

## PGP Included Trust Lands Location Map



Figure 4. Alligator Alley Reservation designated lands









Figure 5. Sherrod Ranch designated lands






































## Miccosukee Tribe Proposed New Trail Road & Housing Expansion



Existing Foundations - (Roads, Buildings, House Pads)

Propsed New Bridges - Culverts

\* Detail Information \*

North Gap - 164.1' FT. South Gap - 50' FT.

All new bridges and culverts - 15' FT. with 20' FT. of space on either side

15' Ft. between all house pads

All new house pads are 130' FT. x 266' FT. from center of road - 230' FT. from the right of way which is also the same as existing house pads.

No house pads are within 50'Ft. of MRA boundary

New road 24' FT. with 25' FT. shoulder on each side

New Roads are to connect with the existing Government Complex

All house pads are set to Loop Road Standards

All house pads with the extra 50' Ft. extension is marked with a gap area of wetlands in between

Total - 34 House pads in the North-East

Total - 35 House pads in the South-East

Total - 48 House pads in the North-West

Total - 49 House pads in the South-West

All fill in wetlands must be permitted by the US Army Corps of Engineers
