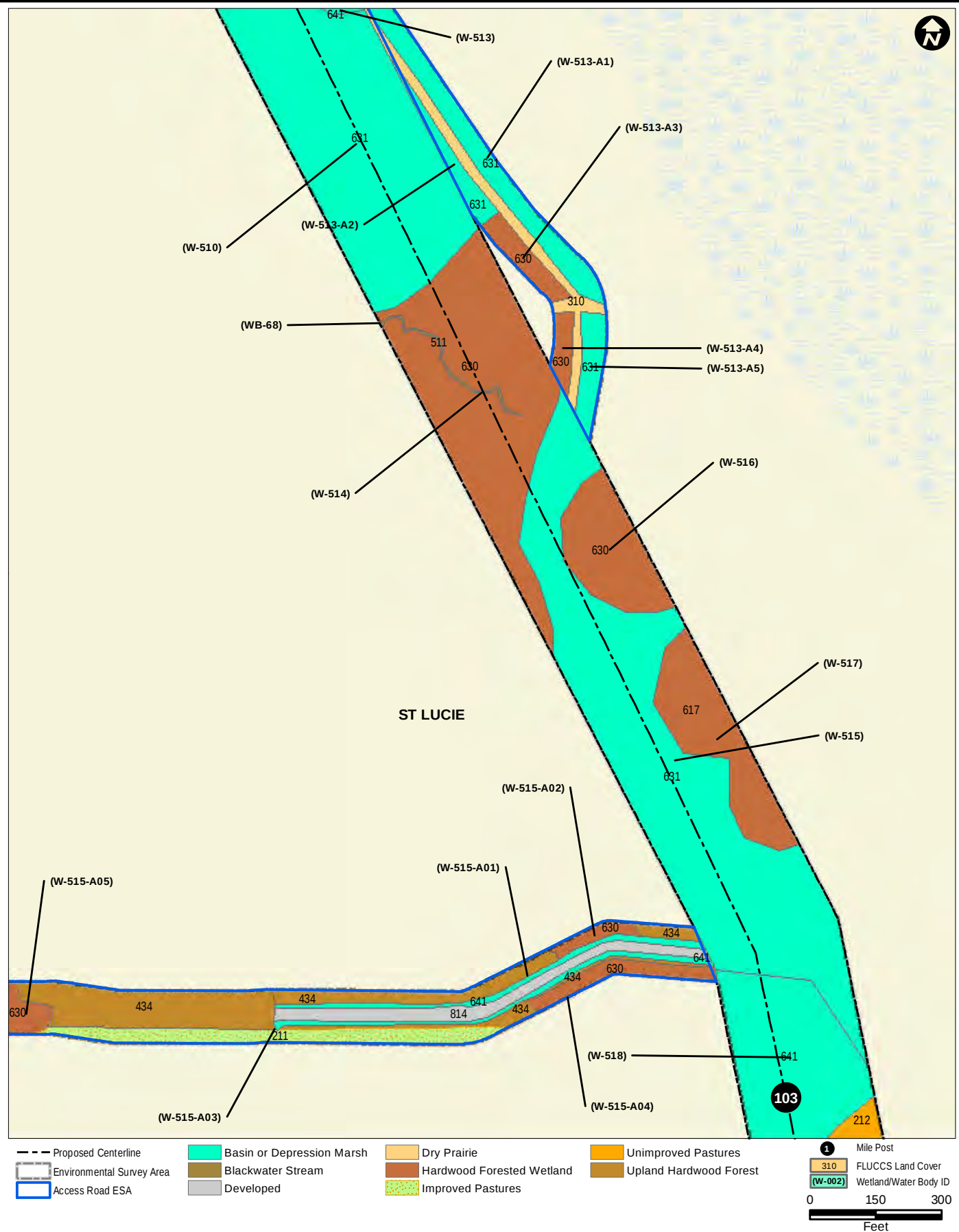


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 221a)

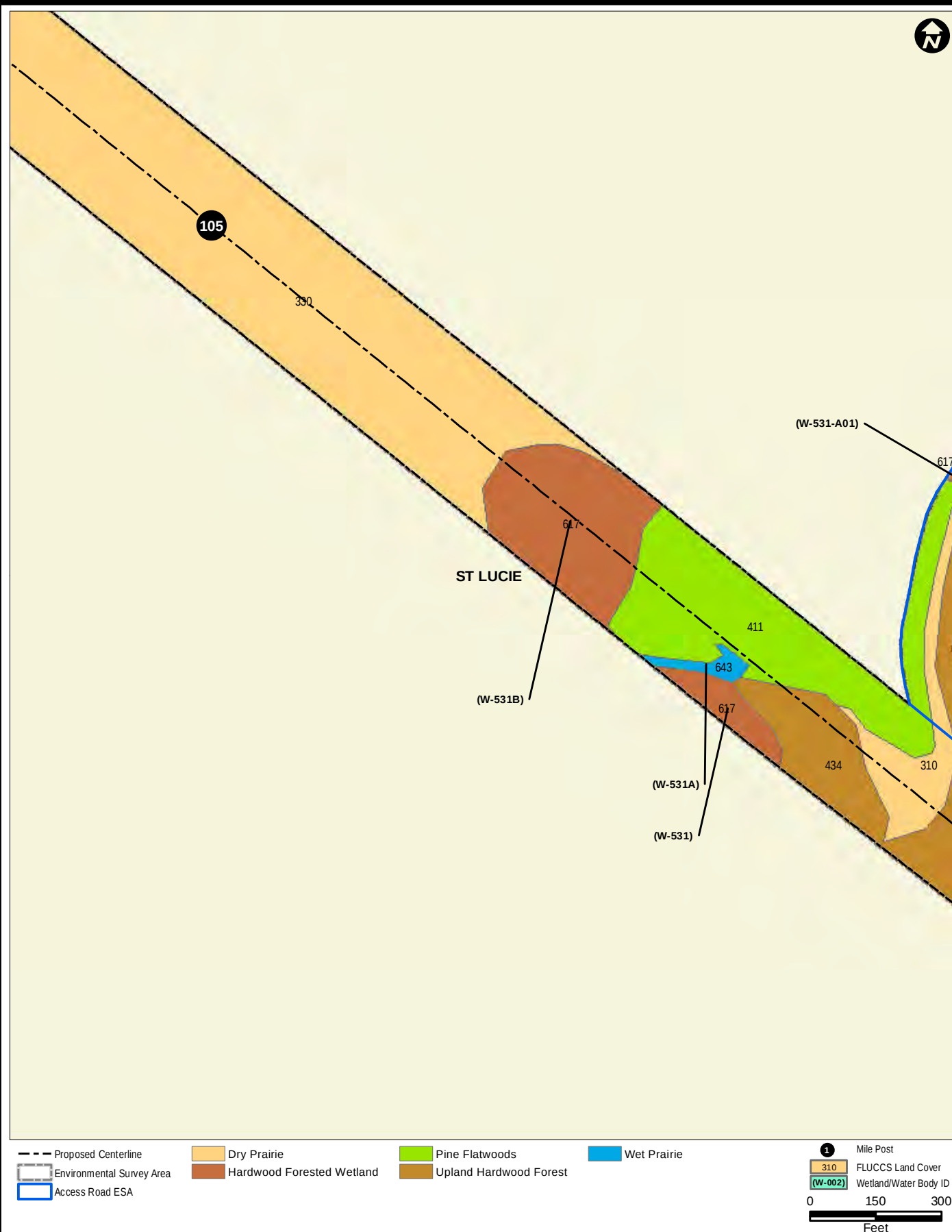


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 226)

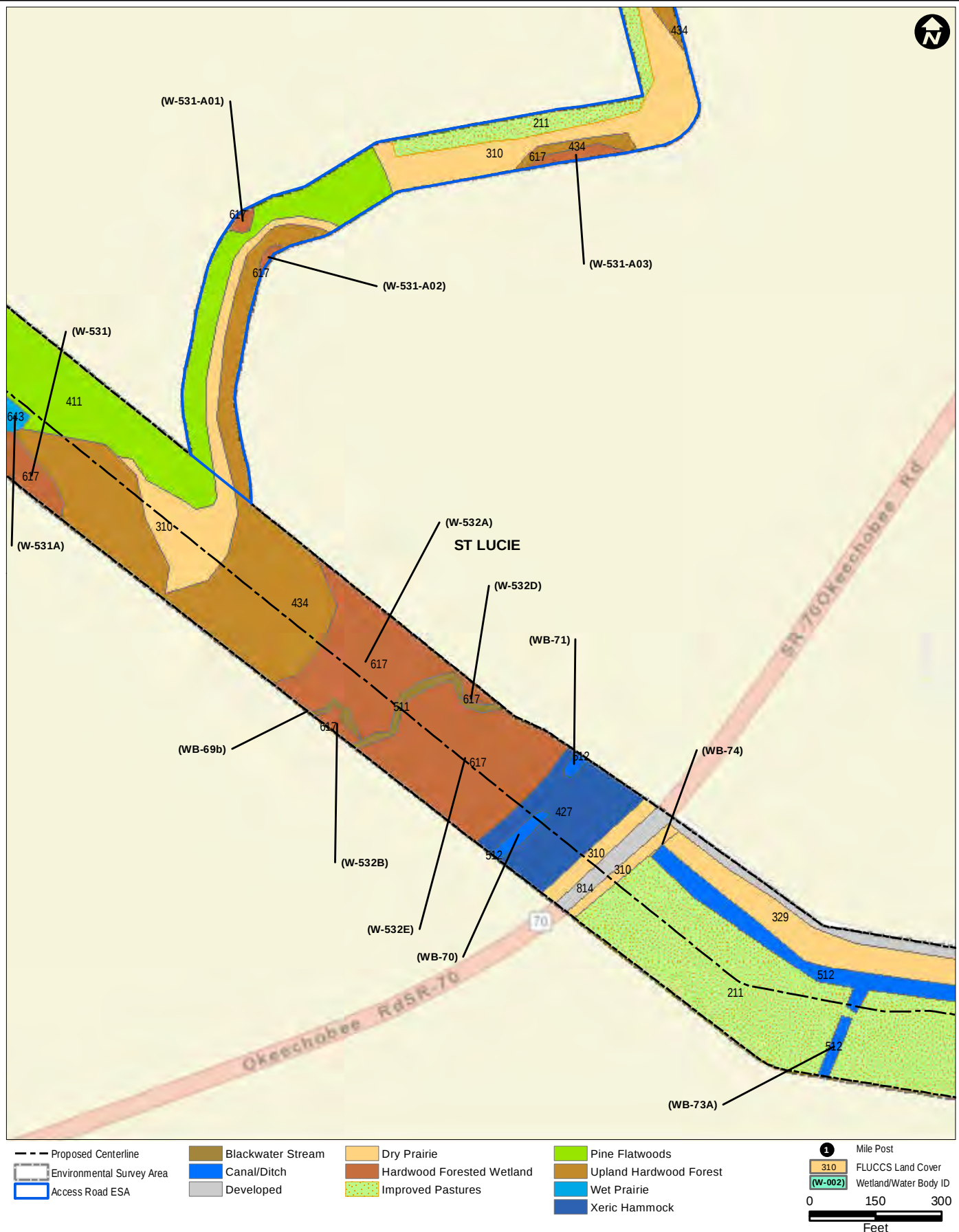


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 227)

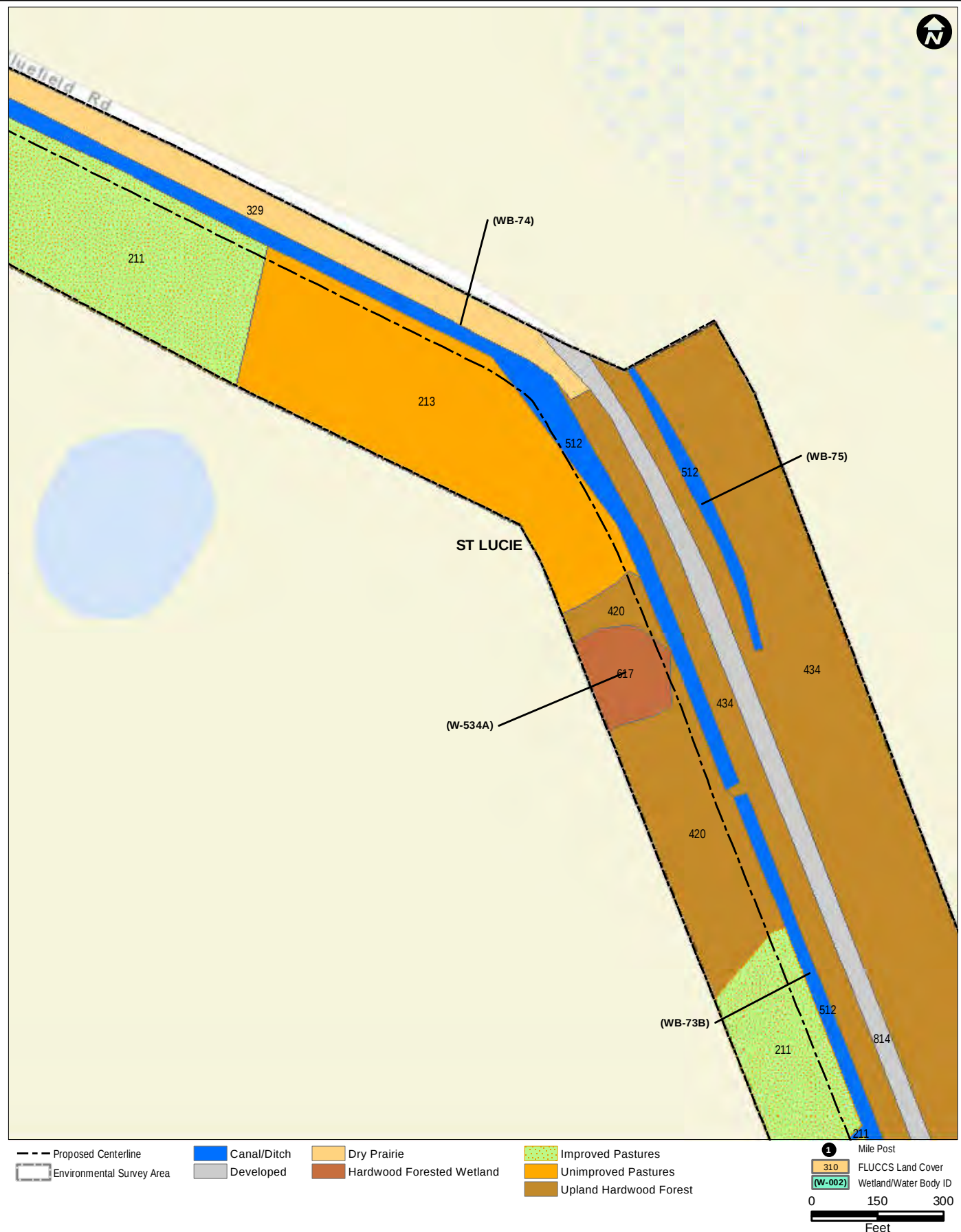


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 229)

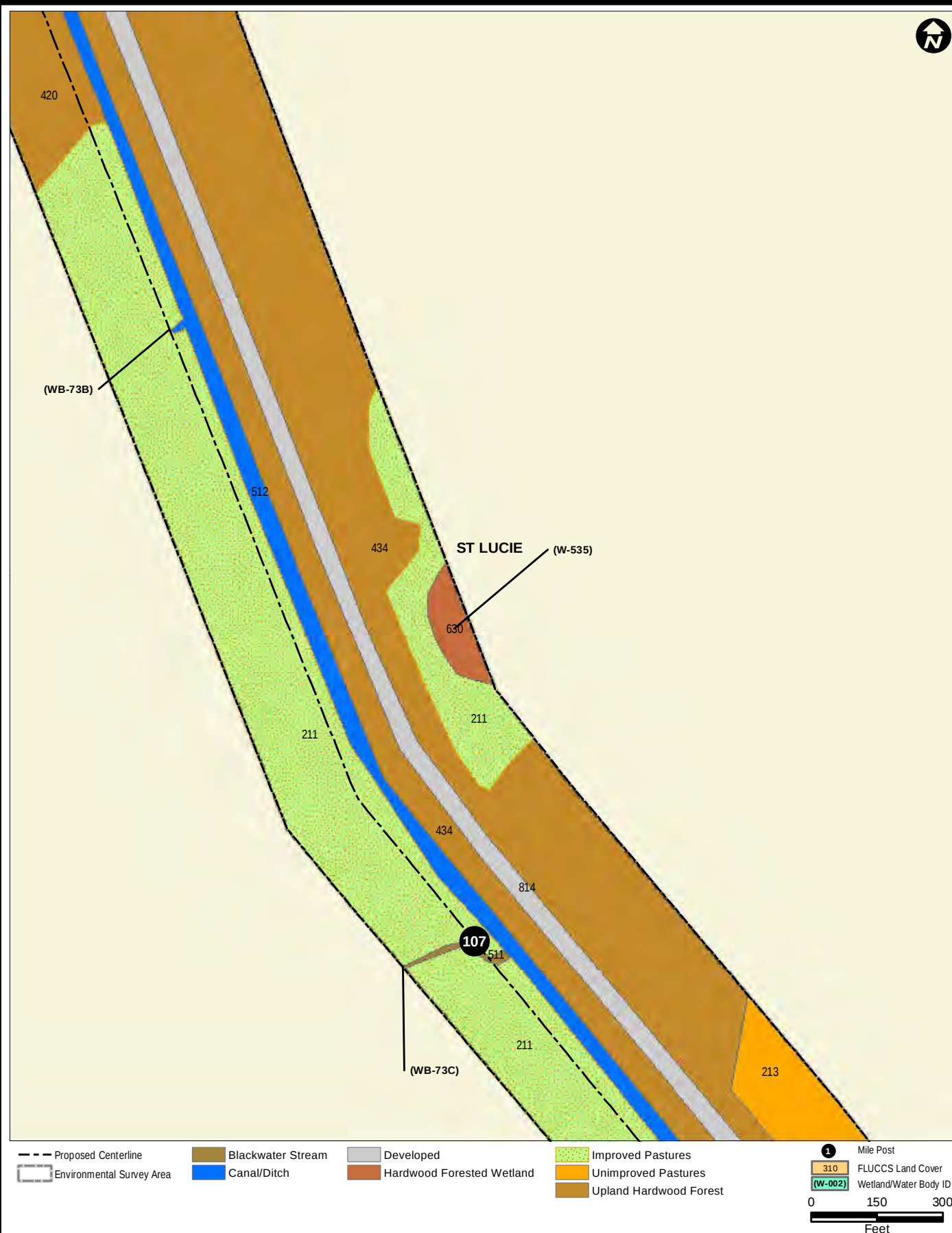


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 230)

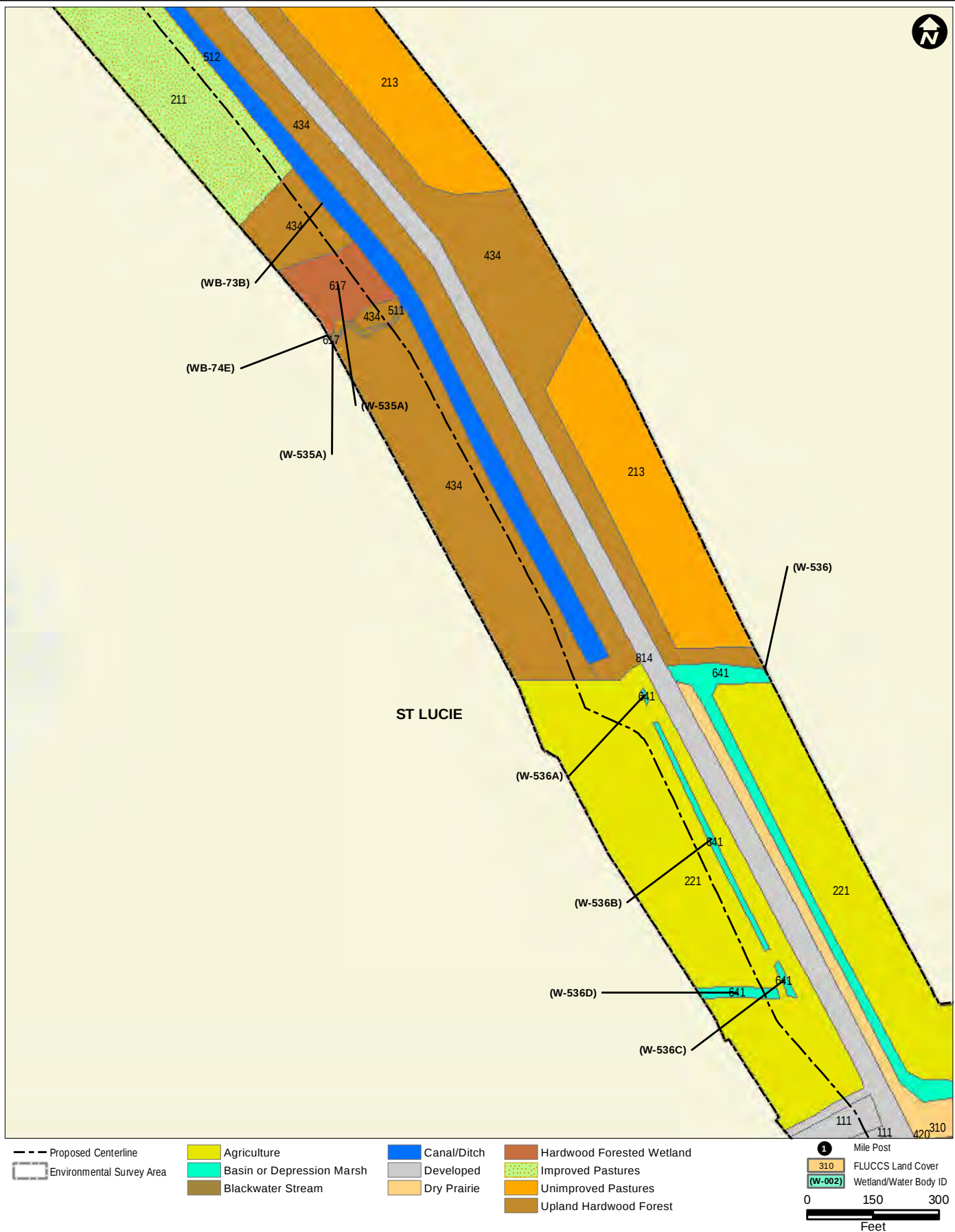


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 231)

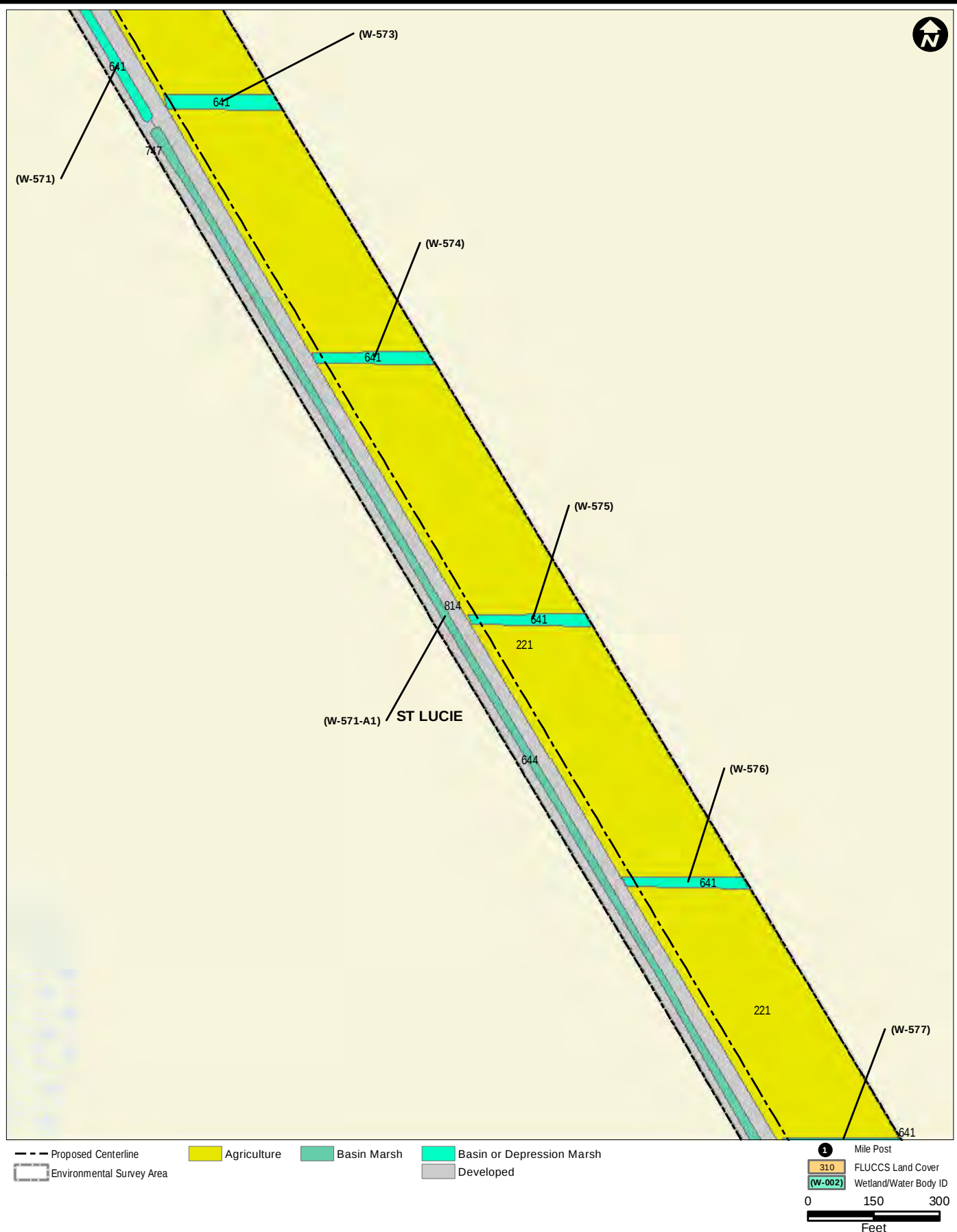


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 243)

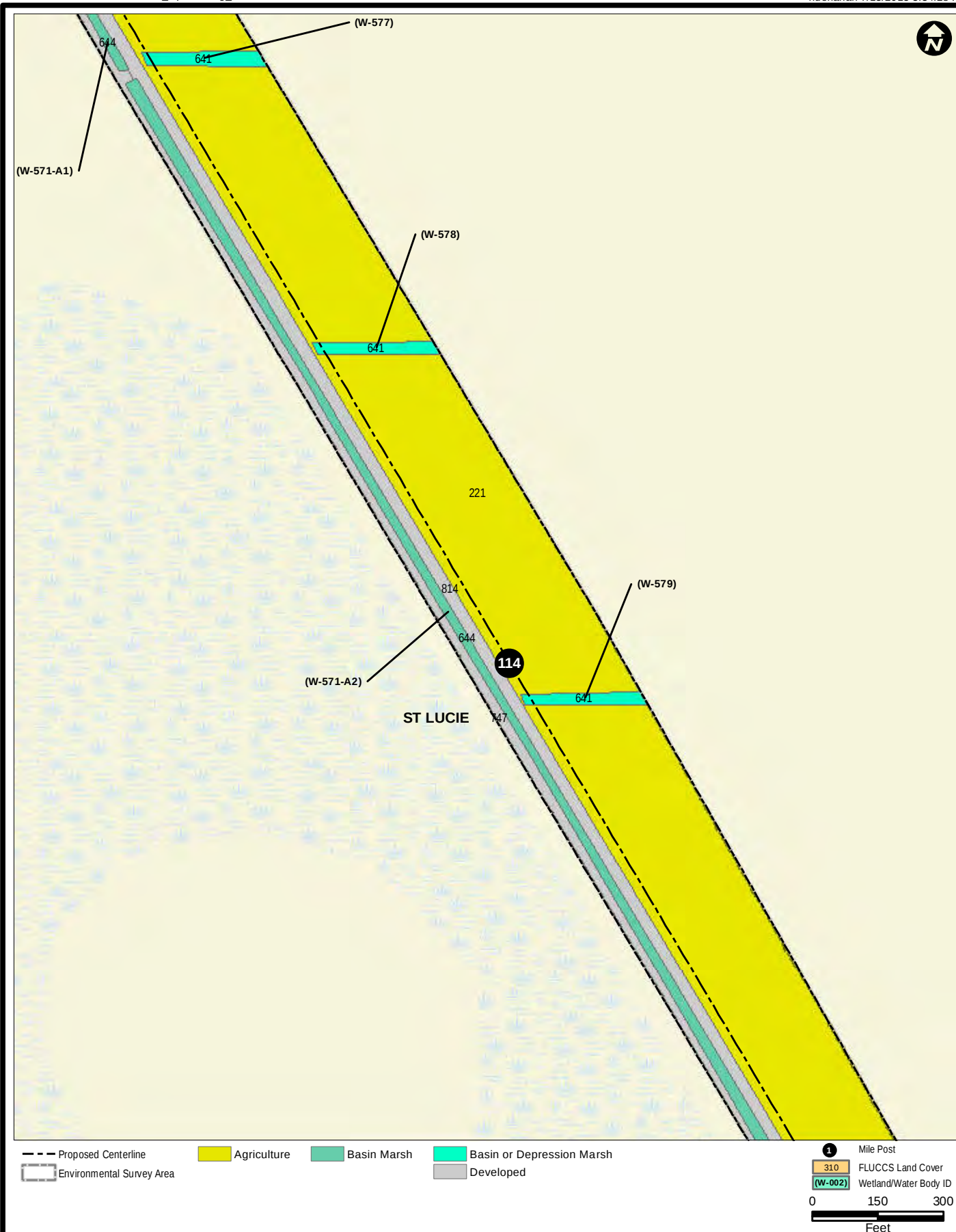


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 244)

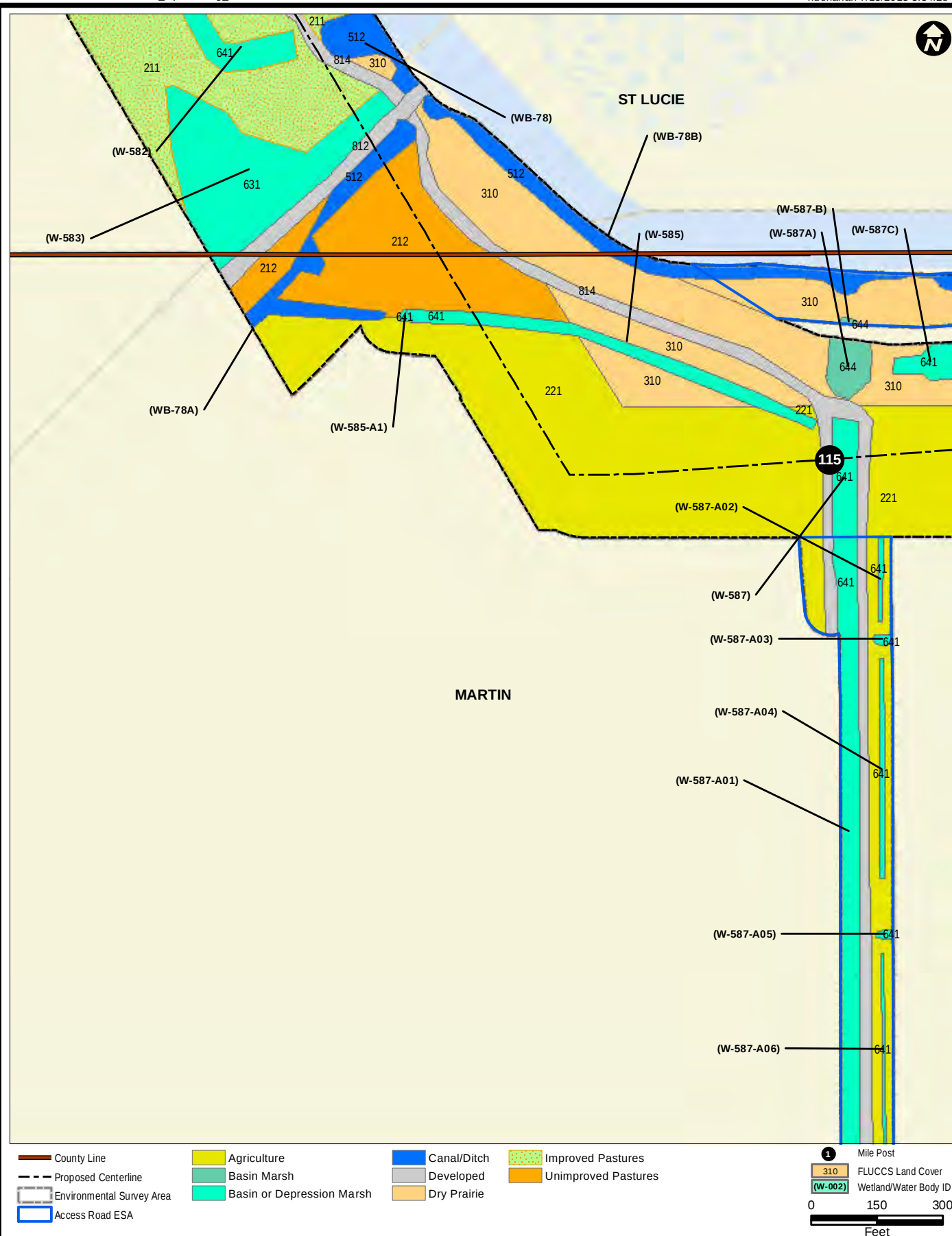
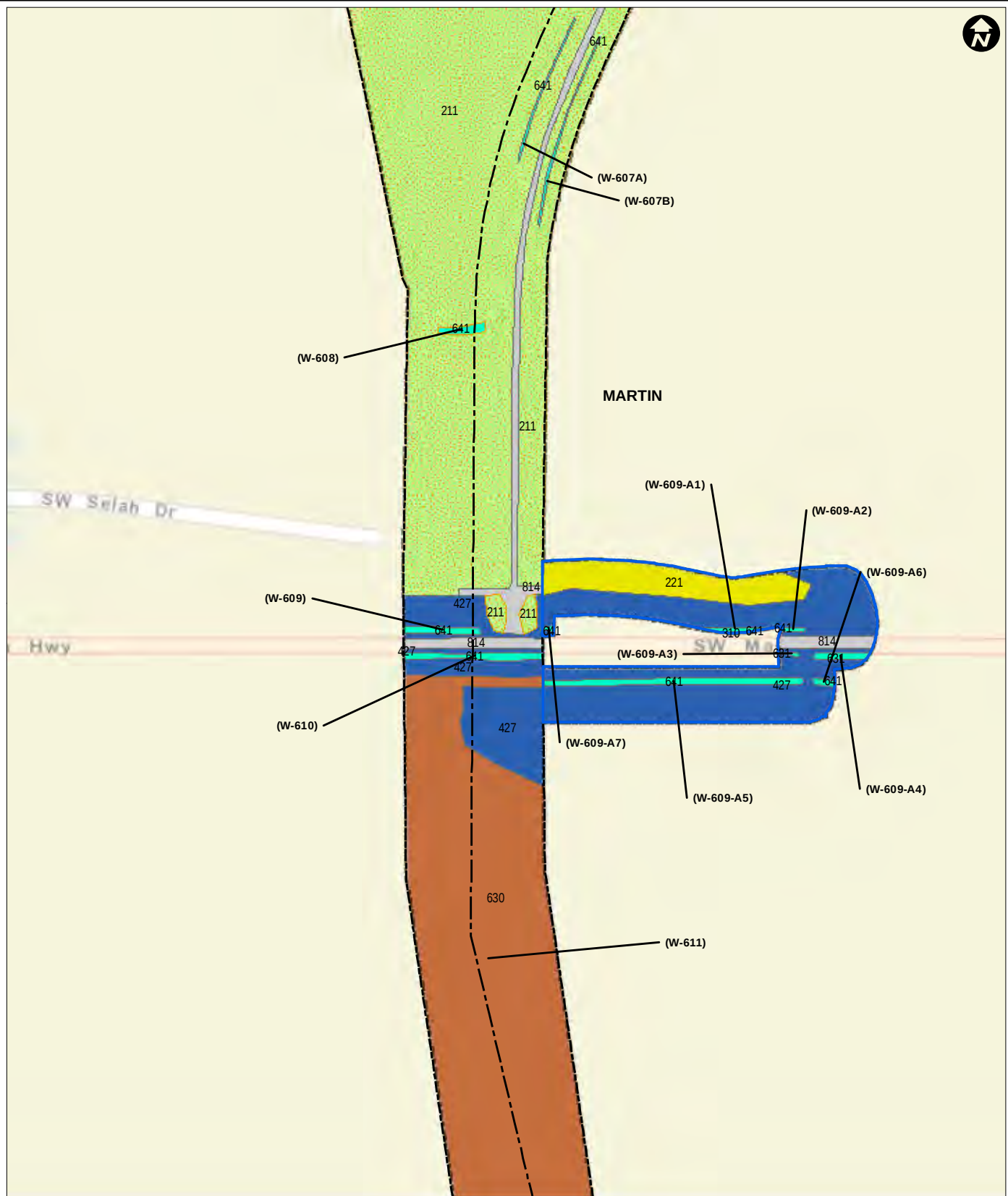


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 246)

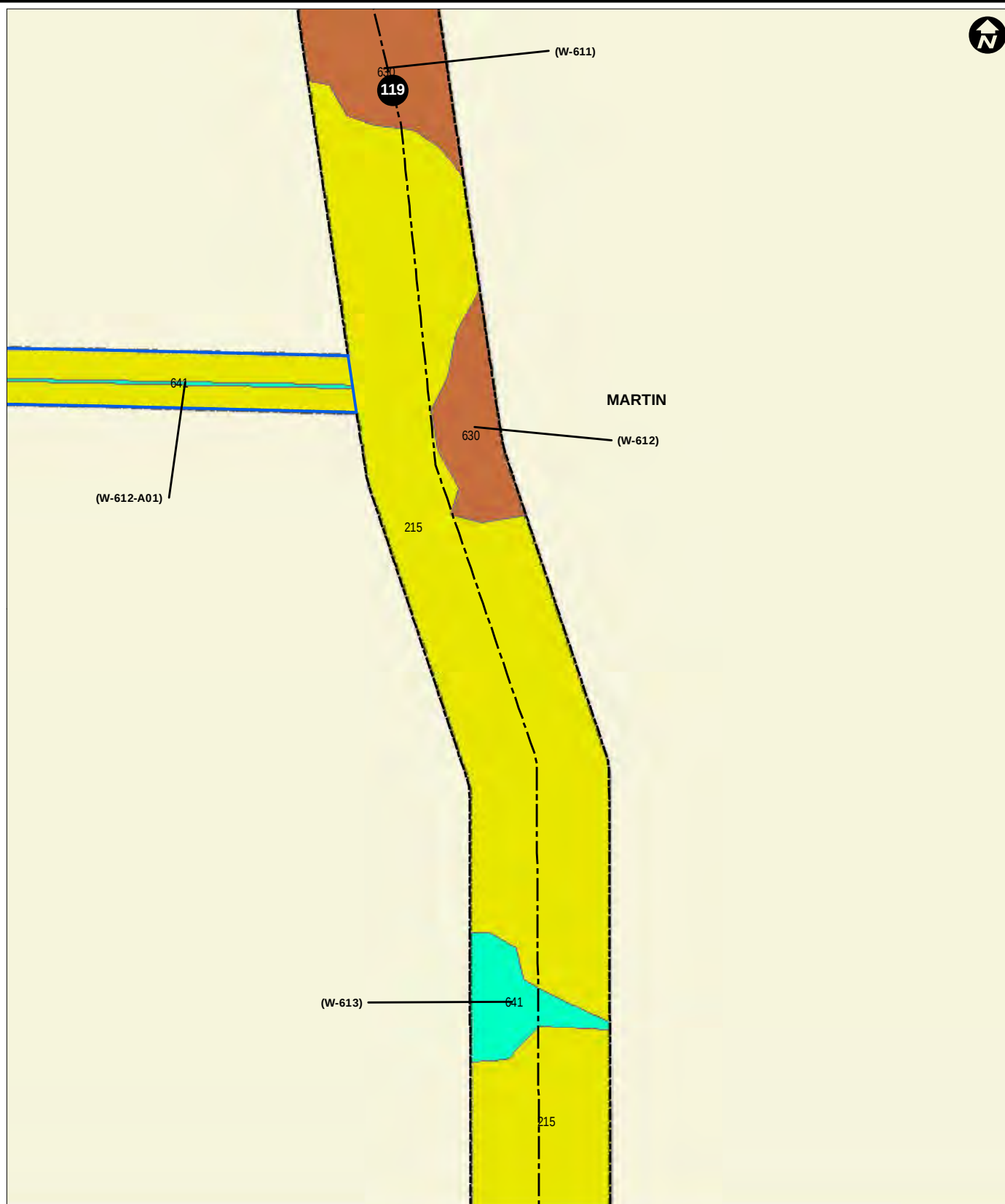

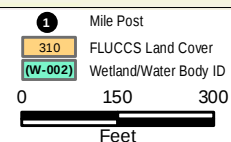


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 263a)

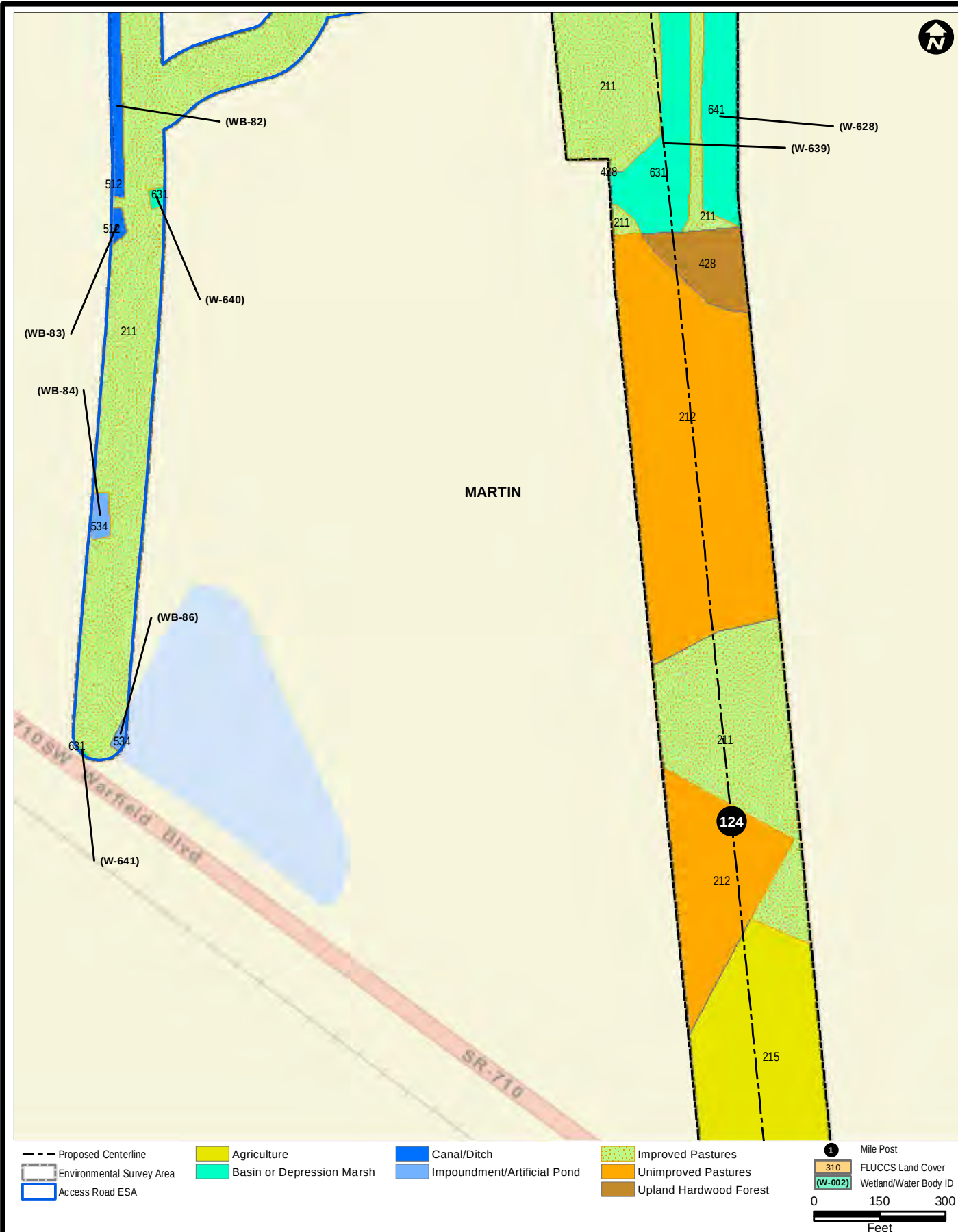


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 273)

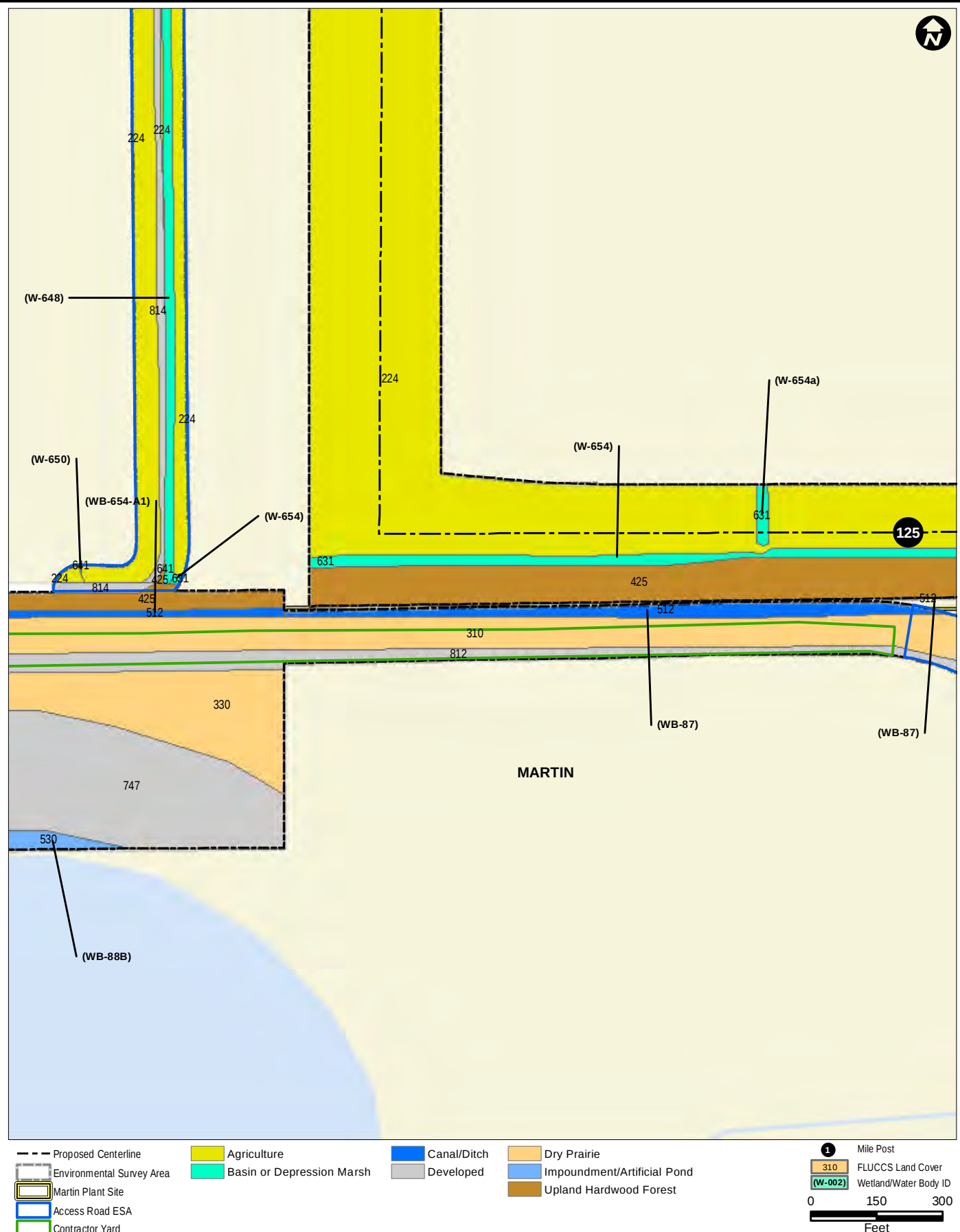


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 275a)

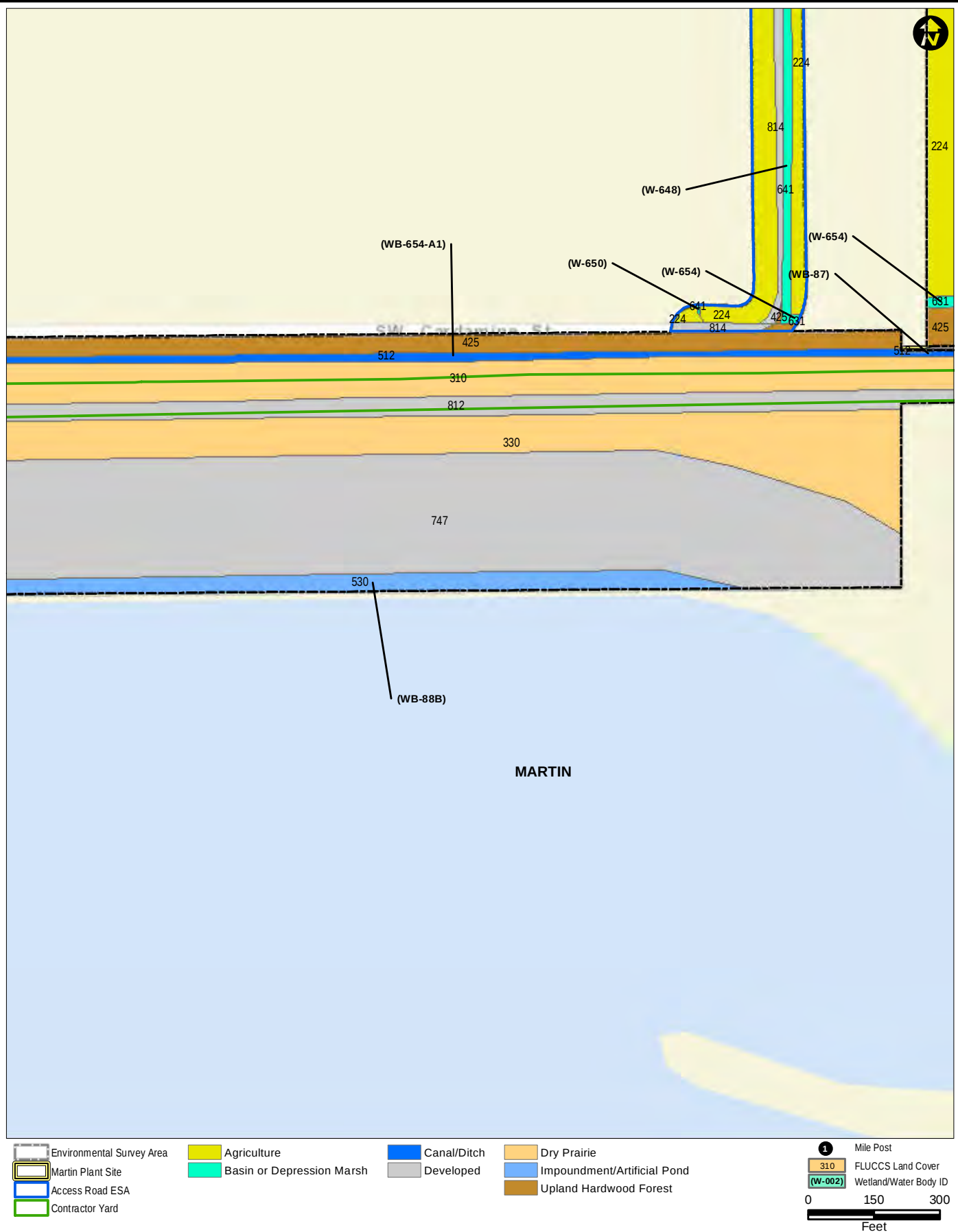


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 275b)

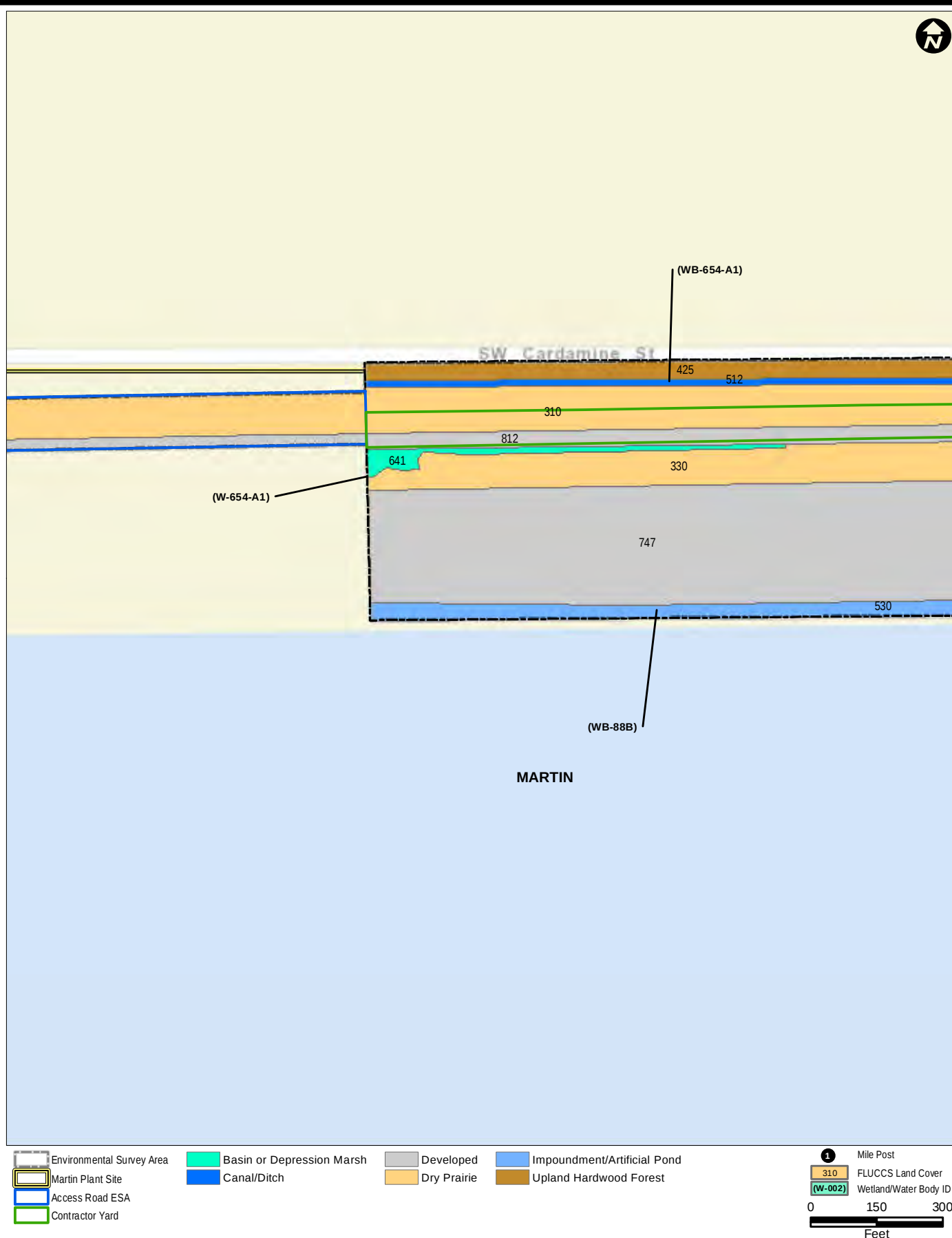


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 275c)

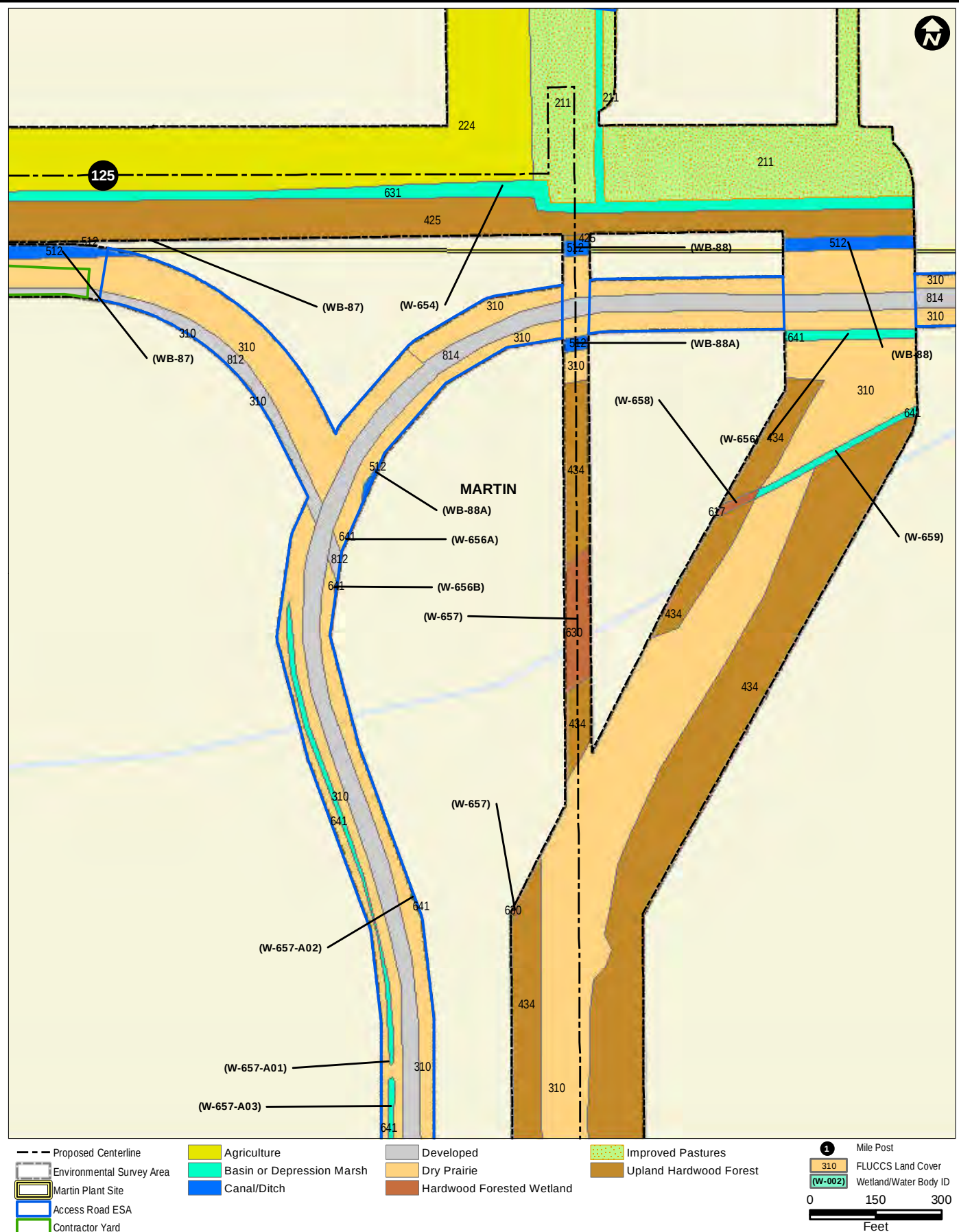


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 276a)

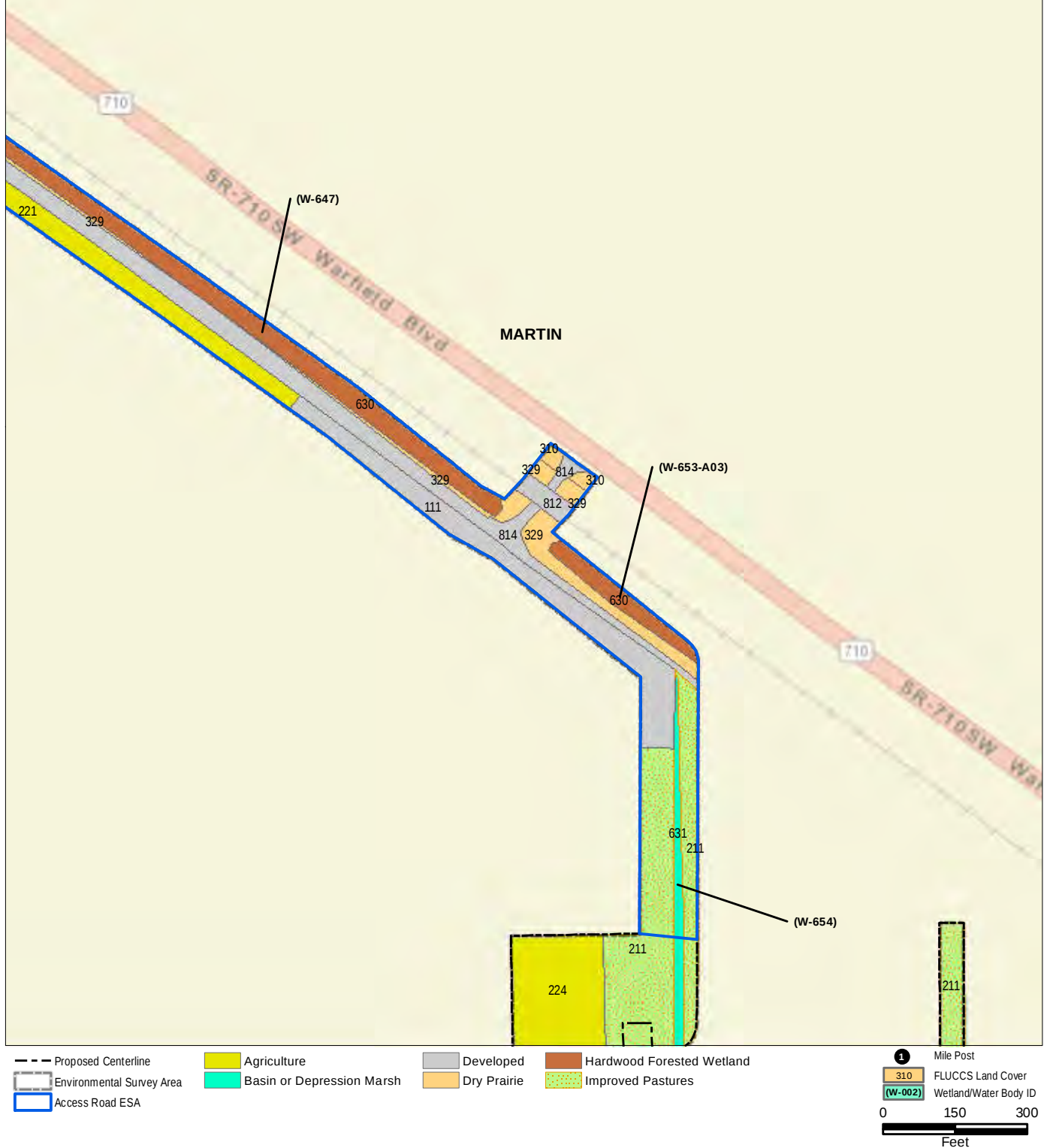


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 276b)

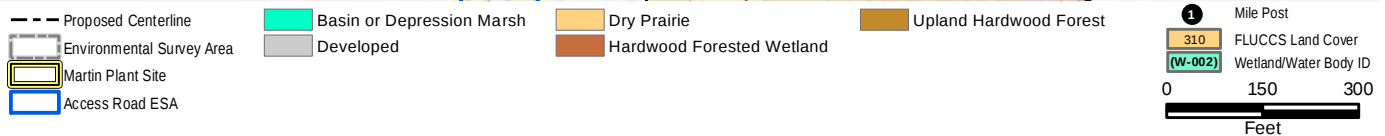
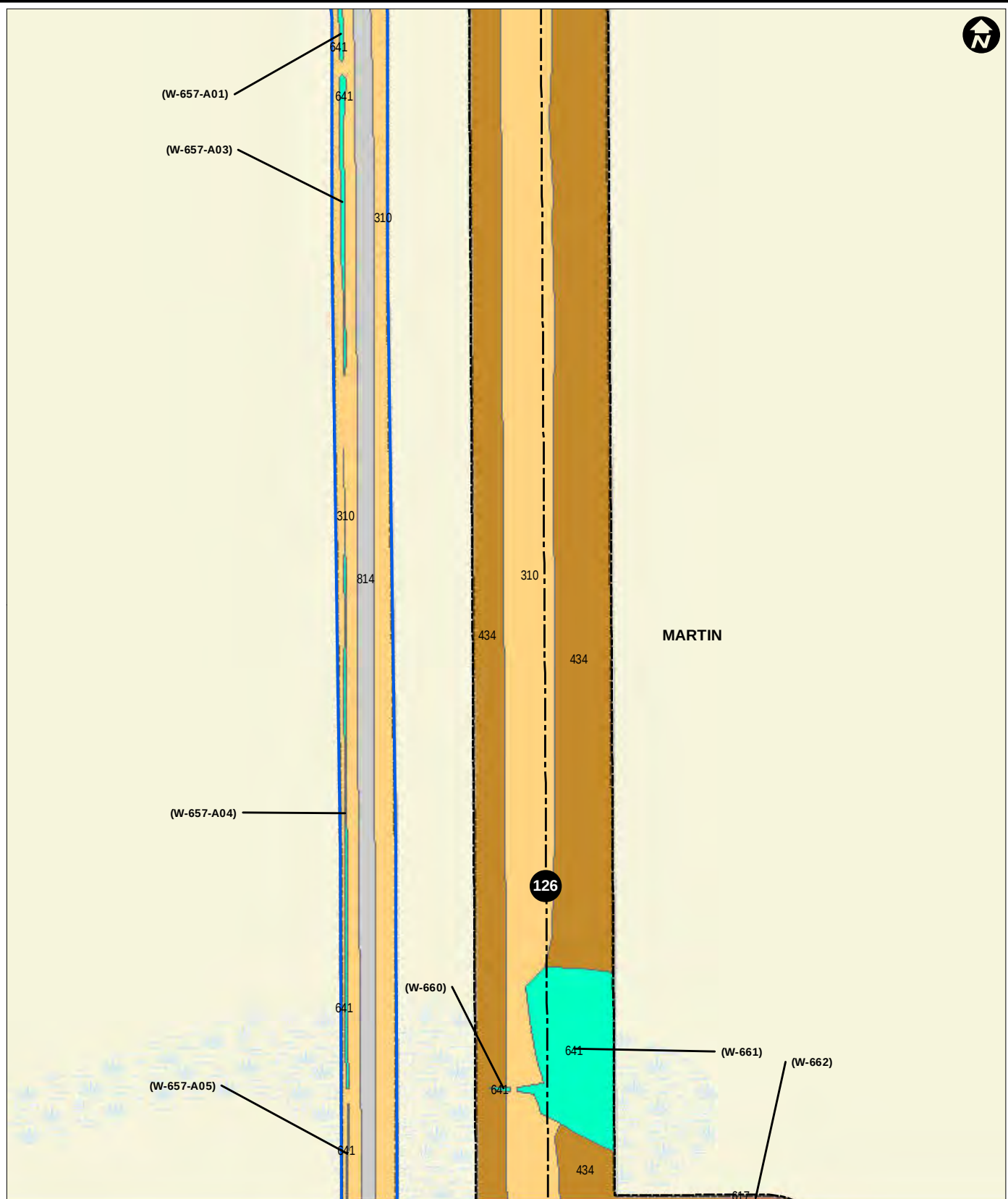


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 277)

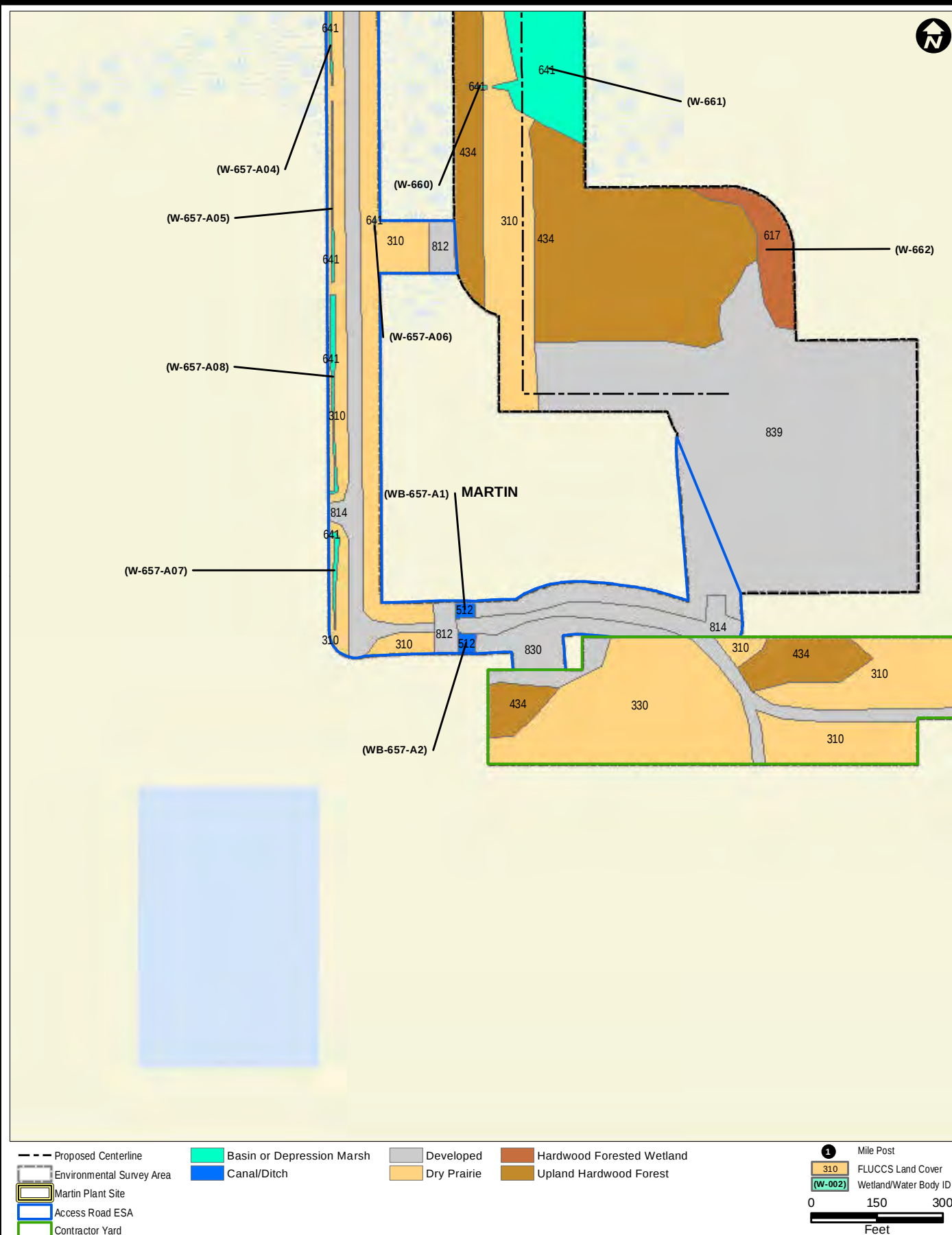


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 278a)

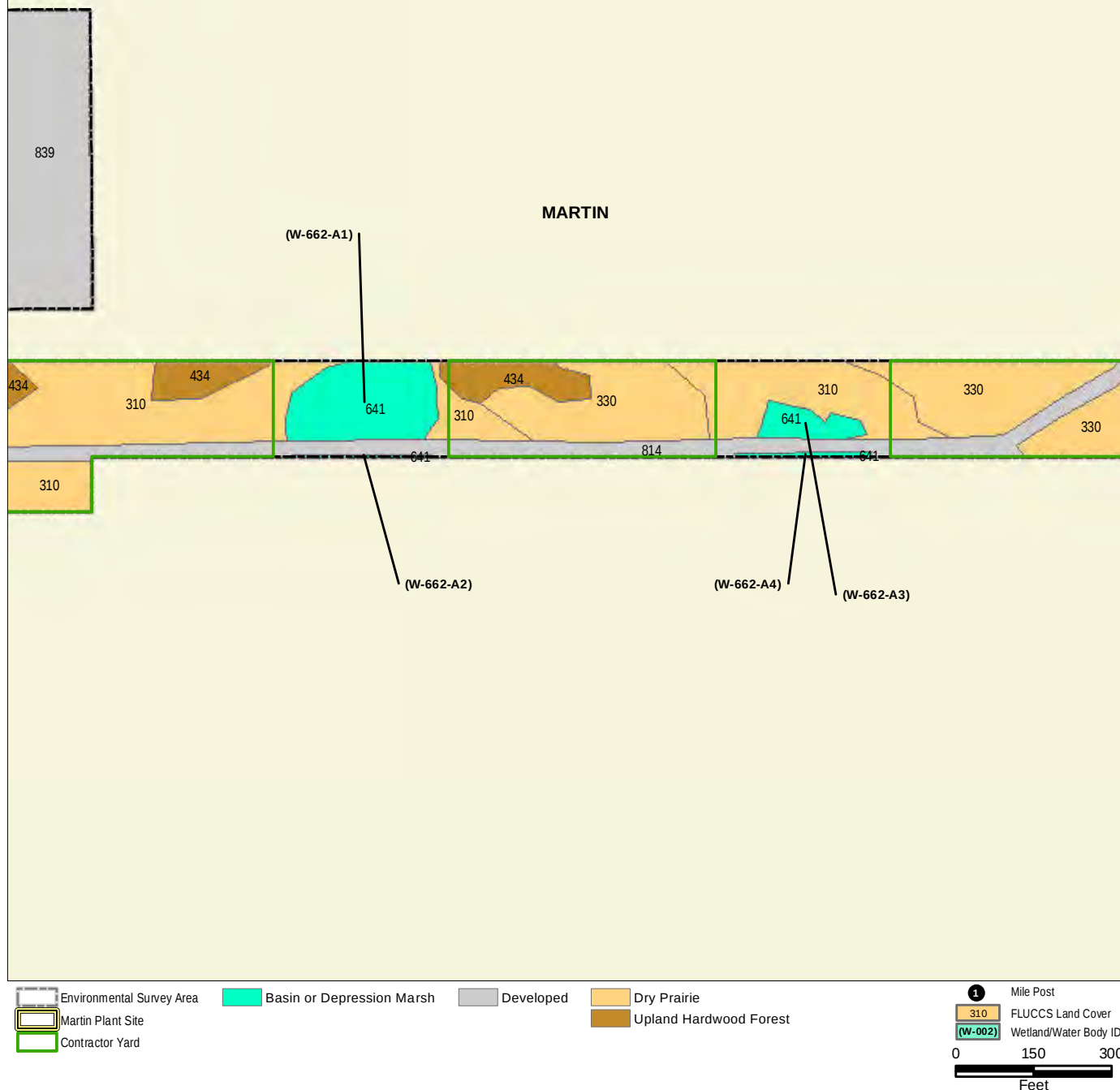


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 278b)

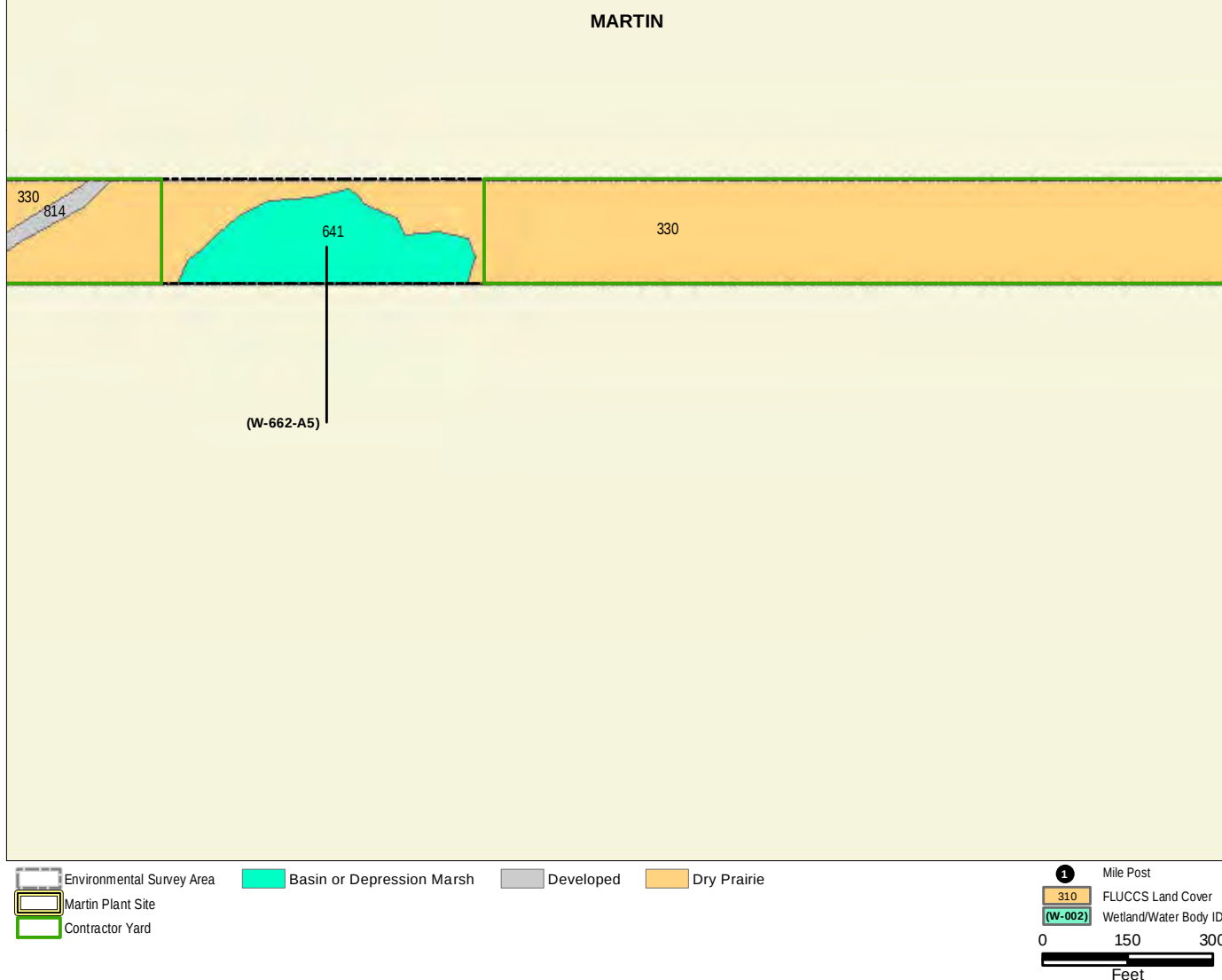


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 278c)

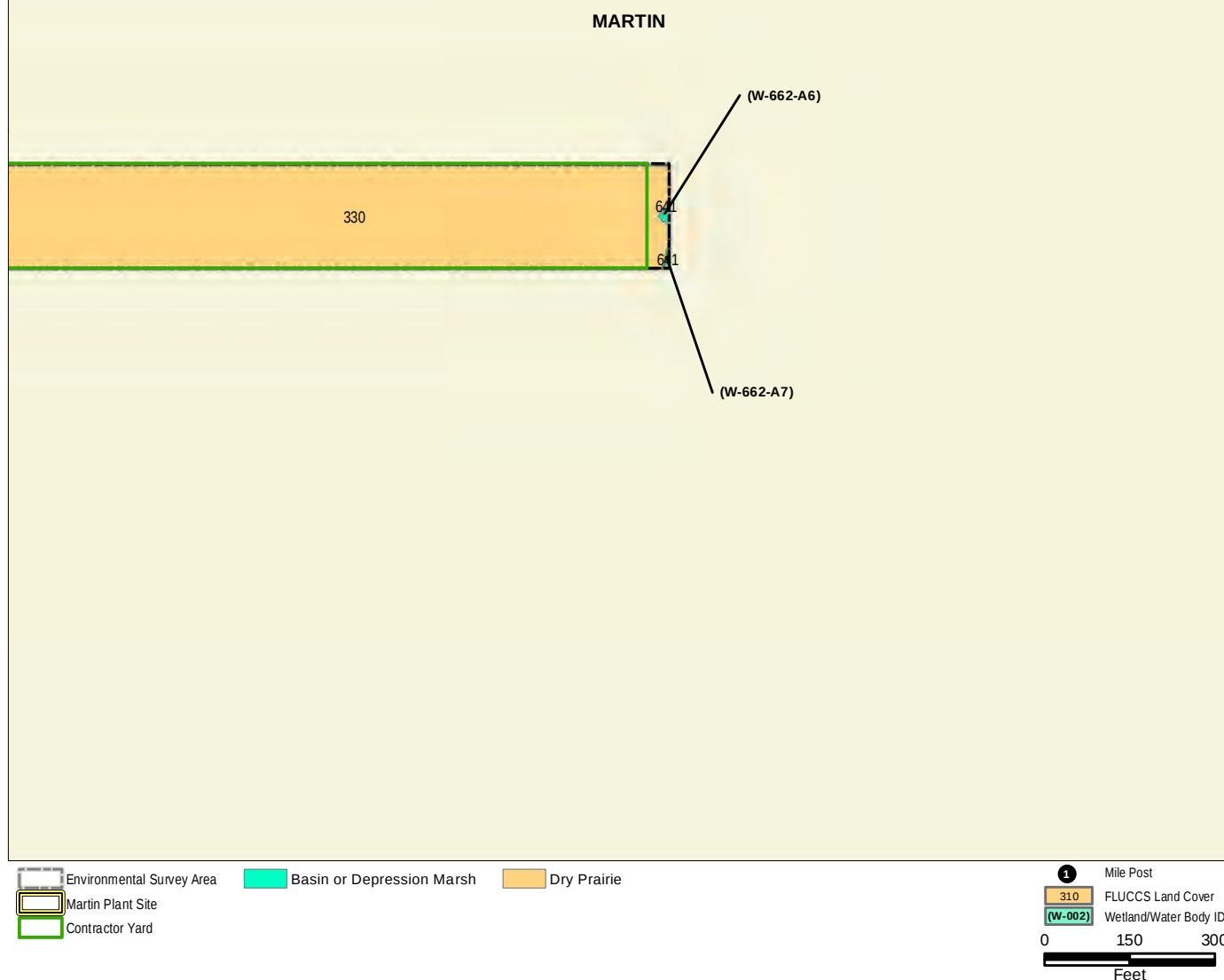


FIGURE 7. (SHEET 278d)

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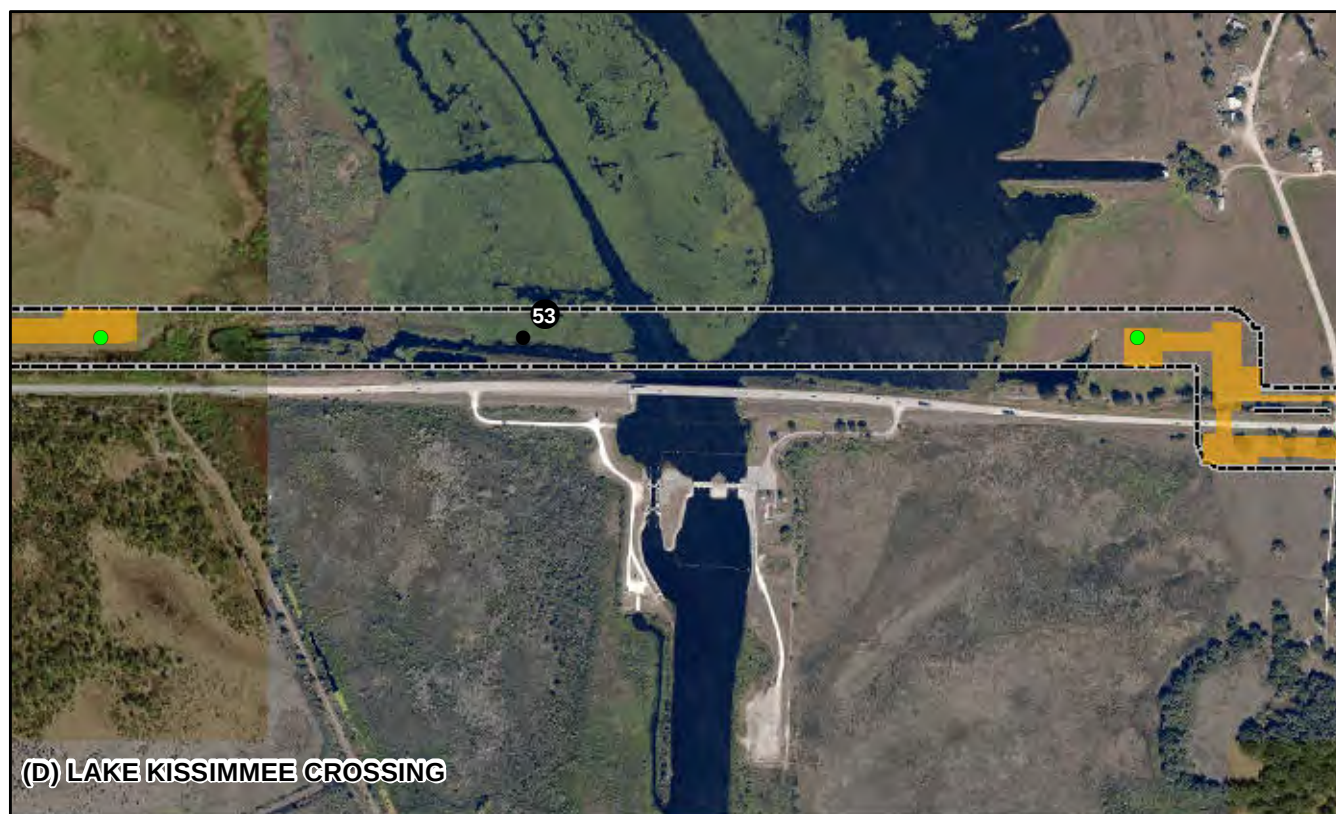


FIGURE 8. (SHEET 2 OF 4)

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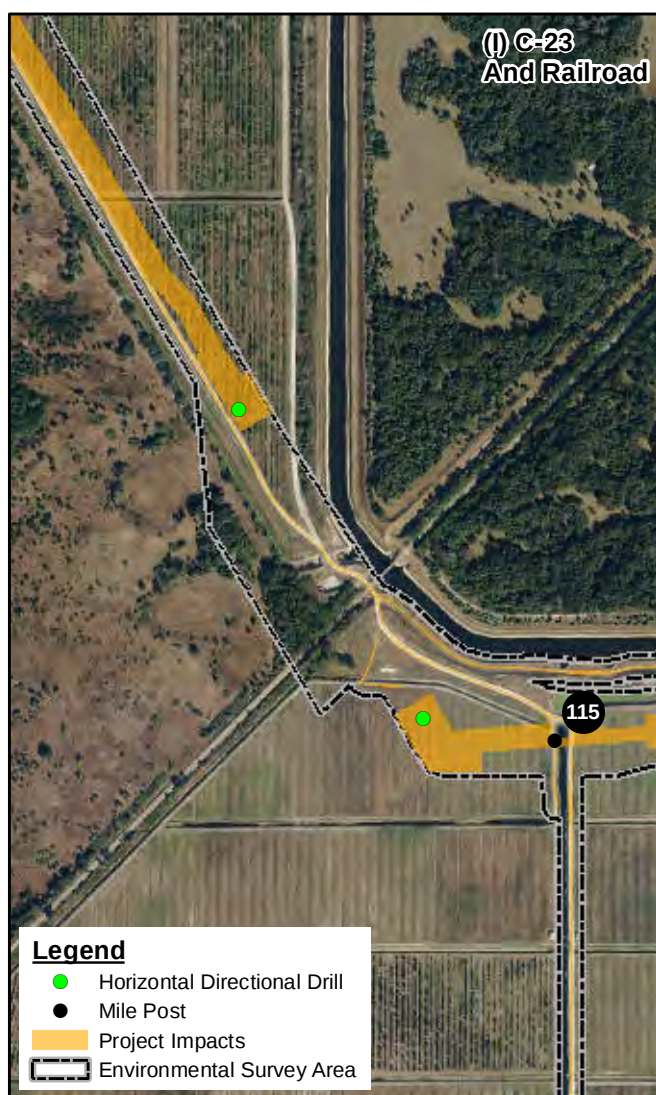


FIGURE 8. (SHEET 4 OF 4)
